Led by the state Congress leaders, a large number of party workers on Monday staged a protest outside the Greater Mohali Development Area (GMADA) office in Mohali near here, raising slogans against the land pooling policy and seeking its immediate withdrawal.

Addressing party workers, state Congress president Amarinder Singh Raja Warring said it was a subtle ploy of the ruling Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government to loot and rob the farmers of their precious land. "This is not land pooling, but land looting policy," he said.

Warring said that the chief minister Bhagwant Mann should have learnt from Prime Minister Narendra Modi's experience, who eventually had to surrender and withdraw the three farm laws under pressure from the farmers. The party also submitted a memorandum, addressed to the chief minister, to the GMADA administrator seeking immediate reversal of the policy. The leaders said the party would continue to hold protests across the state in days to come.

HOUSE THAT | AI crash probe, key discussions mark day one STORMY START TO MONSOON SESSION

Day one of Monsoon Session of Parliament, on Monday, witnessed chaos, questions and adjournment with the Opposition members trying to corner government in both Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha by seeking immediate discussions on the Pahalgalam terror attack, Operation Sindoore, US President Donald Trump's statement on ceasefire and the Special Intensive Revision undertaken by the Election Commission in Bihar.

The Opposition also walked out of the Rajya Sabha after its demand for a discussion on the Special Intensive Revision in Bihar by the Election Commission ahead of the Assembly elections there was turned down by the Chair.

The adjournments happened despite Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kiren Rijju and Defence Minister Rajnath Singh assuring the Houses that the government was prepared for discussions on these issues. Rijju had also announced that the Business Advisory Committee meetings would be held for both the Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha during the day to plan the agenda of the proceedings.

The Lok Sabha adjourned four times on the first day of the session. After the obituary references and paying respects to those killed in the Pahalgalam

AVIATION MIN DEFENDS PROBE PANEL

Union Civil Aviation Minister K Rammoan Naidu, on Monday, refuted allegations that the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB) panel investigating the Ahmedabad Air India AI171 crash lacked experts. Speaking in the Rajya Sabha during Question Hour, Naidu clarified that two subject matter experts are engaged with the investigation team, along with other industry engineers. He also highlighted the presence of an International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) observer from the UN, dismissing the allegations as 'baseless.'

Naidu emphasised that even pilots are part of the panel, addressing various concerns.

The committee, chaired by BJP MP Baijayan Panda, has proposed over 285 changes to the Bill, which was introduced on February 13, 2025, and subsequently referred to the panel for review. Fight against BJP's 'linguistic terrorism': Didi at Martyrs' Day rally

Sharpening her 'Bengali asmita' pitch ahead of the 2026 polls, West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Monday accused the BJP of unleashing "linguistic terrorism" on Bengalis, asserting that the fight for identity and language will continue until the saffron party is defeated.

Addressing a massive Martyrs' Day rally in Kolkata, Banerjee gave a clarion call to defeat the BJP in the assembly elections and eventually oust it from power at the Centre.

This was the last Martyrs' Day rally before the crucial 2026 Assembly elections.

"If needed, there will be a second language movement against the BJP's terrorism on the Bengali language... From July 27, a movement will start in Bengal in protest against the attack on Bengalis, Bengali language and 'Bhasha santras' (linguistic terrorism)," she announced.

EARLY LIFE

Born in 1923 in Alappuzha district to a poor family, Achuthanandan rose from humble beginnings to become Kerala's 11th Chief Minister in 2006 after decades of political activism. His tenure was marked by bold land reforms, environmental crackdowns and an uncompromising fight against corruption—often earning him enemies within and outside his own party.

A BELOVED FIGURE

Known for his austere lifestyle and sharp tongue, he remained a CPI(M) politburo member for over two decades before

END OF AN ERA

His death marks the end of an era for the Indian Left. He is survived by his son and a legacy that few contemporary politicians can hope to match. The Kerala government has declared a public holiday on Tuesday in the departed leader's honour.
