CWC & iWare Set to Roll Out India's First Rail Shipment of Bitumen from Gandhidham to Guwahati

Central Warehousing Corporation (CWC), in partnership with iWare Supplychain Services Ltd., is set to dispatch India's first-ever rail shipment of Bitumen using a BCN rake from the Central Warehouse – RWC Gandhidham to the Guwahati region. The dispatch is scheduled **today**, marking a major milestone in Bitumen logistics and introducing a more economical, efficient, and environment-friendly rail alternative to road transportation.

What is Bitumen?

Bitumen is a petroleum-derived product widely used in road construction, particularly for asphalt production. Being a heavy and viscous material, it requires specialised handling, storage, and loading arrangements.

With upgraded infrastructure and improved operational capabilities at CWC's RWC Gandhidham, these challenges have now been effectively addressed, making rail transport of Bitumen feasible for the first time.

The Landmark Dispatch

In the first phase, approximately **2,000 MT** of Bitumen is planned for dispatch to **Salchapra, Silchar (Assam)**.

This initiative is part of the expanding rail-based logistics solutions jointly developed by CWC and iWare. After the successful launch of the Green Channel Cargo Service on the Gandhidham-Delhi corridor, the Gandhidham-Guwahati movement will further extend this service to the Northeast, offering a reliable and seamless long-distance option for industrial cargo.
