Class 10 admit cards with pass certificates can be used as ID

The Supreme Court on Wednesday clarified that Class 10 admit card accompanied by pass certificate can be produced as supplementary documentation for identity verification in the ongoing SIR exercise in West Bengal.

A bench of Chief Justice of India Surya Kant and Justices Jayashree Jagchi and Indu Malhotra in a 2:1 majority held that the admit card with pass certificate can be used as an ID for the SIR exercise.

The apex court on Tuesday allowed the deployment of West Bengal civil judges, in addition to 250 district judges, and the requisitioning of judicial officers from Jharkhand and Odisha to handle 80 lakh claims and objections of those facing deletion from the electoral roll in the ongoing SIR exercise in the state. It took note of a February 22 letter of Calcutta High Court Chief Justice Sujay Paul that even if 250 district judges deployed in the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) exercise will take around 80 days to deal with the claims and objections of those put under logical discrepancy and unmapped categories.

All documents mentioned in para 3(b) of order dated March 24, 2024 which are not updated so far and received before February 15, shall be submitted by the Electoral Registration Officers, Assistant Electoral Registration Officers to the presiding judicial officers by tomorrow 5 PM. Similarly, para 3(c)(i) is clarified to the effect that Madhyamik (Class 10) admit cards may be submitted along with pass certificate for the purpose of birth certificate and purposes of parentage, the bench said.

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AAP sarpanch murder: Two more accused hurt in police encounter

Two more accused involved in the killing of the ruling Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) sarpanch Harbinder Singh in Punjab's Tarn Taran District, were nabbed after being injured in a police encounter late on Tuesday night.

Police said that acting on inputs, the police teams from Patli town had launched a search operation and tracked the accused who were riding a motorcycle near village Jaloke. However, when the police team asked the accused to stop their vehicle, they at-

tempted to flee the spot and falling which they opened fire at the police personnel. However, both the accused, identified as Ramanpreet Singh and Arshdeep Singh were injured in the police's retaliatory firing.

Stating that two accused had already been arrested, police said that about six people were suspected to be involved in the murder. It was recalled that sarpanch Harbinder Singh was shot dead on February 18 last while attending a marriage function in a farm house in village Thathan Mehta on Tarn Taran-Bathinda national highway.
