BUDAUN (UP)
7 students fall ill after meal
Seven students fell ill after eating a meal at the Jayap-rakash Narayan Sarvodaya Residential Girls' School in the Samrer block of Data-ganj tehsil here, officials said on Sunday. Police said students were admitted to the Samrer Community Health Centre (CHC) around 12.30 am on Satur-day. After receiving pri-mary treatment, families took five students home, stating they would seek further treatment at a pri-vate hospital.

LAKHIMPUR KHERI (UP)
3 youth held for gangrape
Three youngsters alleg-edly gang-raped a 19-year-old woman in Uttar Pradesh's Lakhimpur Kheri district and were ar-rested within hours of the incident, a police official said on Sunday. Circle Of-ficer Vivek Tiwari told re-porters that the three accused, Siddharth (22), Madhumesh Mishra (23), and Vishu Kanojia (19), have been arrested, and further legal action is underway.

Odisha: 2.37L evacuated
The Odisha government on Sunday sounded a high alert across the state after the IMD forecast extremely heavy rainfall in some areas following the forma-tion of a fresh low-press-ure area over the Bay of Bengal. The state has evacuated over 2.37 lakh people to safety as heavy rain continued for the sec-ond day, adding to the plight of people in flood-hit northern districts, an official said.

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The November election recorded 67.25% turnout, Bihar's highest since Inde-pendence, according to the Election Commission. Officials said Kumar will interact with around 500 booth level officers at Nalanda University in Rajgir on Monday. BLAME GAME | Asish Banerjee's death sparks political slugfest between TMC factions and BJP
Ex-dy speaker found hanging at TMC office

Former Assembly deputy speaker Asish Banerjee was found dead in mysterious circumstances at the Trinamool Congress (TMC) office near his residence at Rampurhat in Birbhum district. According to police, Baner-jee's body was found hanging inside the party office and was sent for autopsy. The police also stated that a **PURPORTED SUICIDE NOTE** was found inside the party office and is currently being examined. Asish Banerjee was a five-time MLA and was very close to TMC supremo Mamata Baner-jee. He had also served as deputy speaker of the Assembly and held ministerial portfolios. In the 2026 Assembly elec-tions, Banerjee had lost to Bha-ratiya Janata Party (BJP)'s

Dhruva Saha by more than 24,000 votes. Taking to X, former Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee said, "The passing of Asish Banerjee has left me deeply disturbed. He spent much of his life teaching and serving society with ded-ication, always known for his humble nature and close bond with the people of Rampurhat and Birbhum. What makes this tragedy even more painful is the

immense mental and emotional strain he appears to have en-dured in his final days. As a five-term MLA, former Deputy Speaker and Chairman, Asish Da dedicated himself to bring-ing development to Rampurhat and undertook a large number of important works for the people. Yet, despite the work he did, he was repeatedly mal-igned, falsely accused and sub-jected to relentless pressure."

TMC's corrupt elements might have threatened him: Suwendu
Hours after West Bengal Assembly's former deputy speaker Asish Banerjee was found hanging at a TMC office, Chief Minister Suwendu Adhikari on Sun-day expressed apprehen-sion that corrupt elements within the opposition party might have threatened him. He said the purported suicide note, written on the former MLA's letterhead and re-covered from the party of-fice, would be examined. The note stated that no one was responsible for Banerjee's death and ex-pressed regret over enter-ing politics. PTI, however, could not independently verify the authenticity of the letter.

Vrindavan widows to send 1,100 special rakhis to PM Modi

Hundreds of elderly wid-ows living in Vrindavan ashrams are preparing 1,100 special rakhis for Prime Minister Narendra Modi this Raksha Bandhan, con-tinuing a tradition in which they regard him as their brother. The hand-crafted rak-his, decorated with colour-ful photo-graphs of Modi, were prepared and packed at the historic Gopi-nath Temple on Sunday during an event organised by Sulabh International. The women sang Krishna



'bhajans' and danced dur-ing the pro-g r a m m e . They spend several days making the decorative threads by hand and send rakhis and sweets to Modi every year. Sulabh International executive convenor Nitya Pathak said a group usually visits the prime minister's residence on Raksha Band-han to tie rakhi to him. This year, five women will travel to Delhi to personally pres-ent baskets of sweets and rakhis to Modi.

