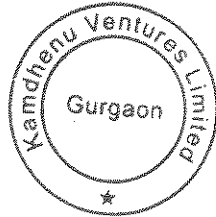

KARNATAKA HAS BEEN ranked first in devolution of power to panchayats in terms of funds, functions and functionaries followed by Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh, a report by Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA) and ministry of panchayati raj stated on Thursday.

Top six states got their rankings on the basis of index scores of Karnataka (72.23), Kerala (70.59), Tamil Nadu (68.38), Maharashtra (61.44) and Uttar Pradesh (60.8) and Gujarat (58.26), according to the report titled "Status of devolution to panchayat in states: an indicative evidence based ranking".

The scores highlight a significant gap between the top three states and the rest. In terms of those states which had scored over 50 points include—Tripura (57.58), Rajasthan (56.67), West Ben-

gal (56.52), Chhattisgarh (56.26), Telangana (55.1), Andhra Pradesh (54.43), Himachal Pradesh (53.17), Madhya Pradesh (50.94) and Odisha (50.03) respectively. Bihar (48.24) along with the northeastern and hilly states of Assam (49.06), Sikkim (43.91), and Uttarakhand (49.11) emerged as moderate scorers but with values above the national average of 43.89.

States and Union territories which have scored low are Goa (37.71), Haryana (39.33), Jharkhand (27.73) and Punjab (29.34).

The report has stated that devolution to panchayats has increased from 39.9% to 43.9% during 2013-14 to 2021-22.

States were ranked in the several parameters including

functions assigned to panchayats, fifteenth finance commission grants and ability to impose and collect revenues and physical infrastructure, staff and e-connectivity.

Accounting and audit of village level institutions and functioning of gram sabha was also taken into consideration. The dimension of 'finances' was a major indicator of measurement carrying the maximum weightage in the index.

The study assesses the enabling environment that the states have created for the panchayats to function as institutions of self-government. Article 243 G of the constitution has stipulated states to assign local functions to Panchayats enabling them to act as institutions of self-gov-

ernments. "The Index encourages transparency and informs us about where resources and services are being allocated effectively, ultimately leading to better governance and services," according to an official note.

The aim of the report was to assess the actual progress in implementing the operative core of decentralization covering the transfer of functions, institutions, functionaries, and finances to panchayati raj institutions in the subjects listed in the 11th schedule of the constitution in comparison to mapping of the activities done by states including panchayats extension to scheduled areas (PESA) States.

The study also aims to examine the role of the panchayats as institutions of local self-government with various committees and managing institutions at the local level.

The study also assessed the role of panchayats in implementation of central schemes including Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana, Integrated Child Development Services and Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana.

Govt mulls anti-dumping duty on China's solar glass

INDIA'S TRADE DEFENCE body, the directorate general of trade remedies (DGTR), has recommended an anti-dumping duty on imports of textured tem-

pered glass from China and Vietnam, a key component of solar panels.

No extension of duty-free import of yellow peas

THE GOVERNMENT HAS decided against extending duty-free import of yellow peas largely used as substitute of chana, beyond February 28, food minister Pralhad Joshi on Thursday said.

"We are stopping the duty-free import of yellow peas," Joshi said at the sideline of the pulses conclave 2025. However he stated a group of ministers (GoM) will soon take a call. Trade sources said the government may impose a 15%-20% import duty on yellow peas.

The move to restrict import of yellow peas comes after trade body—India Pulses and Grains Association had urged against continuing with zero import duty especially when over 3 million tonne (MT) of the cheap variant of chana—key pulses variety largely used in the food processing sector, had been imported.

"There has been lots of dumping of yellow peas which is expected to hit domestic producers and farmers as the landed cost of pulse variants should not fall below the aver-

age minimum support price (MSP) of pulses in India," Bimal Kothari, chairman, IPGA said. Kothari said the MSP of pulses in the country ranges between ₹56/kg – 85/kg

Trade sources said that the landed cost of yellow peas, mostly imported from Canada and Russia, is currently at ₹32/kg and the dal made out of it sold around ₹40/kg while rest of the pulses are ruling in the range of ₹90 – 160 /kg in the retail market.

Sources said that continuation of imports of yellow peas would hit prices, with the commencement of arrivals of chana, which has a 50% in India's pulses production. The mandis prices are currently ruling around the MSP of ₹5,650/quintal in Maharashtra and Karnataka where arrivals have commenced.

