Krystal Targets ₹300–350 Crore Annual Revenue from City Lighting & Urban Infrastructure Business

Acquires 100% Stake in Citelum India from France Government Owned EDF Group

Citelum India

Mumbai, 12th August, 2026: Krystal Integrated Services Limited (KISL), a well-diversified provider of integrated facility management, staffing solutions, security services, catering and waste management services across India announced that the Company has acquired 100% equity stake in Citelum India Private Limited ("Citelum India") from its current shareholders including Citelum S.A.S., France. Citelum India will become a wholly owned subsidiary of Krystal Integrated Services Limited.

The acquisition marks Krystal's entry into the City Lighting & Urban Infrastructure segment and forms part of its strategy to build an engineering-led infrastructure services business. Krystal is targeting annual revenue of ₹300–350 crore from the new vertical over the next 3–4 years and plans to invest approximately ₹100 crores in engineering capabilities, technology platforms and business expansion. The Company plans to scale its operations across 30–40 cities in 12–15 states, with infrastructure services expected to contribute 12–15% of consolidated revenues.

Strategic Rationale

- This acquisition marks Krystal's entry into city lighting and urban infrastructure services supported by increasing investments in energy-efficient public infrastructure and city development initiatives.
- Integrates Citelum India's expertise in city lighting and urban infrastructure services with Krystal's facility management and technical operations platform.
- Strengthens the Company's ability to deliver end-to-end infrastructure services particularly for long-term operations and maintenance projects.
- Krystal intends to build on Citelum India's domain expertise and expand the Company's operations across a wider spectrum of electrical infrastructure services including connected lighting, smart metering, EV charging infrastructure and other city-focused electrical solutions.

Commenting on the performance, Mr. Sanjay Dighe, CEO & Whole Time Director, Krystal Integrated Services Ltd, said,

Krystal Integrated Services Limited took a strategic step toward strengthening its presence in infrastructure-linked services through the acquisition of Citelum India Private Limited, a company operating in the city lighting and urban infrastructure services segment.

Urban infrastructure in India is witnessing growing investment driven by urbanization, increasing focus on energy efficiency and public infrastructure development.
