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Redington Limited**Notes to the Statement of Unaudited Standalone/Consolidated Financial Results for the Quarter ended June 30, 2026**

1. The above financial results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee on July 28, 2026 and approved by the Board of Directors of Redington Limited (the "Company") on July 29, 2026. The limited review of unaudited standalone and consolidated financial results for the quarter ended June 30, 2026, has been carried out by statutory auditors.
2. The above financial results comprise the financial results of the Company and its subsidiaries (collectively referred to as the 'Group') and the Group's interest in its associate.
3. The figures for quarter ended March 31, 2026 as reported in these financial results are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the financial year ended March 31, 2026 and published year to date figures for the 9 months ended December 31, 2025 which were subjected to limited review by the statutory auditors.
4. The above financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 and Regulation 52(4) of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations").
5. Disclosure of reportable segments, "SISA" (Singapore, India & South Asia) and "ROW" (Rest of the World) have been made in a manner consistent with internal reporting to the Managing Director and Group Chief Executive Officer who is the Chief Operating Decision Maker ("CODM") for the Group, in line with provisions of Ind AS 108, *Operating Segment*.
6. During the quarter ended June 30, 2026,
 - i) The following step-down subsidiaries (wholly owned) have been incorporated,
 - PT Redington Technology Indonesia in Indonesia.
 - Redington (Thailand) Limited in Thailand.
 - ii) Redserv Business Solutions Private Limited, a step-down subsidiary (wholly owned) has completed its voluntarily strike-off and consequently ceased to be part of the Group.
7. Subsequent to the quarter ended June 30, 2026, Aladeem Al Ahmar for Computer and Mobile phone Trading and Services LLC a step-down subsidiary has been incorporated in Iraq.
8. The Company is continuing to assess the evolving situation in the Middle East to mitigate any prospective risks to its global footprint. For this purpose, the Company considered internal and external sources of information up to the date of approval of these financial results. Currently, while the operations are dynamically adapting to the ongoing situation, the Company does not foresee any material adverse effects on its financial position resulting from the geo-political conflict. The Company will continue to monitor developments and take appropriate measures, as necessary, to mitigate any potential risks.
9. Ind AS 29, "Financial Reporting in Hyperinflationary Economies", has been applied in respect of certain step-down subsidiaries having "Turkish Lira" as functional currency. The impact on the consolidated financial results is not significant.



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10. The Company has listed its commercial papers in the bourses of BSE and pursuant to such listing, below are the details computed based on standalone financial information of Redington Limited pursuant to Regulation 52(4) of the Listing Regulations:

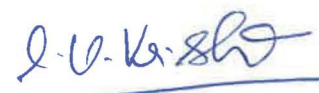

2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Company's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 and Regulation 52(4) of the Listing Regulations. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
3. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Unaudited Consolidated Financial Results of **Redington Limited** (the "Parent") which includes the branch of the Parent located at Singapore and its subsidiaries (the Parent and its subsidiaries together referred to as the "Group"), and its share of the net loss after tax and total comprehensive loss of its associate for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 (the "Statement") being submitted by the Parent pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 and Regulation 52(4) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations").
2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Parent's Management and approved by the Parent's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 and Regulation 52(4) of the Listing Regulations. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of Parent's personnel responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing specified under Section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the SEBI under Regulation 33(8) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, to the extent applicable.

4. The Statement includes the results of subsidiaries and associate listed in Annexure I.
5. Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and based on the consideration of the review reports of the other auditors referred to in paragraph 6 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standard and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 and Regulation 52(4) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.



6. We did not review the financial information of two overseas step-down subsidiaries included in the unaudited consolidated financial results, whose interim financial information reflect total revenues of Rs. 1,613.08 Crores for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 and total net loss after tax of Rs. 69.23 Crores for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 69.24 Crores for the quarter ended June 30, 2026, as considered in the Statement. The unaudited consolidated financial information also includes Group's share of loss after tax for Rs. Nil for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 and total comprehensive loss of Rs. Nil for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 as considered in the Statement, in respect of associate whose interim financial information have not been reviewed by us. These financial information have been reviewed by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these step-down subsidiaries and associate is based solely on the reports of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of this matter.
