Cheers & jeers ahead of FTA deal

Even as India and the United Kingdom are all set to ink on Thursday a landmark Free Trade Agreement (FTA), a move expected to unlock billions in trade and investment opportunities for both nations, the Congress on Wednesday claimed that serious questions have emerged on its impact on India's domestic industry.

HOW INDIA BENEFITS

Nearly 99% of Indian goods sent to the UK will now enjoy zero-duty access. This will eliminate existing tariffs that range from 4% to 16%, especially benefiting sectors like textiles, leather, footwear, toys, marine products, gems and jewellery, and engineering goods, including auto components and electric vehicles.

Indian workers in the UK will no longer have to contribute to UK social security for a period of up to three years. This move is expected to save Indian workers and companies around Rs 4,000 crore every year.

Chefs, yoga instructors, musicians, and other contractual workers will now get temporary access to the UK job market, giving a boost to India's services sector.

Congress general secretary in-charge communications Jaiaram Ramesh said, "The Super Premium Frequent Flier jets out of India again today -- this time to the UK and the Maldives. The London trip is for the signing of the India-UK Free Trade Agreement (FTA), which will in fact have pernicious consequences for numerous stakeholders."

The FTA's significant consequences would be on the micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs), which are the backbone of India's economy, the largest employers of India's workers, Ramesh claimed in a post on X.

The party said automobile manufac-

turers will similarly be impacted, as will the pharmaceutical industry.

The FTA would allow British firms to participate in the procurement of goods and services of non-sensitive central government entities.

Cong said this will open up a huge market of an estimated USD 600 billion to UK firms, he said.

For the first time, India has agreed to patent rules that go beyond the WTO's Agreement on Trade Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights. This is a historic shift in the Indian Government's policy and signifies a submission to the big pharmaceutical lobby," Ramesh said.

likely to rise as well. The UK is already India's 6th-largest foreign investor, with \$36 billion invested so far. With the FTA in place, fresh investments are expected in sectors like manu-

facturing, automobiles, and electric mobility. Several key Indian companies stand to gain significantly from the deal. These include Welspun India, Arvind Ltd, Relaxo, Tata

Motors, Mahindra Electric, and Bharat Forge, among others. Reduced trade barriers will help these companies expand their presence in the UK market more easily.

HOW UK GAINS FROM FTA

The Free Trade Agreement brings significant advantages for the UK, especially through reduced tariffs on its key exports. Tariffs on 90% of UK goods will be removed, giving a strong boost to sectors like whisky, gin, automobiles, and food items. For example, the current 150% tariffs on Scotch whisky and gin will gradually drop to 75%, and then to 40% over ten years. Similarly, car tariffs will fall from 100% to just 10%. Products like cosmetics, chocolates, biscuits, salmon, and medical devices will also get tariff relief, making them more competitive in the Indian market.

UK manufacturers in sectors like machinery, aerospace, and automobiles are expected to benefit significantly. Big brands such as Jaguar Land Rover, Aston Martin, and Diageo are likely to see increased exports. British consumers may also benefit from lower prices on Indian imports, including both goods and services.

The deal also provides UK companies greater access to Indian government contracts. Under the FTA, British firms can bid for Indian non-sensitive government tenders worth over Rs 2 billion. This opens up access to around 40,000 tenders annually, valued at Rs 4.09 lakh crore.

US claims at UNSC of de-escalating Indo-Pak Conflict; India affirms it was resolved bilaterally

The United States brought to the Security Council President Donald Trump's claim of having resolved the India-Pakistan conflict in May, but New Delhi reaffirmed that it was resolved bilaterally.

Acting US Representative Dorothy Shea listed on Tuesday the conflict between India and Pakistan following the terrorist massacre in Pahalgam by The Resistance Front as one of those de-escalated by "US leadership" in the last three months, repeating an assertion Trump has made often.

"The United States, under President Trump's leadership, played an important role in encouraging the parties to reach these resolutions, which we applaud and support", she said.

India's Permanent Representative P Harish said firmly that it was "directly concluded" at Pakistan's request to India.

Operation Sindoor "on achieving its primary objectives, a cessation of military activities was directly concluded at the request of Pakistan", he said.

Harish said that Operation Sindoor, launched in retaliation for the massacre of 26 people by The Resistance Front, an offshoot of Lashkar-e-Tayyiba based in and backed by Pakistan, "was focused, measured, and non-escalatory in nature".

The operation was motivated by the Council statement on "the need to hold perpetrators, organisers, financiers and sponsors" of the Pahalgam attack accountable, and it targeted terrorist camps in Pakistan and Pakistan-occupied Jammu and Kashmir, he said.

