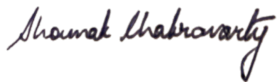

The amount utilised for general corporate purposes does not exceed 25% of the Gross Proceeds (amounting to Rs 1,625.00 million) from the Fresh Issue.

Note 1: Following the repayment of borrowings outlined in the Offer document, a balance of Rs 16.95 million remains from the object, "Repayment/pre-payment, in full or in part, of certain borrowings availed by the Company". This balance of Rs 16.95 million is subsequently added to "General corporate purposes" quantum in line with the disclaimer mentioned in the Offer document, which states, "In case the actual utilization towards any of the Objects is lower than the proposed deployment, such balance will be used for funding other existing Objects, if necessary and/or towards general corporate purposes to the extent that the total amount to be utilized towards general corporate purposes does not exceed 25% of the Gross Proceeds in accordance with the SEBI ICDR Regulations".

Note 2: Shareholder's approval has been obtained vide special resolution dated June 24, 2026 through Postal Ballot Notice, for reallocation of proceeds from Object 1(Funding capital expenditure towards establishment of new centers) to four additional objects as stated above (Objects 4 -7). While capital expenditure towards interiors continues to remain relevant to the Company's business, the Company believes that a portion of the funds earmarked for Object 1 can also be efficiently deployed towards other synergic opportunities that are directly aligned with its current business priorities. To maximize shareholder value and support organic growth, the Board proposed such reallocation of IPO proceeds.

Funding capital expenditure towards establishment of new centers	In order to support growth, the Company intend to leverage their experience and expand its operations by opening new centers in India. The Company intends to cover 1.29 million square feet, 1.24 million square feet and 0.54 million square feet through new centers in Fiscal 2026, 2027 and 2028, respectively. The Company proposes to utilize an estimated amount of Rs 1,944.03 million during Fiscal 2026, Rs 1,868.68 million during Fiscal 2027 and Rs 813.78 million during Fiscal 2028 from the Net Proceeds towards establishment of such new centers.
Repayment/pre-payment, in full or in part, of certain borrowings availed by the Company	The Company avails a majority of their fund-based and non-fund-based facilities in the ordinary course of business from various banks, financial institutions and other entities. The borrowing arrangements entered into by the Company include, inter alia, term loans and working capital loans. The Company proposes to utilize an estimated amount of Rs 913.40 million from the Net Proceeds towards repayment/pre-payment, in full or in part, of such borrowings.
General Corporate Purposes	The Company proposes to deploy the balance Net Proceeds aggregating to Rs 504.70 million towards general corporate purposes and business requirements of the Company as approved by the Board, subject to such amount not exceeding 25% of the Gross Proceeds, in compliance with the SEBI ICDR Regulations. The general corporate purposes for which the Company proposes to utilise Net Proceeds include, but are not restricted to, the following (i) meeting ongoing general corporate expenses, exigencies and contingencies; (ii) marketing, advertising expenditures and business development expenses; (iii) payment of salaries and allowances, administration, insurance, repair & maintenance, payment of taxes, duties and meeting expenses incurred by the Company in the ordinary course of business; and (iv)any other purpose as may be approved by the Board or duly appointed committee from time to time, subject to compliance with the Companies Act. The allocation or quantum of utilisation of funds towards the specific purposes described above will be determined by the Board of Directors of the Company, based on the business requirements and other relevant considerations, from time to time.

As per Company's Prospectus dated July 25, 2025, the Company had estimated to utilize Rs 2,448.73 million for the aforementioned objects by Fiscal 2026. However, based on the management undertaking and peer-reviewed Independent Chartered Accountant certificate, the Company has utilized Rs 1,776.97 million only as at quarter ended June 30, 2026. Hence, there is a delay in the implementation schedule. This delay is on account of lower operational requirements.

However, the Prospectus further states that, “In the event that estimated utilization out of the Net Proceeds in a scheduled Fiscal being not undertaken in its entirety, the remaining Net Proceeds shall be utilized in subsequent Fiscals, as may be decided by our Company, in accordance with applicable laws”.
