

Fintech platform WeRize secures \$7 million funding

Bengaluru: WeRize, a Bengaluru- and Mumbai-based social distribution fintech platform designed for small-city India, has raised \$7 million in a pre-Series C funding round to fund its next phase of growth. The funding round was led by Sony Innovation Fund, with participation from existing investor 3one4 Capital. WeRize will use the fresh capital to deepen investments in its proprietary AI and technology stack, expand its product suite into investment products.

Ola Electric raises ₹780 crore via QIP

New Delhi: Ola Electric Mobility has raised ₹780 crore through a qualified institutional placement (QIP) that was oversubscribed 56 per cent, driven by strong participation from domestic and global institutional investors, stock exchange data showed. The issue received bids worth about ₹780 crore, with demand from long-only investors, including global investment companies.

India, Venezuela seek deeper energy, economic partnership

BUILDING TIES. Discussions focus on oil, critical minerals and unpaid dividends

Venezuelan acting-President Delcy Rodríguez and Prime Minister Narendra Modi held wide-ranging talks on Thursday focused on forging a stronger energy partnership while expanding ties beyond oil to several sectors such as critical minerals, mining, pharmaceuticals, agriculture, and automobiles.

Rodríguez emphasised that Venezuela views India as a "preferred energy partner" due to the size of the Indian economy and its long-term stability as a buyer, Rudrendra Tandon, Secretary (East) in the Ministry of External Affairs, said at a media briefing.

Modi said that India looked forward to building this relationship across both upstream and downstream activities. "Venezuela has already emerged as the third-largest crude oil supplier this month... There exists a per-

fect complementarity for India and Venezuela to work in the energy sector," Tandon said.

The five-day visit is both politically and economically important, taking place just five months after US forces detained former President Nicolás Maduro. Facing West Asia supply disruptions, India is actively diversifying crude sources, while Venezuela, which holds the world's largest proven oil re-

serves, needs a reliable buyer. To explore collaborations, the Venezuelan delegation will visit several industrial sites, which may include Reliance Industries' refinery in Jamnagar, Gujarat.

The Modi-Rodríguez discussions also went into broadening the overall bilateral economic partnership to other areas.

"Venezuela is a resource-rich country. It's not just about critical minerals; it has

also gold, diamonds, and other materials. So, mining is very much there. In fact, there was a discussion on how to assess the potential reserves that they have, or whether we could cooperate in that area," he said.

PENDING ISSUES

During the talks, India raised the issue of Venezuela owing over \$500 million in dividends to ONGC Videsh as well as payments owed to pharmaceutical companies. "All pending issues were raised... They (the Venezuela side) are very sensitive to the issue," Tandon stated.

When asked if the recent political transition in Venezuela came up for discussion, Tandon highlighted the close relations shared with the country.

"We are working with a government that is friendly, that wants a partnership with India. We want to reciprocate that. Venezuela has traditionally been a very close friend," he said.

ED closes FEMA probe against Myntra

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has closed its foreign exchange violation probe against Flipkart-owned e-commerce platform Myntra following a monetary settlement.

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) issued a compounding order on April 20 to formally terminate the investigation into Myntra Designs Private Ltd, after receiving a 'no objection' clearance from the ED.

The central agency had initiated the probe last year following 'credible information' alleging two infractions under the Foreign Exchange Management Act (FEMA), involving transactions worth approximately ₹46 crore.

Rather than facing prosecution, Myntra opted for FEMA's compounding provision, a regulatory mechanism that allows companies to settle offences by paying a monetary penalty.

The fashion-and-lifestyle retailer made a one-time payment of ₹2.88 lakh to close the case.

Consumers focus on savings, selective on spending amid global uncertainties: Report

Amidst geopolitical volatility, Indian consumers are focusing on strengthening saving intentions and becoming more selective in spending on purchases that have long-term value but spend on travel and experiences remain high on their agenda. A survey released by Kantar stated that while consumer remain resilient in their outlook they are increasingly focused on financial security.

