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Eight months pregnant, separated from partner, HC steps into reunite inter-faith live-in couple

THEY HAD once lived as neighbours in the same society in Kutch. They belonged to different faiths, but they fell hopelessly in love.

So they decided to sign a live-in relationship agreement — more on this later — and to begin building a life together, away from their homes and families. She was 21 years old and was completing her graduation; he was 23, and worked as a driver.

Then came the 'missing person' complaint, the intervention by police, and the couple's forced separation. The woman was placed in a woman's protection home in Kutch.

They fought to get back with each other, and the journey went through police, lawyers, and the judiciary. The male partner moved the Gujarat High Court with a habeas corpus petition, which is a formal legal request asking for an order to a person who is detaining someone to bring them before the judge and prove the detention is lawful.

On Monday (August 24), the woman, who is eight months pregnant, told the Gujarat High Court that she wanted to return to the man she had chosen. The couple were expected to be reunited on Tuesday (August 25).

The petitioner had expressed apprehension that the couple would face difficulty in getting back together — the Division Bench of Justices Sanskar V. Shinde and Justice directed the police to ensure that the woman was allowed to join the petitioner after following the requisite procedure "without any problem".

Given the woman's fragile medical condition, the High Court interacted with her in a virtual hearing. The woman told the court that she wished to return to her partner and that her decision was being made "voluntarily, without force or coercion".

The Bench has interacted with the couple and she has expressed her desire to join the petitioner," the court recorded in its order on Monday. "It is also informed by the corpus that the statement is made on her own volition without any force or coercion," the court said.

It added: "In view of the above and respecting the wish of the corpus, we allow her to join the petitioner."

The couple's live-in agreement, and their elopement

Advocate Kevil Brahmhatt, who represented the man in court, said the couple had faced stiff opposition from the woman's family and had therefore decided to elope.

"They were neighbours and knew each other while living in the same society. Despite belonging to different faiths, they were two adults who fell in love and decided to live together. The Constitution, of course, guarantees the freedom of choosing one's partner," Brahmhatt told The Indian Express.

The couple moved to Banaskantha in June this year to begin living together, Brahmhatt said.

They signed a live-in agreement, also known as "maithi karar" in Gujarati — a non-formal agreement where two consenting adults enter into a live-in relationship together like a married couple without legally marrying.

A maithi karar is executed

on a stamp paper. The karar does not have the legal sanctity of marriage, but it is an old institution in Gujarat, and is generally less social sanction. In the present case, Brahmhatt said, the HC considered the live-in agreement placed on record to allow the woman to join her partner (the petitioner).

Police took her away, and he was forced to move court

The couple's decision to live together drew strong opposition from the family of the woman. According to Brahmhatt, within two days of the couple leaving to live together, the woman's family lodged a missing complaint. Police got in touch with the couple and called them to the police station.

They appeared before the police with documents, including their school leaving certificates to establish both their

ages. They also produced their live-in relationship agreement and asserted that, as adults, they had the right to choose their partners," Brahmhatt said.

But even then, he said, "the woman was forcibly separated from him (her partner), even though she was not wanted to return to her family. She was taken away and eventually placed at the Mahila Kalyan Kendra in Kutch."

Brahmhatt said the man first approached the police and later submitted a representation to the District Superintendent, who took the couple reunited with his partner.

But when no action was taken, he moved the Gujarat High Court in August with a habeas corpus petition.

Given she was 8 months pregnant, HC spoke to woman virtually

When the matter first came up before the court on August 17, Brahmhatt told the Bench that the woman was eight months pregnant and had been taken away from her partner. He submitted that she was not

inclined to join her parents and had been lodged at the Mahila Kalyan Kendra.

The case acquired particular urgency because of the advanced stage of the woman's pregnancy.

The state informed the court that the woman had been admitted to hospital after she complained of weakness.

The court noted in its order that doctors had advised admission to hospital, and had cautioned that travelling could pose a risk to her health. So, instead of insisting on her physical appearance, the Bench gave the matter priority and directed that she should join the next hearing virtually.

The woman joined the proceedings virtually on Monday. A police officer and the manager of the Mahila Kalyan Kendra were present with her during the hearing.

The manager informed the court that she was eight months pregnant, receiving medical assistance, and was doing fine. The judges then decided to return to her partner, and she said she was sure she would join him.

"A separate conversation also happened with the petitioner, and he orally assured the court that when the couple decided to marry in the future, they would do so in accordance with the procedure established by law," Brahmhatt said.

Experts who restored Notre-Dame cathedral now help build first major Hindu Temple in Paris

NEXT MONTH, France will see the opening of its first major Hindu temple at Bussy-Saint-Georges, a suburb east of Paris, during a 13-day festival beginning September 2.

The temple is built by the Gujarat-based Bochasanwasi Akshar Purushottam Swaminarayan Sanstha (BAPS) in collaboration with French architecture and engineering firms including stone specialists H Chevalier, that worked on the restoration of the Notre-Dame cathedral after a fire destroyed its roof and spire on April 15, 2019, according to an official statement.

Like the pink sandstone Akshardham temples, the BAPS Swaminarayan Hindu Mandir in Paris is white and uses marble sourced from Greece, Italy and Ambaji in Gujarat, and sandstone from Gwalior in Madhya Pradesh, a source close to the organisation told The Indian Express.

According to the source, this is the first major BAPS temple with traditional features, including five shikhars (spires), 10 ghummat (domes), 120 jharukha (ornate windows), four chhatris (umbrellas), 20 carved columns and 49 sculpted panels.

Other Hindu temples in Paris are dedicated to Ganesha and Shiva.

Given the weather conditions, the temple will have an underfloor heating system and a rooftop garden. Apart from the shrines, the 5,000 sq metre

complex offers a sports hall, a café, a crèche, classrooms, assembly halls, and seminar halls.

Located at Esplanade des Religions et des Cultures (Cultural Centre) in Bussy-Saint-Georges, the temple will be open to visitors from all backgrounds, the BAPS statement said. The Centre has places of worship for people from several faiths.

"Its opening adds a Hindu place of worship to that setting and gives concrete expression to the French ideal of fraternité (fraternity)," read the statement.

The formal opening of the temple is slated for September 6, preceded by a Rajya, a cultural procession along the river Seine, which will be held on September 3. The river will feature 11 choreographed boats with thousands of participants, carrying the 'message of fraternity'.

On September 5, the streets of Paris will see 14 floats passing in the parade, marking traditional performances showcasing Indian culture, culminating in the consecra-

tion of the temple the following day by the BAPS' spiritual leader Mahant Swami Maharaj.

Components crafted in India, shipped to France

The groundbreaking ceremony for the temple coincided with the year of the Covid-19 pandemic in 2021, followed by the foundation stone laying ceremony in Greece. Skilled artisans in India carved more than 1,000 individually crafted stone components, which were carefully coded and shipped to France for assembly. Select elements of the temple were carved by hand using traditional methods.

"In France, Indian artists worked alongside French stone masons, including specialists who restored the Notre-Dame Cathedral. French architects, engineers, and construction teams helped bring traditional Hindu sacred architecture together with contemporary engineering, environmental and construction standards," the statement added.
