# India blocks China's attempt to form WTO panel on PLI scheme

INDIA HAS BLOCKED China's request for the establishment of a panel to adjudicate the dispute it had brought before the World Trade Organization (WTO) against the production-linked incentive (PLI) scheme for solar modules and duties charged on IT products.

The dispute was initiated on December 19 last year when China requested consultations with India on PLI for solar and duties on IT products. As the consultations failed to resolve the issue, China requested for the establishment of a panel under the dispute settlement mechanism (DSM) to adjudicate on it. At the meeting of the dispute settlement body (DSB) on Friday, India blocked the Chinese request. However, China can again request for the establishment of a panel and on second attempt, the panel

does get constituted unless there is a consensus in the DSB against it. This, however, will not happen as long as the complainant is unwilling to join in that consensus.

If the panel is established in the next DSB meeting then India will have to defend its policy. After hearing both sides, the panel prepares its report on the dispute which becomes binding once it is adopted by DSB. Either party has the right to appeal the findings of the panel but at present the appeal

body is non-functional because of the absence of quorum as the US has blocked appointment of new judges since 2017. As the dispute settlement mechanism is not fully functional, all disputes at WTO end in a limbo.

At Friday's meeting, India said it had entered into discussions with China on the dispute in good faith but the Chinese decided to go ahead with the request for formation of the panel. The Indian representatives also said that the PLI for

high efficiency solar photovoltaic modules is consistent with the WTO law. India also said that China controls 80% of the global value chain of solar module production and its efforts to stall the legitimate growth of this industry in other countries is "strange". It also said that the rules-based trading system with the WTO at its core should not support such mercantilism, which amounts to beggar-thy-neighbour.

Within the PLI for solar modules, China has objected to the conditions that stipulate a minimum local value addition to qualify for incentives. Through these measures, India accords to certain technology products originating in China less favourable treatment than local producers which is against WTO agreements and rules. On IT products, China has said India applies duties that are in excess of its commitments at the WTO.

# South dams filled less than a quarter, pan-India level at 33%

WATER LEVELS IN the 47 reservoirs in southern India dropped to 24.2% of their capacity, much below the previous year's levels, reports Sandip Das. Storage is below 25% of reservoir capacities in both Karnataka and Telan-

gana, two states where kharif crops, especially paddy and pulses, are widely grown. With El Nino developing in the second half of the monsoon season (June-September), rainfall could be affected, potentially causing further drops in water

levels in dams. Low reservoir levels could also dent hydro-electric potential.

At the pan-India level, dams are filled up to a third of their capacities ahead of monsoon onset. Water levels in 98 out of 166 key dams monitored by the

Central Water Commission are higher than the year-ago level, while 110 reservoirs store more water now than the average of the last 10 years. The water level across dams is 11% higher than last-year level and over 14% higher than 10-year average.

HC notice to AAP's Gopal Rai, journalist Saurav Das on criminal contempt plea

THE DELHI High Court on Friday issued notice to AAP leader Gopal Rai and journalist Saurav Das in a plea accusing them of running a "coordinated campaign" against Justice Swarna Kanta Sharma.

The petition by lawyer Ashok Chaitanya also named AAP convener and former Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and AAP leader Saurabh Bhardwaj as parties.

Criminal contempt proceedings against Kejriwal and six others, initiated suo motu by the High Court earlier this month, is already pending.

Seeking justice from Rai and Das, Justice Navin Chawla and Ravinder Duggal clubbed the matter for hearing with the suo motu criminal contempt proceedings initiated on May 14, and appointed senior advocate Riddipa Behra as amicus curiae in the case.

...instead of multiplying the number of matters, this contempt case be also taken up along with that matter (suo motu criminal contempt proceedings) "the bench directed, while ordering that Kejriwal and Bhardwaj be also served with the latest petition. It also directed the Registry to preserve the social media material related to the petition, that Chaitanya told the court, were still online.

Chaitanya's plea alleged that Das and the AAP leaders, during the hearing of the applications by those AAP leaders, seeking recall of Justice Sharma from hearing the CBI's plea challenging the discharge of 23 accused in the alleged liquor policy scam, initiated a "concerted and orchestrated campaign" on X and published and amplified content containing "serious, unfounded, and scandalous allegations" against her.

The plea objected to the posts which purportedly highlighted "supposed conflict of interest, bias, and impropriety based on misleading assertion" in relation to Justice Sharma's family.

On May 14, Justice Sharma, in an order, had accused Kejriwal, Sisodia, Pathak, former party MLA Vinay Mishra, AAP Rajya Sabha MP Sanjay Singh, party's Delhi president Bhardwaj, and Devesh Vishwakarma, who is said to be involved in AAP's social media operations, for alleged contempt of court by publishing "contemptuous material" against her and the judiciary on social media.

# Umar Khalid gets 3-day interim bail for his mother's surgery

A lower court had earlier declined to grant interim bail

THE DELHI High Court on Friday granted jailed student activist Umar Khalid interim bail for three days from June 1 to 3 to attend to his mother, who is due to undergo a surgery.

A division bench of Justices Prathibha Singh and Madhu Jain recorded that it is taking an "empathetic view", while noting that Khalid was denied regular bail by the Supreme Court in January as he appeared to be one of the "prime conspirators" in the 2020 north-east Delhi larger conspiracy case under the stringent UAPA.

Khalid sought interim bail for 15 days to attend the 40th day death ritual of his uncle as well as to take care of his mother who is due to undergo a minor surgery. He has earlier been released three or in interim bail during the period of his incarceration as an undertrial.

