Re-appointment of Ms. Vanita Bhargava (DIN: 07156852) as an Independent Director of the Company

As per the provisions of Section 149 read with Schedule IV and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, Ms. Vanita Bhargava (DIN: 07156852) was appointed as an Independent Director of the Company for an initial term of 5 (five) years from 6th March, 2020 to 5th March, 2025. Accordingly, her tenure as an Independent Director was upto 5th March, 2025.

Based on the recommendation of Nomination and Remuneration Committee and pursuant to the performance evaluation conducted, the Board of Directors of the Company on 5th March, 2025, re-appointed Ms. Vanita Bhargava as an Independent Director of the Company for a second term of 1 (one) year w.e.f. 6th March, 2025.

Ms. Vanita Bhargava has given consent for her re-appointment as an Independent Director of the Company and a declaration that she is not disqualified from being appointed as a Director in terms of Section 164 of the Companies Act, 2013 and not debarred from holding the office of director pursuant to any SEBI order or any other regulatory authority. Further, the Company has also received a declaration that she meets the criteria of independence as per the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.

Brief profile