India's yellow peas import of 3 MT was out of a record 6.7 MT pulses import during the 2024 calendar year.

"Our pulses production was badly hit last year and the prices were high so we had to import. We are going to import a similar quantity, it will be much less," Kothari said

Icra: Road construction in FY26 to drop by 5%

THE SLUGGISH PACE in awarding new highway projects over the past two years is expected to further slow highway construction in the next financial year, according to a report.

Due to elections and a prolonged monsoon, the government has already scaled down the highway construction target for FY25 by 15% to 10,412.1 km.

"Road execution by the ministry of road transport and highways (MoRTH) will decline by 5% in FY26 to 9,500-10,000 km from the estimated road construction of 10,000-10,500 km in FY2025," the report by rating agency Icra said.

During April-December 2024, project awarding was subdued at 3,100 km—matching last year's level and significantly lower than the 5,835 km awarded during the same period in 2023.

Icra forecasts road awards to be in the range of 8,500-9,000 km in FY25, similar to FY24. However, some improvement in project awarding has been noted from November 2024, and if this trend sustains, it should result in 9-11% growth during FY26.

"However, given the increasing focus on building expressways/high-speed corridors, the road construction growth in terms of lane-km expansion will be relatively better. With road awarding expected to improve only in FY26, the revenue growth of road developers is likely to remain subdued over the next 12-15 months, as it takes 6-9 months from project awarding to on-ground execution," said Vinay Kumar G, sector head, corporate ratings at Icra.

India, Philippines may sign \$200 mn missile agreement

INDIA EXPECTS TO sell short-range missiles to the Philippines this year in a deal worth more than \$200 million, Indian sources told Reuters, for New Delhi's second major defence export contract with Manila as tension grows with China.

The Akash missile system developed by India's defence research body has drawn interest from the Philippines, which has told New Delhi it would make an order in the fiscal year that begins in April, said three sources.

All the sources spoke on condition of anonymity as the matter is a sensitive one.

The surface-to-air missile system with a range of up to 25 km (16 miles) was exported to Armenia last year in a \$230-million deal, the sources said, adding that the Philippine sale is expected to be bigger than the Armenian deal.

However, they did not reveal the number of missiles and accompanying systems, including radars, involved.

India's Bharat Dynamics, the manufacturer of the missiles, was one of the exhibitors at last year's Asian Defense and Security Exhibition in Manila.

The company and India's defence ministry did not immediately respond to requests for comment. A Philippine defence spokesperson, Arsenio Andolong, declined to comment on the specifics of any deal or on plans for procurement, but said the country's armed forces had "manifested it requires these capabilities".

The expected deal would follow India's \$375-million sale of the mid-range BrahMos supersonic cruise missile to the Philippines in 2022.

The purchase comes at a time when Manila is building its military strength as tension escalates with Beijing on overlapping claims in the busy waterway of the South China Sea, where the two have clashed in recent years. **—REUTERS**

Jamia students protesting against disciplinary action detained, let off

Admin has accused them of vandalising university property, including canteen, students deny claims

AROUND 12 Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) students, protesting since Monday against showcase notices issued to two PhD students for allegedly sloganeering "without permission or intimation to university authorities" last year, were detained by the Delhi Police on Thursday morning before being released later in the day.

The university administration has accused them of vandalising varsity property — including the central canteen and security advisor's office — but students have denied the charge and claimed the canteen was running smoothly.

"I visited the canteen in the day and everything seemed fine. There was no destruction of property visible anywhere," claimed a student.

According to the protesting students, they were made to leave campus after which police detained them at 5 am; they were then taken to different police stations in South-east Delhi. The Delhi Police confirmed that the students were detained but maintained that its personnel did not enter the campus.

The Indian Express reached out to Nawaz Jamal, Chief Proctor; Qamrul Hassan, Chief Media Officer; and Mazhar Asif, the Vice-Chancellor, for a comment and received no response. Police sources told The Indian Express on Thursday that all detained students were released.

The university administration, citing disruption to academic activities and damage to university property, said in a statement Thursday morning, "This handful of students have, in the last two days, vandalised university property, including the central canteen, and also broke the gate of the security advisor's office, forcing the JMI administration to

take action. They have violated other university rules and were found carrying objectionable contraband items. The university administration... has taken preventive measures so the university continues to conduct classes and other academic activities as normal."

