AHMEDABAD-DHOLERA LINE

What's in 1st semi high-speed rail corridor coming up in Gujarat

THE CABINET Committee on Economic Affairs (CEA) chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on May 13 gave approval to the Ahmedabad-Dholera Semi High-Speed Double Line Railway Project, a first-of-its-kind in India.

The project, to be set up at a cost of Rs 20,667 crore, will be Indian Railways' first semi-high-speed rail project based on indigenous technology, on which Namco Bharat trains are set to operate. The entire rail line will be about 134 km long,

with the trains running between Sarkhej in Ahmedabad and the Special Investment Region (SIR) in Dholera town, located in the south-western area of Ahmedabad district near Dhandhuka.

The railway line will connect to the Dholera International Airport and the National Maritime Heritage Complex at Lohthal. The project is being developed in line with the Prime Minister's Gati Shakti National Master Plan.

Speaking at a press conference, Gujarat Chief Secretary Manoj Kumar Das on Friday termed the project "a new chapter in the industrial and

economic development of Gujarat."

"This corridor connecting Dholera SIR with Sabarmati, Dholera Airport and Lohthal will give a new direction to the economic progress of the state. With Metro integration at Sabarmati, Gandhigram and Vastrapur stations, bullet train connectivity at Sabarmati and dedicated freight at Moraia, the corridor will establish Gujarat as a world-class multi-modal transport hub," Das explained.

Divisional Rail Manager (DRM), Ahmedabad, Ved Prakash said a semi-high-speed train will run on a broad gauge track at a speed of 220 km/hr

"for the first time in the world."

"The entire project and trains will be entirely under Make in India. The train will be fitted with a state-of-the-art Kavach 5.0 security system, which will set a new standard in security and automatic train protection. Until now, semi-high-speed trains in the world have been running mainly on standard gauge, but India is going to develop a successful model of 220 kmph-speed on a broad gauge network for the first time. It is not just a railway project, but a historical chapter in Indian engineering, self-reliance and railway modernisation," Prakash.

Once the project is completed, the travel time between Ahmedabad and Dholera will be reduced to less than 1 hour and will also help in connecting Dholera directly with the Ahmedabad-Mumbai High Speed Rail Corridor (bullet train), he added.

Infra development

The design speed of the project is set at 220 kmph and the operational speed will be 200 kmph. A total of 13 stations will be developed on the corridor. There will be three mega bridges, 74 km of viaduct, 39 road under bridges (RUBs) and 2 rail over bridges (ROBs). The

total track length will be around 293 km. The project is targeted to be completed in the next four years, with plans for extending the line to Bhavnagar in future.

Connectivity

The semi high speed line will be connected with Metro at Sabarmati, Gandhigram and Vastrapur railway stations, with the Bullet train at Sabarmati railway station and to the Dedicated Freight Corridor (DFC) at Moraia, near Sanand. It will also be linked to the Sanand Industrial Area near Bisalpur and the upcoming Bhimnath logistics hub in Botad, the latter through the Delhi-Mumbai In-

dustrial Corridor (DMIC).

The Railways said the project will give direct benefit to about 284 villages and over 5 lakh population. It will add a cargo transportation capacity of about 20 lakh tonnes per annum and save Rs 54 crore per annum in logistics costs. It is set to generate 91 lakh man-days of employment in the construction phase and later on, cause an annual saving of about 0.48 crore liters of fuel. On the climate change side, "this project is expected to reduce CO₂ emissions by about 20 million kilograms—equivalent to the environmental benefits of planting about 1 million trees," says the Western Railway.

NIA seeks cancellation of bail to Sudha Bharadwaj, Varavara Rao

THE NATIONAL Investigation Agency (NIA) has sought cancellation of bail granted to Elgar Parishad accused and lawyer-activist Sudha Bharadwaj and Telugu poet-activist Varavara Rao, alleging that they violated bail conditions by attending an event at the Mumbai Press Club where

other co-accused were present. A special court on Friday sought their response to the NIA's plea. Bharadwaj (65) was granted bail by the Bombay High Court in December 2021, while Rao (85) was granted interim bail on medical grounds in February 2021. His interim bail was extended from time to time before being confirmed by the Supreme Court in August 2022.