"The court is also conscious of the fact that the regular bail application was rejected by the SC on January 8, the applicant being one of the prime conspirators... However, taking an

empathetic view that his mother is due to undergo surgery, this court is inclined to grant interim bail from June 1, 7 am to June 3, 5 pm," the bench recorded. The court did not grant him interim bail to attend his uncle's death ritual.

While ASGSV Raju, appearing for Delhi Police on Friday, impressed that Khalid be released only with police escort, the court did not order for the same.

The court has ordered him to furnish surety and personal bond of Rs 1 lakh and also re-estrained him from moving beyond NCR region, permitting him to stay at his residence at Jamia Nagar and to visit the hospital only.

On May 19, a day after the Supreme Court, while underlining that bail is the rule and jail an exception even in UAPA cases, expressed "serious reservations" on the decision of one of its own benches to deny bail to activist Umar Khalid in the

2020 Delhi riots case, a Delhi court had declined to grant him interim bail.

While noting that Khalid and other co-accused in the case have "never flouted conditions" imposed by the court, it, however, recorded: "But it doesn't mean that on every occasion, whenever the accused seeks bail, the court should grant it."

In January, a division bench of the Supreme Court, comprising Justices Arvind Kumar and NV Anjaria, while granting bail to Khalid and activist Sharjeel Imam, saying they stood on a "higher footing in the hierarchy of participation". The court had observed that prolonged incarceration cannot be an "absolute entitlement" to seek bail in terror cases.

On May 18, another division bench of the Supreme Court, comprising Justices BV Nagarathna and Ujjal Bhuyan, expressed its disapproval with the January order. It referred to the three-judge decision in Ka Najeb in 2021, which had said that an accused undertrial suffering long incarceration under UAPA with no end in sight to the criminal trial must be enlarged on bail.

Khalid has been in jail for five years and eight months, since his arrest in September 2020.

# Big relief for property owners as govt slashes infra charges of water, sewer

IN A major relief for residents, the Delhi government has announced major reductions in "Infrastructure Charges" paid by property owners while constructing a new house, along with a 50% rebate for all properties in E and F-category colonies and a 70% rebate for properties in G and H categories.

Chief Minister Rekha Gupta said, "Infrastructure Charges (IFCs) for water and sewer will be levied on water demand based and only on new development or additional construction within a property. It will not apply to redevelopment cases where the water demand remains unchanged."

"For instance, A & B category who earlier paid Rs 13.18 lakh as IFC charges, will have to pay Rs 5.4 lakh now. For residential category who paid Rs 3.29 lakh will get rebate of 50% (E&F) and 70% (G&H)...", said the CM, adding that non-F&R and unopened areas will not be included for calculation of water demand and IFC.

Gupta said the changes in the IFC of the Delhi Jal Board will bring transparency in the system and provide relief to the public.

IFCs are paid by buyers of those constructing a new house to the government during the registration of the property and documentation process, for facilities like water connection, pipeline, sewer line, roads, etc. Water Minister Parvesh Sahib Singh, meanwhile, accused the previous AAP government of using the IFC system to harass the public.

# Vigilance team raids CPA over 'Rs 350-crore procurement irregularities'; DGHS transferred

THE DELHI Directorate of Vigilance conducted raids at the office of the Central Procurement Agency (CPA) on Wednesday and Thursday night following complaints of alleged irregularities in procurement tenders related to medicines, surgical items and medical equipment, sources said.

Amid the probe, sources claimed, the Delhi government transferred Dr Vatsala Aggarwal, who was serving as Director General of Health Services (DGHS), and replaced her with the medical superintendent of Jag Pravech Chandra Hospital.

Sources said complaints were received regarding procurement of medicines and

medical equipment worth over Rs 350 crore at prices allegedly higher than prevailing market rates. Questions have also allegedly been raised over the necessity of these purchases, procurement procedures and possible financial irregularities.

The CPA, the nodal authority under DGHS for the Government of the NCT of Delhi, is responsible for acquiring medicines, surgical consumables, and medical equipment for all state-run hospitals and healthcare facilities.

According to sources, the Directorate of Vigilance had allegedly received confidential complaints regarding irregularities in the procurement process of medicines and equip-

ment, following which a Vigilance team reached the CPA office and initiated a probe.

During the raid, the team allegedly seized files related to procurement of medicines and medical equipment. The officials are now allegedly examining major tenders connected with hospitals and scrutinising documents related to X-ray and MRI machines, anaesthesia machines, medicines, surgical equipment, chairs, modular operation theatres and other medical items. During the raid, Vigilance officials allegedly questioned employees and seized important files linked to the procurement process.

The matter allegedly reached the Lieutenant Governor's office, after which Dr Aggarwal was removed as DGHS. Sources alleged she was questioned by Vigilance officials and that a team conducted searches at her residence.

According to sources, complaints had been made regarding multiple tenders, alleging that contracts were awarded without proper technical evaluation and that equipment and infrastructure items were

procured without adequate justification. It was also alleged that certain firms wore coats of rupees for medicines, surgical equipment, diagnostic devices and anaesthesia-related items.

Dr Aggarwal was appointed DGHS last August. She had earlier faced a Vigilance inquiry initiated by the Health and Family Welfare department over alleged manipulation of recruitment rules during her tenure as the director of Delhi State Cancer Institute. The probe had looked into complaints regarding the alleged appointment of Dr Minakshi Mann to the post of assistant professor without following due procedure. Health Secretary Rupesh Thakur was unavailable for comment.
