In his opening remarks to the Russian president, Modi stated that "14 crore Indians were eagerly awaiting his attendance" at the 23rd India-Russia annual summit.

MARATHA QUOTA AGITATION | Manoj Jarange hardens his stand by giving up water on day four of the stir

Mumbai brought to standstill due to stir: HC

The Bombay High Court on Monday noted the city has been brought to a standstill due to the ongoing Maratha quota agitation, and the situation is grim as reservation campaigner Manoj Jarange hardened his stand by giving up water on day four of the stir.

The HC, while observing the protest has not been peaceful and has violated all pre-stir conditions, urged for normalcy to be restored in Mumbai, and gave an opportunity to Jarange, spearheading the stir, and his supporters to rectify the situation and ensure all streets are vacated by Tuesday noon.

It asked the Maharashtra government why the streets occupied by agitators, who have come to Mumbai from different parts of the state, are not being cleared and directed it to ensure more protesters do not enter the metropolis.

Follow directives, says Jarange

Maratha quota leader Manoj Jarange on Monday asked protesters to follow the directives of the Bombay High Court and not inconvenience the people of Mumbai by roaming on the streets.

KEY OBSERVATIONS BY HC
- The Bombay High Court strongly criticised the Maratha quota protest led by Manoj Jarange Patil, calling it unlawful and disruptive.
- Stated that protesters entering Mumbai should be stopped to prevent further chaos.
- Clarified that while right to protest exists, it cannot cause hardship to ordinary Mumbaikars.
- Allowed provisional permission for food and water to reach protesters, but underlined limits.
- Directed that if Jarange's health deteriorates during hunger strike, he must get immediate medical attention.

Alleging that his rival and ruling NDA nominee C P Radhakrishnan is "not speaking", INDIA bloc's Vice Presidential candidate B Sudershan Reddy on Monday said a healthy debate would have taken place had he spoken.

Addressing a press conference, which was also attended by Telangana Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy and the ruling Congress leaders, Sudershan Reddy said he favoured a healthy debate and that his intention is not to speak lowly about his rival.

Sudershan Reddy, a former Supreme Court judge, said the contest for Vice President's post is part of his long journey with the Constitution.

"Every day I am speaking to the media. I made the comment with the view that a healthy conversation would have taken place if he (Radhakrishnan) also spoke," he said.

Asked what was the most pressing Constitutional challenge that India faces in the present circumstances, Reddy said the most critical challenge the Constitution now faces is the "deficiency" in the functioning of the great Constitutional institution-- Election Commission of India.

Raj comes up with a stronger bill against religious conversion

The Rajasthan government is coming up with a more stringent bill to curb religious conversions via coercion, fraud, or misrepresentation during the assembly session that commenced with uproars on the issue of alleged vote chori on Monday.

The amended bill was cleared by the state cabinet on Sunday. The Law and Legal Affairs Minister of the state, Jogaram Patel, said that the existing draft, which was introduced in the assembly in February this year, will be replaced with a stricter version, featuring severe penalties including seven to fourteen years of imprisonment and minimum fines up to Rs 5 lakh.

He said that there is no specific law in the state to prevent illegal conversion; therefore, Rajasthan Prohibition of Unlawful Conversion of Religion Bill-2025 was introduced in the Assembly in the last session.

The said Bill proposes religious conversion by coercion, fraud, or misrepresentation as a non-bailable and cognizable offense.

A marriage with the objective of illegal religious conversion would be void, although Ghar Wapsi, a return to the original ancestral religion, has not been included in the definition of religious conversion.

BILL PROVIDES FOR:

- 7 to 14 years imprisonment and Rs 5 lakh fine for illegal conversion.
10 to 20 years imprisonment and a fine of Rs 10 lakh for religious conversion of a minor, handicapped person, woman, SC, or ST.
20 years to life imprisonment and a fine of Rs 25 lakh for mass religious conversion.
10 to 20 years imprisonment and a fine of Rs 20 lakh for receiving money from a foreign or illegal institution for religious conversion.

Dhankhar shifts to Chautala's farmhouse, not govt home

Former vice-president Jagdeep Dhankhar shifted from his official residence to a private farmhouse in the Chhatarpur area of south Delhi on Monday evening, six weeks after he resigned from his post, according to officials.

The farmhouse in the Gaudipur area of Chhatarpur belongs to INLD leader Abhay Chautala.

An official told PTI that Dhankhar will stay in the

private farmhouse as an interim arrangement till he is allocated a Type-VIII official residence, which he is entitled to as a former vice-president.

Abhay Chautala, the son of ex-Haryana chief minister O P Chautala, confirmed that the former vice-president has moved into the farmhouse in Chhatarpur. "We have old family ties with him. He is like a family member. I don't have to offer him to stay in our house, it is his own house," the INLD leader said.