"... today morning, the university administration and the Proctorial team removed students from the site of the protest and they have been evicted from the campus. The police have been requested to maintain law and order situation," the statement added.

Members of Left students' groups have been protesting against showcase notices issued by the varsity last year to students who had organised a CA-NRC observance day in December. The university formed a disciplinary committee to look into allegations of sloganeering at the said event, which is scheduled to review the students' role on February 25.

On December 1 last year, JMI had said "no protests, dharnas, and raising

slogans against any constitutional dignitaries shall be allowed on any part of the University campus" and warned of disciplinary action.

Official sources had told The Indian Express that the notification was issued after a few Left-wing organisations held a protest against the violence in Uttar Pradesh's Sambhal over a survey of the Shahi Jama Masjid.

At the centre of the latest demonstrations is a suspension letter issued to student activist Sakshi, president of the Students' Federation of India JMI Unit, which accused her of violating university rules.

SFI, in a statement Thursday, said the charges against her include disobeying faculty instructions, damaging property, and engaging in conduct deemed "unbecoming of a student".

Students contended that these accusations are baseless, and part of an ongoing effort by the administration to silence calls for campus rights, including improved hygiene facilities, better food quality, and academic freedom.

The protest was also fuelled by opposition to a 2022 office memorandum that prohibits gatherings of more than five students without prior approval from the administration. Student parties on campus argued that this memorandum functions as a de facto restriction on demonstrations, academic discussions, and even informal cultural gatherings such as book readings and poetry sessions.

"Jamia has turned into a space where any form of student engagement is labelled as misconduct," a protesting student said.

"The administration responded with a forceful eviction of the demonstrators. Following the eviction, university authorities called for police assistance to maintain order on campus. The protest and subsequent crackdown have reignited discussions about student representation at Jamia, which has not held student union elections for nearly two decades," another protesting student told The Indian Express on condition of anonymity.

SEAT ALLOCATION DISPUTE WITH ST STEPHEN'S HC pulls up DU: Compromising education quality

PULLING UP the Delhi University (DU) for "unilaterally" asking St Stephen's College to admit students over and above the sanctioned seats, the Delhi High Court on Thursday said it would compromise the quality of education.

A bench of Chief Justice D K Upadhyaya and Justice Tushar Rao Gedela told the counsel for DU, "If you are asking the college to do so, you are diluting the education. You are compromising the quality of education. Will that be in the interest of students?"

"Prima facie, the university cannot unilaterally ask any college to take admissions over and above the sanctioned strength. Sanctioned strength means what was sanctioned at the time of granting affiliation or recognition to a college in a college," it added.

The HC was hearing a seat allocation dispute between the college and DU. It said that seats couldn't be unilaterally increased, as it needed to be ensured that adequate number of teachers and infrastructure was also available with the college. However, the DU counsel submitted that it was not asking the college to increase the seats in any course.

The bench was hearing an appeal filed by the college against a single-judge's September 6, 2024 order which granted admission to seven students on the basis of the seats allocated by DU.

The court asked the DU counsel to show the statute or resolution relating to the original seat allocation and asked if the university could unilaterally increase the seat allocation. The counsel placed certain documents and said it was a practice followed by DU.

The bench, however, said, "You are a central university and you need to have some statutory backing or resolution of the academic council or executive council."

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Water shortage likely in parts of Delhi on February 15 and 17

New Delhi: The Delhi Jal Board (DJB) on Thursday warned of potential water crisis in several areas of the Capital on February 15 and 17 due to routine maintenance work like cleaning of underground reservoirs and booster pumping stations.

Areas like Janakpuri, Vikas Puri, Budella, Vasundhara Enclave, New Ashok Nagar, Shalimar Bagh, Pitampura, Paschim Vihar, Kirti Nagar, and Kamesh Nagar could face water shortage on February 15. The DJB said water tankers will be available on request from its emergency rooms.

Janakpuri and Vikaspuri may again face disruptions on February 17. Other areas that may be affected on February 17 include Dilshad Garden, Mayapuri, Punjabi Bagh, Jasola Vihar and Sarita Vihar.

