CA No.04/2026, CA No.05/2026 & CA No.06/2026

1. Ld. Sr. Counsels with their assisting counsels representing these applications i.e. CA No.04/2026, CA No.05/2026 & CANo.06/2026 in main petition i.e. CP No.64/ALD/2023 seek to pursue the present applications for a decision/ disposal.
2. Ld. Sr. Counsels with their assisting counsels for their respective parties in these applications respectively, have therefore made their elaborate submissions.
3. Ld. Sr. Counsels representing all the parties also extensively refer to the order dated 27.02.2026 passed by this Tribunal in the aforesaid CAs. The matter has been heard at length in these applications on the submissions and the request being made by all the Ld. Sr. Counsels for decision/ disposal of these applications.
4. The matter has been heard, order reserved.

5. While passing the order dated 27.02.2026, we have observed in para nos.20 & 23, which reads as under :

20. However, notwithstanding our such opinion, the prevailing situation is that the said resolution dated 14.07.2023 has been passed in which there is no stay granted, despite its challenge in terms of the CA No.30/2023. Since, there is no stay on the validity of the resolution dated 14.07.2023 also remains intact subject to determination in pending Lis in the main matter & connected CA and it is up to the Applicants in CA No.4/2026 and CA No.6/2026 to carry it forward in accordance with law.

23. We therefore direct that in the larger public interest, the requisition dated 12.02.2026 seeking to convene the Extraordinary General Meeting of Respondent No.19 Company be kept in abeyance till the next date of hearing of these present applications for further considerations which are listed for further hearing on 19.03.2026 to come up higher on the Board, alongwith the main case.

6. Since, now after hearing at length the Ld. Sr. Counsels representing the parties in the aforementioned CAs, which are now being reserved, therefore we deem it appropriate that the requisition dated 12.02.2026 to convene the EOGM of the respondent no.19 company, which was kept in abeyance in terms of the order dated 27.02.2026 shall continue to be in abeyance and would be subject to the final decision/ disposal in the aforementioned CAs.
7. Let the main matter along with all other applications be adjourned for hearing on 16th April, 2026 and to be taken up at 02:30 PM.