CJP protester's father beaten to death, eight arrested

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The father of Cockroach Janta Party (CJP) supporter and activist Sheikh Abdul Hafiz was beaten to death in West Bengal's Bankura. A group of unknown miscreants suddenly at-tacked Hafiz and his father. Hafiz's father later suc-cumbed to his injuries after he was taken to Burdwan Medical College. So far, police have ar-rested eight people in con-nection with the attack. The attack took place on Aug 13 when Hafiz visited Karishunda Paschimpara Primary School to inspect its educational conditions as part of his party's work. That night, some un-known miscreants attacked Hafiz and his father with sticks and iron rods. Hafiz managed to flee from the house, but his father was attacked by the miscreants. Hafiz's mother, Hasina Begum, lodged a complaint with the police and pleaded that no one should lose her husband due to such violence and prayed for strict punishment for the miscreants. CJP, however, held the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) responsible for the death.

Abhishek blames BJP, media for Asish Banerjee's suicide

Trinamool Congress general secretary and the party's Dia-mond Harbour Lok Sabha member, Abhishek Banerjee, on Sunday issued a social media post blaming the Bha-ratiya Janata Party (BJP) and the media for the suicide of Asish Banerjee, the former West Bengal Minister and ex-Deputy Speaker of the state Assembly. Referring to the suicide note of the deceased leader, which was recovered this morning along with his body, Abhishek Baner-jee claimed that the statements in the suicide note were the re-sult of amplification of baseless allegations by the BJP and a section of the media. "His final note raises seri-ous and troubling questions about the sustained smear campaign he said he had en-dured. The BJP and sections of the MEDIA must reflect on the consequences of a politics where allegations are ampli-fied, reputations are put on trial and individuals are con-demned in the court of public opinion before the truth is es-tablished."

Students burn effigies of Rahul, Soren, Tejashwi

Plan CM residence gherao from Aug 20

Job aspirants and students protesting against alleged irregu-larities in Jharkhand's recruitment examinations burnt effigies of Congress leader Rahul Gandhi, Chief Minister Hemant Soren and RJD leader Tejashwi on Sunday, accusing them of not showing seriousness in conced-ing their demands. Congress and RJD share power with the JMM-led Ma-hagathbandhan government in the state. Demanding Soren's resigna-tion, protesters announced plans to lay siege to the Chief Minister's residence from Aug 20. They vowed to continue the protest until their key de-mands, including cancellation of the JSSC-CGL examination and a CBI probe into the al-legged irregularities, are met. Students urged Gandhi to withdraw his party's support

Protesters gave the government an ul-timatum to con-cede their demands by Aug 18. BJP has extended moral support to the protesters, who also de-manded greater trans-parency and reforms in the state's recruitment examination system.

from the JMM-led govern-ment if it fails to address their concerns. Police used water cannons, tear gas and a lathi-charge dur-ing the students' march towards the state Assembly on Aug 10. Gandhi condemned the use of force and said the government should listen to students and re-solve their grievances. Pro- testers, however, criticised him for allegedly failing to take con-crete follow-up action. The agitation entered its 23rd day on Sunday.

Akhilesh fires salvo at BJP over borders, inflation, schools

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Samajwadi Party president Akhilesh Yadav on Sunday questioned the BJP govern-ment over border security, in-flation, fuel prices and closure of government primary schools, saying these issues required greater attention than delimitation. "Today, the country needs security of its borders more than delimitation," Yadav said after paying tribute to free-dom fighter Rani Avantibai Lodhi on her birth anniver-sary in Hazratganj. Yadav said the BJP to compare the country's geographical area in 2014 with its pres-ent area, saying questions were being raised over border se-curity. He also tar-

geted the government over in-flation and E20 petrol, and al-legged shortages and irregularities in fertiliser supply, including DAP. He criticised garbage across Lucknow and questioned the BJP's claim of planting 300 crore trees. Yadav alleged that 500 pri-mary schools had been closed in Gorakhpur and criticised potholes on the Kanpur-Luck-now Expressway. Paying tribute to Rani Av-antibai Lodhi, he compared her contribution to the freedom struggle with Rani Lakshmbai's. Yadav said the Sa-majwadi Party would continue fighting for the PDA - Pichhda, Dalit and Alpsankhyak - and work to create awareness and bring people together.

NALSAR row: BCI chairman apologises to law students

Bar Council of India (BCI) chairperson Manan Kumar Mishra has apologised to law students after facing criticism over a now-withdrawn order to state bar councils not to enrol any of the current batch of gradu-ating NALSAR students as advocates. In a statement issued on Independence Day, Mishra said recent developments had caused concern among stu-dents and expressed regret if any of his words or communi-cations had hurt their feelings. "If anything connected with the present controversy, any of my words, or letter, has hurt the feelings of our law students, I sincerely regret and apologise for the same. There should be no hesita-tion in saying so. An ex-pression of regret is not a matter of prestige or ego. It is simply an acknowledgement that the feelings and concerns of our students matter," the statement said.
