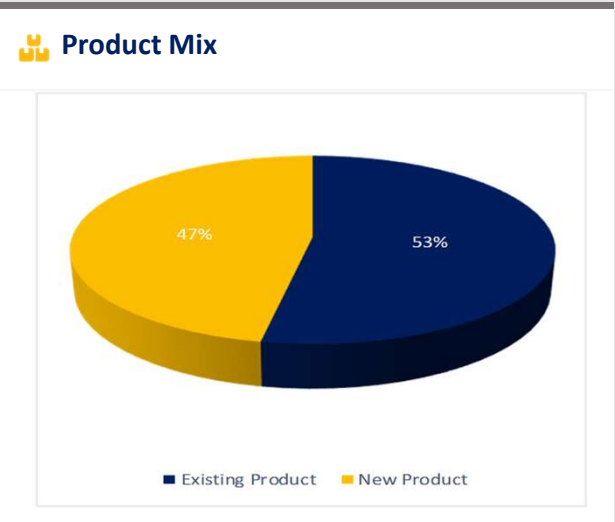
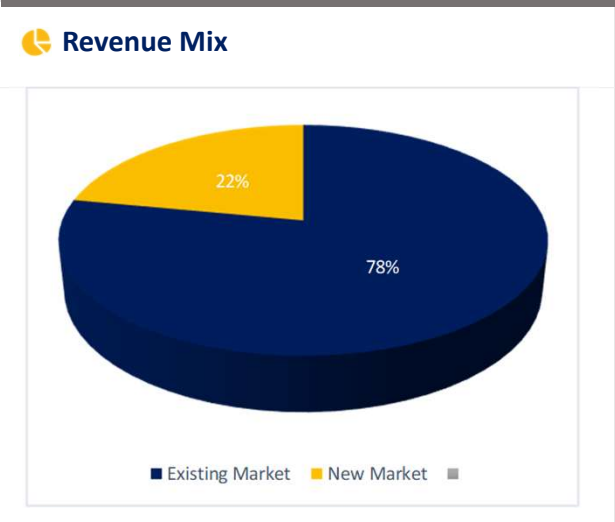
LCV Production Changes

