1. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (hereinafter referred to as the said "MCA") permitted holding of the AGM through VC/OAVM, without physical presence of the Members at a common venue. Accordingly, in compliance with the MCA Circulars, AGM of the Company is being held through VC/OAVM. [General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020 and 17/2020 dated 13th April, 2020, in relation to "Clarification on passing of ordinary and special resolutions by companies under the Companies Act, 2013", General Circular Nos. 20/2020 dated 5th May, 2020 and subsequent circulars issued in this regard, the latest being 03/2025 dated 22nd September, 2025, collectively referred to as "MCA Circulars"]

In view of the above, it has been decided to convene the 34th AGM of the Company through VC / OAVM only. The deemed venue for the 34th AGM shall be the Registered Office of the Company. As the AGM is being conducted through VC / OAVM, the facility for appointment of Proxy by the Members is not available for this AGM and hence the Proxy Form and Attendance Slip including Route Map are not annexed to this Notice

2. Members attending the AGM through VC / OAVM shall be reckoned for the purpose of quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act)

3. The Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 and 110 of the Act read with applicable Rules setting out all material facts of the businesses specified above is annexed hereto. Brief profiles and other additional information pursuant to Regulation 36 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (SEBI Listing Regulations) and Secretarial Standard on General Meetings issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, in respect of directors seeking re-appointment is also annexed to the Notice.

4. 11.Transfer of Unclaimed/Unpaid amounts to the Investor Education and Protection Fund (IEPF):

15. Procedure for ‘remote e-voting’ and e-voting at the AGM



In accordance with the provisions of Section 108 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and amendments thereto and applicable provisions of the SEBI Listing Regulations, the Company has engaged the services of MUFG Intime India Private Limited to provide the facility of voting through electronic means to the members to enable them to cast their votes electronically in respect of all the businesses to be transacted at the aforesaid Meeting.

The Company is providing facility for voting by electronic means (e-voting) through an electronic voting system which will include remote e-voting as prescribed by the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 as presently in force and the business set out in the Notice shall be transacted through such e-voting facility.

Voting rights of the members for voting through remote e-voting or e-voting system provide in the Meeting itself shall be in proportion to shares of the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the **cut-off date i.e. Thursday, 20th August, 2026**. A person, whose name is recorded in the Register of Members or in the Register of Beneficial owners (as at the end of the business hours) maintained by the depositories as on the cut-off date shall only be entitled to avail the facility of remote e-voting or e-voting facility to be provide in the Meeting. In case of joint holders attending the Meeting, only such joint holder who is higher in the order of names shall be entitled to vote.

The remote **e-voting facility shall commence on Monday, 24th August, 2026 (9:00 a.m.IST) and ends on Wednesday, 26th August, 2026 (5:00 pm IST)**. The e- voting Module shall be disabled by MUFG Intime India Private Limited for voting thereafter. Once the vote on a resolution is cast by a member, it cannot be changed subsequently.

The facility of e-voting through the same portal provided by MUFG Intime India Private Limited will be available during the Meeting through VC also to those Members who do not cast their votes by remote e-voting prior to the Meeting. Members, who cast their votes by remote e-voting, may attend the Meeting through VC but shall not be entitled to cast their votes once again.

The Scrutiniser (Deep Shukla & Associates, Company Secretaries) shall, immediately after the conclusion of voting at the AGM, unblock the votes cast through remote e-voting in the presence of at least two witnesses not in the employment of the Company and will make, not later than 48 hours from the conclusion of the AGM, a consolidated scrutiniser's report of the total votes cast in favour or against, if any, to the Chairperson or a person authorised by him in writing who shall countersign the same. The Chairperson or a person authorised by him in writing will declare the results of voting forthwith.

The voting results declared along with the report of the scrutinizer shall be placed on the Company's website at www.kilitch.com and on the website of MUFG Intime India Private Limited immediately after the result is declared by the Chairman and simultaneously communicated to the Stock Exchanges.
