Liquor stocks buzz after K'taka excise policy shift

Radico Khaitan, Globus, United Spirits, UBL soar up to 8%

Mumbai, 6 March

Shares of breweries and distilleries rose as much as 9 per cent on the National Stock Exchange (NSE) on Friday, before closing about 8 per cent higher in an otherwise weak market. The gains come after the Karnataka government announced a major overhaul of its six-decade-old excise policy, and shifted to a global taxation standard, with complete deregulation of alcohol pricing.

Among individual stocks, Radico Khaitan (₹2,766.90), United Breweries (₹1,758.20) and Tilaknagar Industries (₹450.55) closed with gains of 6-8 per cent each on Friday. United Spirits (₹1,389.80), Allied Blenders and Distillers (₹474.60) and Globus Spirits (₹867.60) were up 3-5 per cent each. By comparison, the Nifty 50 was down 1.27 per cent at 24,450.45 on Friday.

Presenting his 17th Budget, Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah introduced the Alcohol-in-Beverage (AIB) excise duty structure. Starting April 2026, taxes will be levied based on actual alcohol content rather than total volume. This transition will be phased in over the next three to four years to avoid market disruption.

Under the proposed reforms, government-administered price fixation will be deregulated, allowing producers to place their products within pricing slabs, based on market considerations instead of seeking government approval. Moreover, the total number of price slabs for alcoholic beverages will be rationalised from 16 to eight.

While technology-led steps will be taken to prevent the government's revenue loss from the sector, measures towards ease of doing business, including auto-

renewal of manufacturing licences among others, are also to follow.

The announcements are important and seen in positive light for the alcohol industry, as Karnataka is among the top consuming states of liquor, brandy and beer in the country, and also among the heavily regulated and taxed.

The state government also plans to promote tourism linked to the alcohol industry, by allowing distilleries and breweries to conduct tasting sessions and sell products manufactured on their premises to visiting tourists.

In an update on the alcoholic beverages sector, Emkay Global Financial Services said that the tax hikes in the state Budget have been relatively low, against expectations of sharp hikes, given that the state government needs to fund social welfare schemes.

Amid state Budgets announced so far, Uttar Pradesh (UP) remains a progressive state, with policy changes in the state Budget aligned to boost consump-

tion and develop opportunities in the state. While beneficial for all players through increased transparency, Radico Khaitan stands as the primary beneficiary of regulatory shifts in its fortress state, Emkay Global Financial said.

The excise policy for 2026-27 sets an all-time-high revenue target of ₹71,278 crore, which is 13 per cent higher than the current fiscal target of ₹60,000 crore. The Uttar Pradesh Excise Policy 2026-27 presents a structural shift that favours transparency (transaction via portal), premiumisation (label registration fee reduced, allowing domestic super-premium brands in premium vends), export-led growth (reduced fees for exports of bulk alcohol as well as bottled products). The state is pivoting toward a 'Cash and Carry' retail model, which effectively eliminates credit risk for wholesalers and shifts the duty burden to the point of retail procurement, the brokerage firm said.



WOMEN HOME LOAN BORROWERS

Co-borrowers must ensure they are co-owners of property

Women are emerging as an important borrower segment in India's credit ecosystem. According to a March 4 report by CRIF High Mark, a credit bureau, women account for 33.2 per cent of home loan originations by value, with a higher average ticket size of ₹33.9 lakh compared with ₹30.7 lakh for men (December 2025 data).

Benefits for women borrowers
Many banks and housing finance companies (HFCs) offer women interest rates about 5 basis points (0.05 percentage points) to 50 basis points (0.50 percentage points) lower than the standard rates. "When a woman applies as a co-borrower with her spouse, lenders consider the combined income, which increases overall loan eligibility. Loan approvals are also faster when both applicants have stable incomes and good credit profiles," says Raoul Kapoor, co-CEO, Andromeda Sales and Distribution.

Checks single women should run

Single women borrowers should avoid taking the maximum loan they are eligible for and instead keep the EMI within 30-40 per cent of their monthly take-home income. They should also maintain an emergency fund covering 6-12 months of EMIs and household expenses. "Borrowers should also consider home loan protection or term insurance and ensure job stability," says Kapoor.

Risks for women co-borrowers

Women who borrow along with their spouses should remember that co-borrowers are equally responsible for loan repayment. Another key issue is property ownership. "In some cases, women are co-borrowers but not co-owners, which means they may not receive legal ownership despite sharing repayment liability," says Kapoor. "Ideally, co-borrowing should also include co-ownership, ensuring financial responsibility and

property rights remain aligned," says Amit Prakash Singh, co-founder and chief business officer, Urban Money.

Credit score risks and precautions

If EMIs are delayed or there is a loan default, the negative repayment history appears in the credit records of both borrowers. The woman co-borrower's credit score also suffers. "Women borrowers should monitor the loan account and maintain repayment buffers. They should also build an independent credit profile to ensure joint loans remain a pathway to asset ownership rather than a shared credit risk," says Singh.

Factor in career breaks

When a young couple plans a home loan, they should factor in the possibility of temporary career breaks for childbirth or childcare. "A prudent approach is to assess affordability assuming only the

more stable income so that EMIs remain manageable if one income pauses. Ideally, the EMI should not exceed 30-35 per cent of that single income," says Sanjeev Govila, certified financial planner and CEO, Hum Fauji Initiatives, a financial advisory firm. Couples should also maintain a contingency fund covering 6-12 months of EMIs and expenses, opt for adequate term insurance for the primary earner, and avoid stretching the loan amount too aggressively.

Tax benefits in joint home loans

Home loan tax benefits on principal repayment and interest are available only if the individual is both a co-borrower and a co-owner of the property. "If a woman is only a co-borrower without ownership rights, she is generally not eligible to claim tax deductions. Women should ensure their name is included in the property title if they want these benefits," says Vipin Upadhyay, partner, King Stubb & Kasiva, Advocates and Attorneys.

Safeguarding property rights

Women should take certain legal and financial precautions to protect their interests. "They should ensure their name is included as a co-owner in the property title. They should also maintain records of financial contributions, such as EMIs or down payments, and review the loan agreement and ownership structure carefully," says Upadhyay. In case of divorce, ownership rights and documented contributions can significantly influence property claims or settlement terms.

Converting large credit card purchases into equated monthly instalments (EMIs) helps manage expensive purchases without straining monthly cash flow. However, it may quietly increase overall cost if used without careful evaluation. A credit card EMI allows a cardholder to split a high-value transaction into fixed monthly repayments over a

chosen tenure, typically ranging from three to 24 months. The entire purchase value is blocked against the card's credit limit until the EMI is fully repaid.

Using credit card EMIs

Most banks offer multiple options to convert transactions into EMIs.

- Select EMI option at checkout

while making an online or offline purchase

- Customers may convert eligible transactions later through mobile or internet banking
- Avail of post-purchase EMI offers shared by the card issuer
- Eligibility depends on available credit limit, transaction size, repayment track record and card variant.

What to consider

- Small EMIs may mask the actual borrowing cost
- EMI interest rates range from 12 per cent to 24 per cent annually
- Processing fee of 1-3 per cent of transaction value may be charged
- A foreclosure charge is applicable if EMI is paid before tenure completion
