### **Sub: Intimation under regulation 30 of SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015**

We refer to the above captioned subject and our intimation to the exchanges dated 21<sup>st</sup> May 2025 regarding the receipt of notice from National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) Issuing Show Cause Notice to the Concessionaire i.e. KNR Ramanattukara Infra Private Limited (wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company) and Promoter of the Concessionaire i.e. KNR Constructions Limited to respond within 15 days with respect to failure of Main Carriageway & Service Road and associated structures (Retaining wall & RE Wall) in the project stretch from Ch 276.8 to Ch 277.05 on 19.05.2025 and suspending the Concessionaire i.e. KNR Ramanattukara Infra Private Limited, from participating in ongoing/future bidding for 1 month period or completion of investigation by the expert committee whichever is later.

In continuation, we herewith intimate that the Concessionaire (KNR Ramanattukara Infra Private Limited) and the Company have provided their comprehensive replies to NHAI and subsequently the Concessionaire approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, seeking relief from NHAI's order of suspension from participating in on-going/future bidding process.

The Company is in receipt of the copy of order passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi on 21<sup>st</sup> July 2025 at 08.06 PM and brief details of the order are mentioned hereunder:

- The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi is of the considered opinion that the impugned order by NHAI has lived its life and further observed that under the guise of suspension, the bar on petitioner's right to bid in future bidding seems to be a drastic measure.
- The investigation is completed and also the one-month period as mentioned in the NHAI's letter is completed/expired, therefore, the suspension order should not be treated as disqualification anymore.
- The department, however, shall be at liberty to take further action in accordance with the extant policy.
- At this stage, no further observations are necessary, however, the respondent's counsel shall be at liberty to place on record the Department's comprehensive reply before the next date of hearing i.e. 25<sup>th</sup> July 2025.
