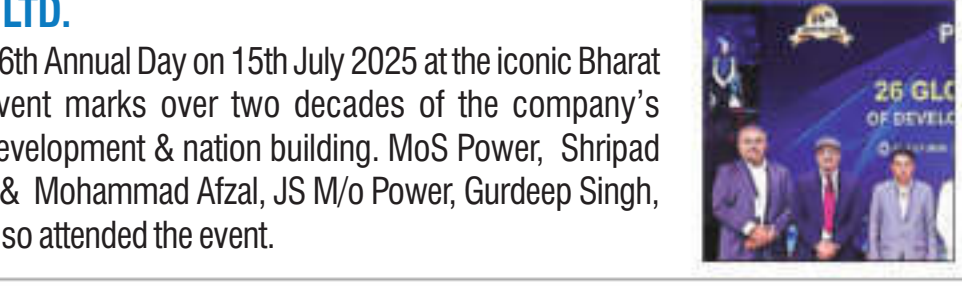
EDUCATIONAL IMMERSION SESSION—SCOPE
