6 suspects in donation theft hired on trust officials' word

SIT: Cash Seized From Loo Near Counting Room

Lucknow: Six of the eight-arrested suspects in the Ram temple embezzlement case got jobs in the shrine's donation-counting room based on recommendations by functionaries linked to the Shri Ram Janmabhoomi Teerth Kshetra Trust, according to the preliminary SIT report submitted to the UP govt last month.

Main accused Avinash Shukla and his alleged accomplices — Anulkalp Mishra, Lavkush Mishra, Manish Kumar Yadav, Karunesh Pandey and Ramashankar Mishra — were all hired as counting staff through Sainik Security Services, an outsourcing agency associated with SBI, the report states.

The induction of these six suspects into a team assigned to handle large amounts of cash and valuables donated by devotees was allegedly in violation of operational guidelines framed by the trust and SBI to ensure transparency and integrity in the process. The SIT report cites Manish's appointment on the recommendation of his uncle

Ramshankar Yadav, alias Tinnu, as one of the alleged transgressions.

Tinnu allegedly wielded influence in the donation-counting process and instructed Manish to submit his documents to SH employee Ramesh Chaturvedi, leading to his appointment, the report says. Manish joined the counting room on April 15.

CCTV footage from May 11 onwards shows him allegedly stealing donation money on multiple occasions.

SIT officials said the theft occurred not for want of safeguards but because of the authorities' failure to enforce them. A detailed framework governing the collection, counting and banking of donations had been put in place through an MoU and SOPs fi-

nished by the trust and SBI.

The probe report mentions minutes of official meetings on Sept 20, 2024, and Feb 6, 2025, signed by then SBI branch manager Govind Mishra and trust representative Dr Anil Mishra.

Based on the SOPs, donation vaults or hundi are to be opened only in the presence of authorised trust and bank representatives.

The rules also stipulate counting cash separately for each donation box.

For staff, biometric attendance, uniforms and frisking on entry and exit are mandatory. Personal belongings are barred inside the counting room.

The SIT found out that routine and surprise frisking of counting personnel, as man-

Adityanath: Oppn targets Sanatan

UP CM Yogi Adityanath Tuesday accused the Congress and Samajwadi Party of "attacking" Sanatan with their statements on the Ram temple donation theft row and asked why their mouths were "glued shut" when he came to waqf issues, reports **Kapil Dhilli**.

Addressing a public gathering in Pratappur, Yogi questioned the opposition's stance on waqf-related matters. "Why those who attack Hindu faith suddenly go silent — as if their mouths were sealed with Feticol — when it comes to the issue of waqf. Why the anti-NDA bloc remained muted when hectares of land across the nation were sold off in the name of the waqf," he said.

He said the Feb 2025 SOP was never carried out.

The report states that these failures went beyond procedural lapses, amounting to negligence that allegedly enabled theft and misappropriation of donations.

Investigators have so far seized Rs 79 lakh in cash, foreign currency and jewellery from the accused. Another Rs 2.25 lakh was found in a toilet adjoining the counting room, suggesting attempts to conceal stolen donations within the temple complex.

Trust treasurer bets on a CEO for mandir management

Ayodhya: A CEO with professional bureaucratic experience could have prevented the alleged theft of devotees' offerings at the Ram temple, trust treasurer Govind Dev Giri said.

"All of this happened due to the absence of a CEO. Oversight requires the discipline that professional bureaucrats bring. We did not have that kind of professional supervision in place and this was the result," Giri said Tuesday.

The remarks came a day after the trust decided to appoint a CEO and constituted a three-member committee to identify suitable candidates for the post.

While defending former

trust general secretary Champat Rai, who has resigned on moral grounds amid the row, Giri acknowledged lapses in supervision. "When I say he is innocent, I mean he could not possibly have had any personal involvement in this scandal..." However, one has to admit there was carelessness. After all, such a criminal was employed as a driver. He held the keys and controlled everything," Giri said, referring to Rai's aide Tinnu Yadav, who is one of the eight accused and has now been arrested. "I believe the driver executed all of this... he was connected to outsiders."

"All this was happening and nobody noticed. It is a matter of sorrow, anguish and shame for us. We feel ashamed because of it," he said.

Will respond to charges after SIT gives final report: Champat

Ayodhya: Breaking his silence on the temple donation theft controversy, Ram Temple Trust former general secretary and VHP international vice-president Champat Rai said Tuesday he would "respond to all charges" levelled against him "only after the SIT submits its final report".

In an open letter to "Ram bhaktis", Rai said, "News reports related to donation theft from 'hundi's of the temple surfaced for the first time on June 7. Several people have been levelling baseless and unverified allegations against me, but I decided to remain silent..."

Footage shows accused setting aside bundles of cash: Report

According to the report, this and CCTV footage point to alleged attempts to conceal or funnel misappropriated funds elsewhere. The footage purportedly shows Avinash Shukla setting aside and concealing



bundles of cash during counting on multiple occasions, investigators said. The recordings helped trace the money trail and identify the other suspects in the alleged theft.

The probe team has footage showing three suspects — Anulkalp Mishra, Lavkush Mishra and Karunesh Pandey — allegedly assisting Avinash in stealing and concealing donated cash. Another accused, Manish Kumar Yadav, is seen with him inside the counting room.
