India has surpassed Kenya to top the Athletics Integrity Unit's (AIU) list of ineligible persons due to doping violations with 148 suspended track and field athletes, which is two more than the African nation. The latest updated list is for the period up to April 1 this year. Russia took the third spot with 66 suspended athletes. Women's 100m national record holder **Dutee Chand**, who has been serving a four-year ban since December 2022 is in the list.

India has confirmed at least three medals at the Asian Boxing Championships 2026 after Nikhat Zareen, Priya, and Preeti Pawar registered impressive victories to advance to the semifinals on Day 5 in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia.

Leading the charge, Nikhat Zareen was in complete control during her women's 51kg quarterfinal, sealing a first-round RSC (Referee Stops Contest) victory over the Philippines' Xian Baguhin in a dominant display. She now faces her toughest test yet in the semifinals against China's Wu Yu, the Paris 2024 Olympic gold medallist.

In the women's 60kg category, Priya showcased composure and tactical maturity to defeat China's Chengyu Yang 4-1, continuing her fine run in the tournament.

Indian-origin Bodhana Sivanandan creates history

Indian-origin chess prodigy Bodhana Sivanandan has become England's top-rated female player, according to the latest rating list issued by the International Chess Federation (FIDE).

The 11-year-old, whose parents moved from Tiruchirappalli in Tamil Nadu to England in 2007, now holds 2366 FIDE rating points. The North London primary school student has overtaken the 25-year-old four-time British women's champion, Lan Yao, at the summit of the FIDE list for England.

With this achievement, she has also broken into the world's top 100 women for the first time, currently sitting at number 72.

"It is an extraordinary rise for a Harrow schoolgirl who took up the game during the 2020 COVID-19 lockdown after finding a chessboard and set in a bag her father had intended to throw out," the release from the English Chess Federation stated.

In the middle of a brilliant run in his maiden pool nationals, Pankaj Advani, winner of the 9-ball event three days ago, powered into the semifinals of the 10-ball championships at the Rotary Bhawan here on Friday.

Advani carried far too many guns for reigning champion Shivam Arora in the quarterfinals. His lopsided 8-2 victory helped him set up a last-four showdown with fellow Petroleum Sports Promotion Board cueist **Shahbaaz Adil Khan**. Khan prevailed by a similar margin over Punjab's Sumesh Jhangra in the other quarterfinal.

The other semifinal will be played between Pushpender Singh of the Railways Sports Promotion Board and Aayush Kumar of Punjab. While Singh edged out Divya Sharma of Punjab 8-6, Kumar overcame Chetan Chabra of Telangana 8-7. Spectators expected plenty

of fireworks in the last-eight clash between Advani and Arora. Advani proved that his win over Arora in 9-ball was not a flash in the pan and he had the skill set and tactical nous to rub shoulders with the best in pool as well. The Bengaluru native was on song from the get-go, not giving his fancied rival much chance in the race-to-eight clash.

At the adjacent table, Khan was a trifle slow to start with. But once he got his eye in, the Kolkata native looked a different player altogether, potting brilliantly and showing immaculate cue ball control en route to a crushing victory.

Tanuj Dayal drew with Aashrita Balaji Guttala, while Palaash Mapara bounced back strongly with a win against Ekaansh Sharma, keeping his chances alive going into the final round.

With one round remaining, Mhasane holds a slender but significant lead, while a strong chasing pack ensures that the title race is still wide open and promises a thrilling finish.

The Willingdon Sports Club (WSC) golf season reached a grand conclusion on 28 March 2026, marked by an Annual Day celebratory gala dinner and a record-breaking closing tournament. The season finale witnessed an unprecedented 328 golfers taking to the greens, vastly surpassing the previous record of 182 participants set in 2025.

In the flagship Annual Day Golf tournament, Arjun Nohwar and Nikhil Bardia claimed top honours, finishing ahead of silver medallists



Abhishek Parekh and Aakash Shah in a closely contested field.

The highlight of the evening was the crowning of the "Willingdon Golfer of the Year". After a gruelling season spanning 36 tournaments, Golf Captain Riaz Batlivala emerged victorious for the second consecutive year, win-

Following this historic year, the WSC Golf section is now preparing for the commencement of the new tournament season in June 2026.
