## DFCCIL SETS NEW ENGINEERING BENCHMARK WITH RECORD RAIL FLYOVER GIRDER LAUNCH AT KALAMBOLI

- The above audited financial results of the Company for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2025 were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their meeting held on May 12, 2025. Further, Ms. M. R. Jyothy, Chairperson and Managing Director of the Company is duly authorized by the Board of Directors of the Company to sign the aforesaid financial results for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2025.
- The Board of Directors, at its meeting held on March 25, 2025, had approved the sale of the Company's entire equity stake in Jyothy Kallol Bangladesh Limited ('JKBL' or 'the Subsidiary') to Kallol Enterprise Limited ('KEL' or 'the Buyer'), for an aggregate consideration of Rs. 210 Lacs. This sale of investment has resulted into a loss of Rs. 370 lacs and Rs. 430 lacs shown under "Exceptional Items" in the standalone and consolidated statement of profit and loss respectively. JKBL ceased to be a subsidiary of the Company from March 25, 2025.
- During the quarter ended March 31, 2025, the Company has issued 5,867 equity shares of face value of Re 1 each, upon exercise of stock options granted under the Company's Employees Stock Unit Plan – 2023. Consequent to this allotment, the paid-up Equity Share Capital of the Company stands increased to 36,72,14,511 equity shares of face value of Re 1 each i.e. Rs 3,672 lacs.
- The Board of Directors has recommended final dividend of Rs.3.50 per equity share of Re 1 each for the financial year ended March 31, 2025. The same is subject to approval of the shareholders at the ensuing Annual General Meeting.
- The figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2025 and March 31, 2024 are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and unaudited published figures upto the third quarter for the respective years. Also the figures upto the third quarter had been reviewed and not subject to audit.