UNNAO RAPE CASE SC sets aside HC order suspending Sengar's sentence

THE SUPREME Court Friday set aside the Delhi High Court order suspending the life sentence of former MLA Kuldeep Singh Sengar in the Unnao rape case, remarking that it does not endorse the HC's "hypertechnical view" that a legislator is not a public servant for the purposes of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act.

"This is a legislation which is not only penal but also one which protects children from sexual exploitation and other forms of abuse," Justice Joymaya Bagchi said. Justice Bagchi was part of a two-judge bench, including CJI Justice Surya Kant, hearing the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI)'s appeal against the December 23, 2025, order of the Delhi HC suspending Sengar's life sentence and granting him bail in the case. The HC had ruled that his former status as an MLA does not bring him under the ambit of a 'public servant' as defined under the IPC.

May 25 and that he is ready with the arguments. As Senior Advocate N Hariharan, who represented Sengar, intervened, the CJI said one order before the bench is "without getting into details, we can set aside the order and ask the high court to pass a fresh order".

CJI Kant, too, said the HC may not have looked at all issues while considering the application for suspension of Sengar's sentence. Justice Kant added that if the court issues a speaking order, it will also address the merits. "HC may make an endeavour to decide the main appeal finally as early as possible," the court said and added that in case the appeal is not likely to be heard, a fresh order be passed concerning the application for suspension of sentence after hearing the parties, including the counsel for the victim, complainant. The SC directed that appropriate orders be passed preferably before the summer vacations begin.

On December 29, 2025, the top court stayed the high court order, saying there are "various substantial questions of law which arise for consideration". On Friday, Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, appearing for CBI, pointed out that Sengar's appeal is listed for hearing on

Carpooling for judges, virtual hearings: SC on measures to save fuel

THE SUPREME Court on Friday announced carpooling for judges, permission for Registry staff to work from home, and hearing through videoconferencing as part of measures to save fuel.

each branch/ section of the Registry are permitted to work from home for up to two days per week, provided that the remaining staff remain available in the office to ensure uninterrupted functioning.

A circular issued by Secretary General Bharat Parashar said that "matters listed on miscellaneous days (i.e. on Mondays, Fridays, or such other days as declared to be miscellaneous), and matters listed during the Court's partial working days, shall be heard by videoconferencing only." It added that "the Registry shall ensure that links for the video-conferencing are sent in a timely manner, maintain stable videoconferencing facilities and extend timely technical assistance so as to avoid any inconvenience to the... Court." The circular said that "to ensure optimum utilisation of fuel, the... Judges of the Supreme Court have unanimously resolved to encourage car-pooling arrangements amongst themselves."

The communication said "the Registrar concerned shall ensure that a weekly roster is prepared before the commencement of the week. Staff who are permitted to work from home are directed to remain available on telephone and be ready to attend office, in case of requirement, at any time. The concerned officers shall also ensure timely completion of various tasks assigned to them."

The circular added that "if, after considering the essential nature of the work in a branch or section, the concerned Registrar is of the opinion that a work-from-home arrangement is not effective, the Registrar may restrict or modify such arrangements for that branch or section." The court said that circular in view of the May 12 Office Memorandum issued by the Department of Personnel and Training, and that the measures announced will take force with "immediate effect".

On way from Karnataka, Goa Cong leader dies of 'snakebite'

Panaji: Goa Congress leader

Ketan Bhatikar died of a suspected snakebite in the early hours of Friday, said police. Bhatikar (40), a physiotherapist, was the Congress candidate in the recent Ponda Assembly by-poll, which was cancelled after a High Court order. Bhatikar had challenged the order in the Su-
