In compliance with Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“LODR Regulations”) as amended by the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) (Second Amendment) Regulations, 2023, we wish to inform you that, M/s. Jai Suspension Systems Private Limited, a subsidiary of the Company has received a Show Cause Notice (SCN) dated April 10, 2026, from the Office of the Joint Commissioner of Central GST, Audit Commissionerate, Dehradun (“GST Authority”) for the audit period from FY 2021-22 to FY 2023-24.

The subsidiary, based on the advice of the tax consultants will be filing appropriate response to the SCN to the Authority. The details as required under Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 read with SEBI Master Circular dated January 30, 2026 is enclosed herewith as an Annexure-1.

a) Brief details of litigation viz. names of the opposing party, court/tribunal/agency where litigation is filed, brief details of dispute litigation:

Show Cause Notice (SCN) dated April 10, 2026, from the Office of the Joint Commissioner of Joint Commissioner of Central GST, Audit Commissoinerate, Dehradun (“GST Authority”). The SCN was received on i.e. on April 16, 2026.

The SCN is primarily in regards to the demand of tax due to difference in ITC as reported in annual return GSTR-9 and ITC availed in GSTR-3B.

b) Expected financial implications, if any, due to compensation, penalty etc.;

The GST Authority has proposed to impose Goods & Services Tax of Rs. 10,46,80,941 [Rupees Ten crore forty-six lakh eighty thousand nine hundred forty-one only] and applicable interest and penalty thereon. The subsidiary, based on the advice of tax consultants, we will be filing appropriate response to the said notice.

c) Quantum of claims, if any.

Demand of total amount of Rs. 10,46,80,941 [Rupees Ten crore forty-six lakh eighty thousand nine hundred forty-one only] and interest and penalty thereon.

Further, there is no material impact on the financial, operations and/ or other activities of the Subsidiary/Company due to the said Notice.