BJP MP's son, facing trial for stalking, appointed law officer

The BJP Rajya Sabha MP and former Haryana BJP chief Subhash Barala's son Vikas Barala has been appointed as Assistant Advocate General (AAG) in Haryana at the Advocate General (AG) Delhi office.

The case was registered on the complaint on Varnika and trial in the case is pending before a Chandigarh court with the next hearing in the case being August 2, 2025. Vikas is currently out on bail.

According to the complainant, she was heading to her home in Chandigarh on August 4 night when she noticed a car following her and its occupants, Vikas and Anish allegedly attempted to block her path and tried to enter her vehicle.

Initially the Chandigarh police booked them under Section 354D (stalking) of the IPC and relevant sections of the Motor Vehicles Act, though subsequently, charges of attempting to abduct her were added after widespread criticism of police functioning.

The Chandigarh court framed charges against the duo on October 13, 2017 and Vikas remained in jail for about five months and appeared in his law exams during the period.

According to media reports, Vikas's appointment was recommended by a screening committee comprising two retired judges of the high court. The order regarding his appointment was

Vikas and his friend Ashish Kumar were booked on August 5, in 2017 for allegedly stalking and attempting to kidnap RJ Varnika Kundu, daughter of a senior IAS officer V S Kundu (now retired)



issued by the home secretary on July 18 last - Vikas and four other law officers were appointed by the Haryana government for the state's legal cell in Delhi.

Notably, the Haryana Law Officers (Engagements) Act, 2016, bars only appointment/engagement of a person, who has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude.

The other four law officers include Anu Pal, sister of Justice Lisa Gill of Punjab and Haryana High Court, Swati Batra, daughter of former High Court judge Lalita Batra, Ruchi Sekhri, a BJP leader from Punjab and Nitin Kaulsh, son of Punjab's former chief secretary Sarvesh Kaulsh.

Odisha: Man found with throat slit

KENDRAPARA: A 40-year-old man was found with his throat slit in Odisha's Kendrapara district, police said.

The man was rescued by locals and taken to a nearby hospital in a critical condition and later shifted to Cuttack's SCB Medical College and Hospital, where he is currently undergoing treatment.

The man was identified as Satyajit Sarangi.

Al-Qaeda terror module busted by Guj ATS

The Anti-Terrorism Squad (ATS) of Gujarat Police on Wednesday arrested four terror suspects, allegedly linked to Al-Qaeda, for running a fake currency racket and spreading the global terror group's ideology.

The accused have been identified as Mohd Faiq from Delhi, Mohd Fardeen from

Ahmedabad, Sefullah Kureshi from Modasa in Aravalli district and Zeeshan Ali from Noida.

They used social media platforms and suspicious apps to spread al-Qaeda's ideology and used an auto-delete app to clean any trace of their communication footprint, sources said, according to a report by NDTV.

"Terror module affiliated

with Al-Qaeda in the Indian Subcontinent (AQIS) has been busted by the Gujarat ATS. Four persons linked to the proscribed terror outfit have been arrested," the anti-terror agency said in a statement, PTI reported.

AQIS is a regional affiliate of the Al-Qaeda network and has been involved in radicalization and recruitment activities across South Asia.

The ATS will provide further details about the operation later in the day.

The four came in the ATS radar after they were detected discussing terror activities in the state. The Gujarat ATS said they are analysing the chats and social media handles.

SIR: TEJASHWI HINTS AT POLL BOYCOTT

RJD leader Tejashwi Yadav on Wednesday created a flutter in political circles when he hinted at a possible boycott of the upcoming assembly election over the special intensive revision (SIR) of the electoral rolls in Bihar.

Tejashwi said, "If you're going to conduct polls based on a voter list given by the BJP -- then what's the point of an election? It's a fight between those who are trying to finish democracy and those who want to save it."

Asked whether the Opposition could mutually decide to boycott the elections, RJD leader Tejashwi Yadav said, "That too can be dis-

JD (U) MLA objects to SIR timing: JD (U) MLA from Parbatta, Dr Sanjeev Kumar, on Wednesday claimed that the names of several labourers in his assembly constituency had been erased from the voters' list. "It is justified to erase the names of those who have died. However, it is completely wrong to remove names of

the poor and labourers, as they do not know how to apply online," he claimed.

Roll revision near completion

Patna: The ongoing SIR of the electoral rolls in Bihar is near completion as 98.01 percent voters have already been covered. According to a press release issued by the EC, 20 lakh deceased voters, 28 lakh

permanently migrated voters, seven lakh voters found enrolled at more than one place, and one lakh untraceable voters, were reported during the SIR exercise. Similarly, 15 lakh voters' forms have not returned even as 7.17 crore voters' forms (90.89 percent) received and digitised.
