The remote e-voting period will commence at 9:00 A.M. on Monday, September 22, 2025 and end at 5:00 P.M. on Wednesday, September 24, 2025. The Company has appointed CS Sandhya R. Malhotra, Partner of M/s. Manish Ghia & Associates, Company Secretaries, as the Scrutinizer to scrutinize the voting process at the Annual General Meeting.
