5	Brief summary of the material contents of the communication received, including reasons for receipt of the communication	Show Cause Notice dated 12.04.2022 involving demand of ₹81.90 crore (differential GST on tubes and flaps) along with proposed Input tax credit disallowance of ₹30.62 crore and imposition of penalty thereon was initially issued by invoking Section 74 of the CGST Act. Also, various 27 states had issued respective Show Cause Notices raising tax demands. The matter has now been adjudicated under Section 73 by competent Authority in favour of the company by disposing off the Show Cause Notice in question with no additional tax demand and penalty. Also, the personal Show Cause Notice served upon Shri A.K. Kinra, Finance Director has also been dropped without any tax demand or penal consequences.

7	Expected financial implications on the listed company, if any	Refer point no. 5 above The Company had already voluntarily discharged the differential GST liability of ₹81.90 crore along with applicable interest and the same has been accepted by the adjudicating officer. Further, disallowance of ITC of ₹30.62 crore and penalty has also been dropped in the final order. Therefore, there is no further financial impact and/or adverse operational or regulatory consequences.