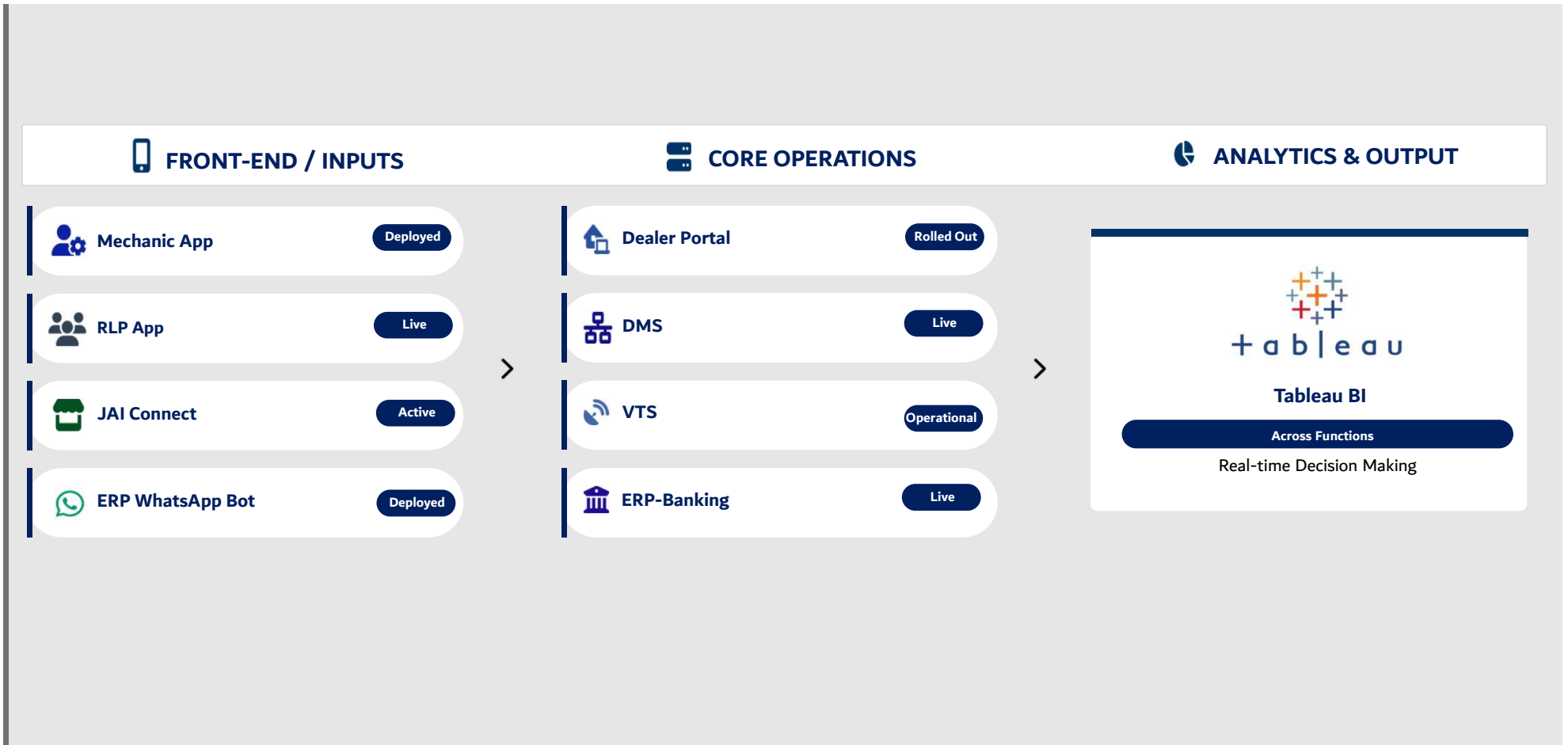
M&HCV Production Changes

REVENUE MIX & PRODUCT MIX

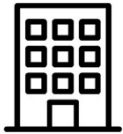

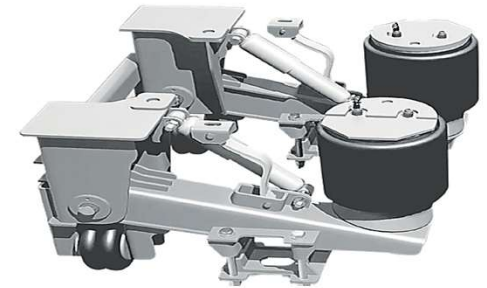

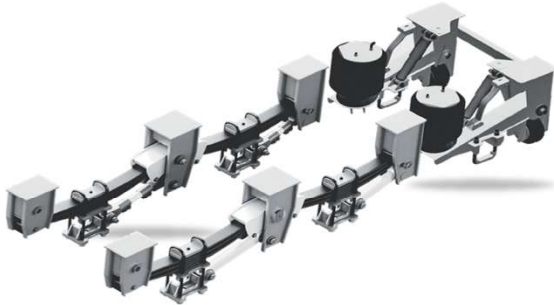

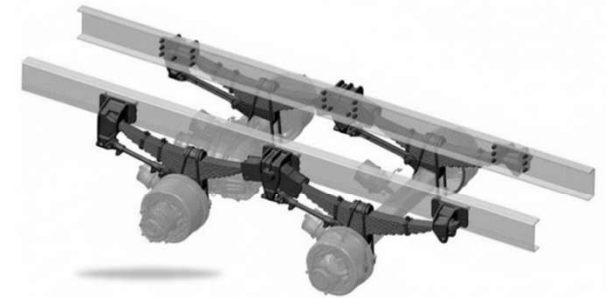
