LEAD RECLAIM VENTURES INTO TYRE PYROLYSIS OIL PRODUCTION IN GUJARAT, WELL-POSITIONED FOR SAF AND MARINE FUEL OPPORTUNITIES

Gujarat, April 9, 2026 – Lead Reclaim and Rubber Products Ltd (LRRPL), an ISO 9001:2015 and MSME ZED certified manufacturer of premium reclaim rubber, butyl reclaim rubber granules, and crumb rubber powder, today announced that, subject to necessary approvals, it is venturing into a new product line namely Tyre Pyrolysis Oil (TPO) and Recovered Carbon Black (RCB) plant at Mundra, Gujarat.

With the increasing interest and anticipated changes in regulatory approvals for Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) and marine fuel opportunities from Pyrolysis Oil including indicative blending targets starting at 1% and scaling toward 15% over time according to reports published in prior years, LRRPL is very well positioned to participate in these rapidly evolving green fuels landscape. The government has set a target to have 1 per cent blending of Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) by 2027, 2 per cent by 2028 and 5 per cent by 2030 for international flights. India is one of the world's fastest-growing civil aviation markets, and with the availability of feedstock, the country also has significant potential for producing SAF. Globally, the requirement for SAF is estimated at 183 million tonnes by 2040.

Currently, aviation fuel is using 100% natural resources. A substitute like TPO not only helps with recycling and EPR norms but is also much cheaper and sustainable in nature which looks to be the future of fuels.

LRRPL's high-quality TPO will align with required technical upgrades, certifications, and partnerships to enable its use in these high-value applications. The realistic timeline for full operationalization will be determined by the Company in short period, ensuring seamless integration into the value chain. A ₹20-25 Crore total investment will deliver a target capacity of 1,500 MT/month (TPO + RCB).

"We are thrilled about this business pivot into TPO and RCB, which not only positions LRRPL at the forefront of the green fuels revolution but also marks the beginning of an exciting expansion into other value-added products from recycled rubber," said Mr. Jayeshh Patel, Managing Director at Lead Reclaim and Rubber Products. "These innovations are cost-efficient, fully compliant with 100% EPR norms, and poised to transform our financial trajectory unlocking sustainable profitability and significant growth for our shareholders in the years ahead."
