## Selamba riot 'witness' arrested for staging attack, inflicting wounds on minor daughter

THE NARMADA police Tuesday arrested two persons, including a "witness" in the communal clash that broke out in Selamba town on September 29 during the Shaurya Yatra procession taken out by the Vishwa Hindu Parishad (VHP), for allegedly "staging an assault to incite communal discord" in the area.

The accused "witness", Wasim Salim Shaikh, has also been booked under sections of the Juvenile Justice Act for inflicting injuries on his minor daughter during the "staged assault".

Following the communal riot and arson on September 29, Shaikh had filed a complaint at the Sagbara police station on October 6 alleging he had received death

threats over the phone for being a witness in the case against 21 accused from the other community, who were allegedly involved in setting fire to goods from the shop of Wasim's brother Sajid during the riot, Narmada Superintendent of Police Prashant Sumbe said Tuesday.

On October 7, Shaikh and his minor daughter sought medical assistance for knife cuts allegedly sustained during an attack on him while he was returning from the Sagbara police station after taking a copy of the FIR he filed a day earlier.

"Wasim told the police that he received the first death threat on a WhatsApp call on October 2 in which the caller purportedly asked him to withdraw names of the 21 accused from the FIR filed at Sagbara police station earlier. On October 5, while I was

holding a peace committee meeting with members of both communities, Wasim was present and received another "threat" call during the meeting. We filed an FIR the following day at Sagbara police station and traced the SIM card from which he had received the threat call to a man in Mumbai, who said he had handed it over to another person for use, who in turn had given it to a person named Nadeem. When we questioned Nadeem, he confessed that he had made the threat call at the instructions of Wasim during the meeting," said Sumbe.

The police also summoned members of the Child Welfare Committee (CWC) while recording the statement of Wasim's minor daughter who had also sustained injuries in the alleged attack on October 7. "When the

child was questioned by women police officials and also members of CWC in the presence of her mother and (personnel with) body-worn cameras, she told us that her father had attacked her and then called for help. She said that while they were returning from Sagbara police station (on October 7), Wasim stopped the vehicle at a deserted location and used a radium cutter to inflict wounds on his daughter and himself before calling people for help... It seems that the motive was to attract attention and also fan the communal discord in the area... We have also taken up counselling for the child along with members of CWC. The child is a victim," Sumbe said.

The police are also investigating if others are involved in the incident while Wasim and Nadeem

have been booked under Indian Penal Code Sections 153-A (promoting enmity between different groups), 181 (false statement on oath or affirmation to public servant) as well as sections of the Juvenile Justice Act.

Wasim's was the fourth FIR since the incident occurred on September 29. Earlier, the Sagbara police had lodged three FIRs, including two based on cross-complaints filed by members of the two communities. The third complaint was filed by the police against 26 identified people belonging to both the communities. While traders had shut their shops for close to a week after the incident, the district police held meetings with locals and community members of both sides to assure law and order in the town and have the markets open back to normal a few days ago.

## Sanghavi: State police has seized drugs from Punjab jails, Kolkata

THE GUJARAT Police has seized drugs from Punjab jails as well as from Kolkata, Minister of State for Home Harsh Sanghavi said in Gandhinagar on Tuesday.

He was speaking at Sabarmati Samvad, organised at the Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India by Panchjanya - the weekly Hindi magazine published by RSS.

"Drugs have become a fashion status of Western countries. India is safe against it even today. Gujarat Police seizes drugs amid strong sea waves and fighting bullets. This is the Gujarat model. Gujarat (Police) has seized drugs from Kolkata... from Punjab jails, too..." he said.

When asked by Panchjanya editor Hitesh Shankar how much support did he receive from West

Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee, Punjab CM Bhagwant Mann and AAP chief Arvind Kejriwal when Gujarat Police did "dadagiri" in states like West Bengal and Punjab, Sanghavi said, "Ladai me dadagiri kami padti hai (there is need for dadagiri in a fight) and we will do that too. Those people say a very selective thank you."

Admitting that drug menace is a major social issue, Sanghavi said, "Drugs is a major issue and the fight will continue. We have a zero tolerance policy against it."

He added that due to the prevailing political situation in Afghanistan, the business of smuggling drugs from there has increased. "But we are vigilant... We will fight a tough battle against drugs and save the youth of our state and the country," he said.

Asked about removal of encroachment from coastal towns, Sanghavi said some houses in

these areas were used as "landing and storage points" for drugs coming from Pakistan, Iran and Afghanistan. These houses were illegal and have been removed, he added.

On the anti-encroachment drive at Somnath temple, Sanghavi said that government land was encroached upon at the temple by some groups for commercial use. "We removed those encroachments for people's facilities... In the coming days, the Bhupendra Patel government will set up facilities for the people there. Encroachment of any type on government land will be removed in a similar manner."

Sanghavi appealed to everyone to visit GIFT City. "When (PM Narendra) Modiji had shared his idea (of GIFT City), so called intellectuals had said these are mere talks. Today, all those people too are singing praise of Modiji after visiting GIFT City," he said.

## Keep ambulances, doctors ready at event venues: Govt to Garba organisers

Ahmedabad: The organisers of commercial garba events in towns and cities will have to deploy an ambulance and a medical team at the venue so that participants get aid immediately in case of health emergency, the Gujarat government said Tuesday.