About 48 per cent of respondents surveyed said they expect the economy to improve in 2026, significantly down from 60 per cent in January.

Concerns around layoffs have increased from 36 per cent in January to 41 per cent in May.

Expectations around personal financial growth have also moderated. Sixty-one per cent of the respondents expect their savings and investments to either remain same or decline versus 2025, only 39 per cent expect them to increase, the survey findings revealed.

Deepender Rana, Executive Managing Director, South Asia, Kantar, said: "Our latest report shows that Indian consumers remain resilient but are becoming noticeably more cautious as economic and geopolitical uncertainty rises. Confidence in future financial growth has softened, while concerns around job security, retirement preparedness and rising living costs have intensified. As a result, consumers are becoming more deliberate in how they spend, prioritising savings, value and long-term financial security, while continuing to protect experiences that enhance their wellbeing and

quality of life. For brands, this presents a clear imperative: demonstrate tangible."

MORE CAUTIOUS

The findings suggest consumers are becoming more cautious about both the broader economic environment and their own financial prospect. Future financial preparedness is emerging as one of the strongest concerns for Indian households with healthcare expenses continuing to be the biggest financial worry.

Nearly two-thirds of respondents said they are "very likely" to save more for their own and their family's future.

"However, financial pressures remain evident, with 33 per cent reporting a decline in savings and investments compared with 2025, while only 28 per cent report growth," it added.

However, rather than cutting consumption altogether, consumers are becoming more deliberate about where and how they spend, the survey said. Spending intentions across discretionary categories such as dining out, entertainment, shopping and subscriptions have weakened but spending intentions on travel and experience remain resilient.

"At the same time, consumers continue to favour assets perceived as offering long-term value and security. More than half (52 per cent) say they are very likely to purchase gold over the next 12 months," it added.

India-UK minerals observatory unveiled

The India-UK critical minerals Global Supply Chain Observatory (GSCO) was formally launched on Thursday by Coal & Mines Minister G Kishan Reddy and Yvette Cooper, UK's Secretary of State for Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Affairs.

The launch marks a milestone in the growing India-UK partnership on critical minerals and supply chain resilience, reinforcing co-

operation in securing the resources essential for clean energy, advanced manufacturing and electric mobility.

CRUCIAL BACKBONE

Addressing the gathering, Reddy emphasised that critical minerals are the backbone of modern economies and indispensable for clean energy technologies, advanced manufacturing, electric mobility and strategic sectors.

He noted that the Observatory would strengthen India's capabilities in critical mineral supply chain intelli-

gence, support evidence-based policymaking, and advance the objectives of the National Critical Mineral Mission.

Cooper underscored the importance of India-UK collaboration in developing resilient, diversified and sustainable critical mineral supply chains.

She stated that greater access to critical minerals and improved information-sharing are in the mutual interest of both nations and can contribute significantly to economic growth and supply chain security.

Zepto eyes \$1 billion order mark in June

Quick commerce platform Zepto is likely to cross the \$1 billion-mark in terms of net order value (NOV) by the end of June quarter as it eyes a public listing. This comes at a time when the company has been focusing sharply on profitability and financial discipline strategy.

Sources said that the quick commerce platform's net order value is expected to grow to over \$1 billion in June quarter from about \$500 mil-

lion in late 2025 and has been scaling up despite growing competitive intensity in the sector. Zepto has been focusing on reducing cash burn per order while focusing sharper focus on stronger unit economics and profitability, they added. The platform had reported a cash burn per order of about ₹200 in the early half of 2025.

INITIAL APPROVAL

Last month, Zepto received initial approval from markets regulator SEBI for its confidential initial public offering and is reportedly in

the process of filing an updated draft prospectus.

In October last year, the pure play quick commerce platform had raised about \$450 million in a funding round led by California Public Employees' Retirement System and General Catalyst, valuing it at about \$ 7 billion. Other existing investors, including Avenir, Avra, Lightspeed and Glade Brook had also participated in the round.

The platform seems to have a strategy of focusing on serving 61 cities with a higher focus on metros.