"It's routine maintenance for the purpose of cleaning underground reservoirs. It won't cause any major issue. To address water-related complaints, residents can contact the area joint engineer who will be available to assist immediately," said S K Sharma, Joint Director (South/Southwest) at DJB. ENS

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पंजाब मंत्रिमंडल की बैठक में फैसला

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चंडीगढ़, 13 फरवरी (ब्यूरो)।

पंजाब सरकार के करीब छह लाख कर्मचारियों और पेंशनभोगियों को एक जनवरी, 2016 से छठे वेतन आयोग का बकाया मिलेगा। गुरुवार को मुख्यमंत्री भगवंत मान की अध्यक्षता में हुई पंजाब सरकार की मंत्रिमंडल की बैठक में इस फैसले को मंजूरी दी गई। फैसले से राज्य के खजाने पर 14,000 करोड़ रुपए का भार पड़ेगा।

वित्त मंत्री हरपाल चीमा ने बताया कि एक जनवरी 2016 से 30 जून 2022 तक की अवधि के संशोधित वेतन/पेंशन और छुट्टी नकदीकरण का बकाया और एक जुलाई, 2021 से 31 मार्च 2024 तक का डीए/डीआर पेंशनभोगियों और कर्मचारियों को दिया जाएगा। 14,000 करोड़ रुपए की यह राशि चरणों में जारी की जाएगी। 85 वर्ष से अधिक आयु के पेंशनभोगियों को पहली किस्त दी जाएगी। 75 से 85 वर्ष के बीच वालों को दूसरी किस्त दी जाएगी और 65 से 75 वर्ष के बीच वालों को तीसरी किस्त में बकाया दिया जाएगा। सरकार के पास 2027-28 वित्तीय वर्ष तक सभी बकाया चुकाने का प्रस्ताव है। उन्होंने कहा कि उनकी योजना 2028 तक सभी बकाया चुकाने की है।

गौरतलब है कि राज्य सरकार के तीन लाख कर्मचारी और तीन लाख पेंशनभोगी हैं, जिन्हें इस कदम से फायदा होगा। वित्त मंत्री चीमा ने कहा कि इससे राज्य के सरकारी खजाने पर हर साल 2,400 से 2,500 करोड़ रुपए का बोझ पड़ेगा।

तीन हजार नौकरियां सृजित करने को मंजूरी

मंत्रिमंडल ने 3,000 सरकारी नौकरियां सृजित करने को भी मंजूरी दी। वित्त मंत्री चीमा ने कहा कि लोगों को न्याय दिलाने के लिए राज्य में 22 नई लोक अदालतें स्थापित करने के लिए पंजाब राज्य कानूनी सेवा अथॉरिटी में नए पदों को मंजूरी दी गई है। कैबिनेट ने नए बनाए गए जिले मलेरकोटला में सहायक निदेशक, वरिष्ठ सहायक और सेवादार के तीन नए पद सृजित करने को भी मंजूरी दी। कराराधन विभाग में मानव संसाधनों का समुचित उपयोग करके राज्य में करों की चोरी रोकने के लिए मंत्रिमंडल ने विभाग में 476 नए पदों के सृजन को भी मंजूरी दी। प्रारंभिक शिक्षा विभाग में शारीरिक प्रशिक्षण प्रशिक्षकों (पीटीआइ शिक्षकों) की सीधी भर्ती के लिए नियमों और योग्यताओं में संशोधन को भी मंजूरी दी। राज्यभर में ऐसे 2,000 शिक्षकों की भर्ती हो सकेगी।

नई दिल्ली, 13 फरवरी (भाषा)।

दिल्ली की एक अदालत ने 2014 में नशे में धुत व्यक्ति द्वारा कार को फुटपाथ पर चढ़ा देने से

हुई दो लोगों की मौत और 10 अन्य के घायल होने के मामले में 10 वर्ष के कठोर कारावास की सजा सुनाई। अदालत ने कहा कि यह सच है कि फुटपाथ सोने के लिए नहीं होते, बल्कि पैदल चलने के लिए होते हैं, लेकिन यह भी सच है कि फुटपाथ वाहन चलाने के लिए भी नहीं होते।

अतिरिक्त सत्र न्यायाधीश वीरेंद्र कुमार खरता ने आरोपी ऋषि कुमार के खिलाफ मामले की सुनवाई की और दोषी करार दिया। अदालत ने 12 फरवरी को दिए गए अपने फैसले में अतिरिक्त सरकारी वकील पंकज रंगा को इस दलील