The health and family welfare department has issued a circular to this effect, Health Minister Rushikesh Patel said. The circular, issued on Monday, did not mention any punitive action if it was

not complied with, but the minister said organisers will be given permission only after they give an assurance about compliance.

The nine-day Navratri festival starts from October 15.

The intention behind the directive was that participants get timely treatment in case of emergencies "such as blood pressure issue or snake bite," Patel, also the government spokesperson, told mediapersons in Gandhinagar. The health department, too,

will deploy its own ambulances and medical teams at strategic spots, he said.

Citing the circular, Patel said doctors and other staff at government hospitals and health centres situated close to garba venues have been asked to remain on duty till midnight during Navratri. "We have also alerted the staff in rural areas to stay prepared to either attend to medical emergencies or refer patients to larger hospitals," he added. PTI

## MoUs worth Rs 5,300 cr signed at Vibrant Vadodara Summit

"Narendra Modi had initiated

the Vibrant Gujarat Summit in 2003 and it has resulted in an industrial and commercial development, thus giving rise to employment; now, under Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel, this Vibrant Summit has been brought down to individual districts from Dang to Danta in order to encourage investments in all areas of Gujarat and increase the scope of development in the state. The paracetamol tablet produced in Vadodara has been included in the One District, One Product campaign," said Sanghavi.

## RMC got over 8K applications to regularise unauthorised constructions

Rajkot: Over 8,000 property owners of Rajkot have so far applied to get their unauthorised constructions regularised under the Gujarat Regularisation of Unauthorised Development Act, 2022 by paying an impact fee. Rajkot Municipal Corporation said Tuesday.

An official release said RMC has received 8,058 applications seeking to regularise unauthorised additional constructions done after getting building-use (BU) certificate for the respective buildings. They include 2,681 applications from the central zone of RMC, 1,482 in the east zone and 3,895 in the west zone.

The window opened by the state government on October 17 last year is set to complete a year. Originally, the window was to remain open only till February 16. However, it was extended by four more months and subsequently, by another six months. Now, the last date of filing an application to avail the benefit of the scheme is December 16, 2023. ENS

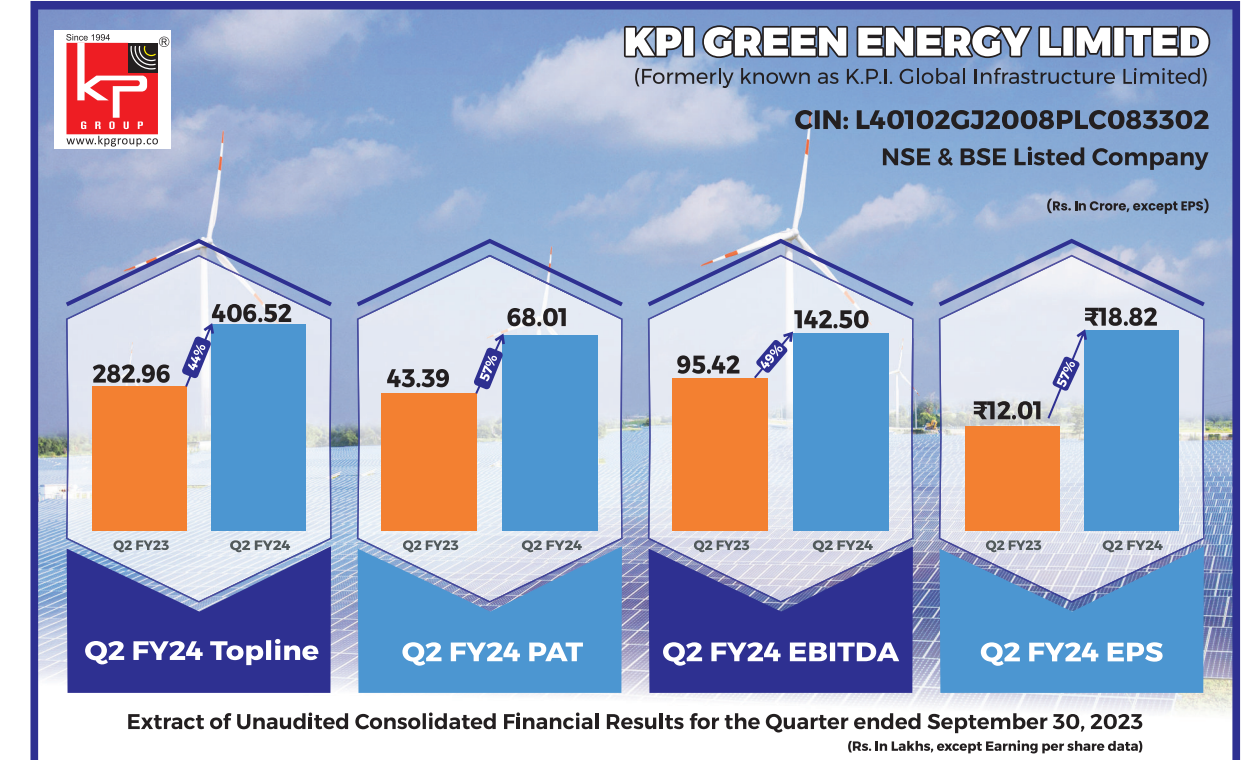

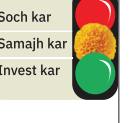
