

# To Ensure Quality, Trai Raises Fine on Telcos

## Regulator also tightens quality norms in move to deal with call drops and network downtime

### QoS Benchmark for 5G

New Delhi: The telecom regulator has tightened quality norms around 4G and 5G networks, increasing the financial penalties for not meeting benchmarks and directed telcos to compensate mobile phone users with rent rebates and value-added services in case mobile service outages continue for more than 24 hours, in a bid to reduce instances of call drops and slow network downtime problems.

TraI increases the financial penalty to ₹1 lakh from ₹50,000 earlier for not meeting the QoS benchmarks for 5G services.

Regulator introduces a graded penalty system of ₹1 lakh, ₹2 lakh, ₹5 lakh and ₹10 lakh for different scales of rule violations under revised regulations, which will come into effect from Oct 1.

and upload speed have been changed from average to percentile to have a better understanding. For insights into network performance at a granular level, TraI has decided to collect performance data against certain parameters like network availability, call drop, voice packet drop rate etc on cell level as against base station level earlier.

To achieve time-boundance on quality of service (QoS) related issues, the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TraI) on Friday increased the financial penalty to ₹1 lakh from ₹50,000 earlier for not meeting the benchmarks. The regulator has also introduced a graded penalty system of ₹1 lakh, ₹2 lakh, ₹5 lakh and ₹10 lakh for different scales of rule violations under revised regulations, which will come into effect from October 1.

For the first time, the TraI notified QoS benchmarks for 5G services as the technology was launched in October 2022 in India.

TraI had earlier issued three different regulations for QoS norms for basic and cellular services, broadband services, and broadband wireless services. The new regulations will supersede the three regulations.

Similarly various other benchmarks, including related to call drops, packet drop rate, latency parameters for 4G/5G networks etc, will come into effect from six months to two and a half years.

# Airtel, Jio may Buy Gear worth \$2b to Expand Network

Kolkata: Bharti Airtel and Reliance Jio are likely to collectively buy another \$2 billion worth of fresh 5G network gear to expand and bolster their next-gen mobile broadband coverage for a rapidly growing user base amid rising shipments of smartphones supporting next-gen technology people are aware of the matter said.

Both telcos are expected to invest around \$1.5 billion each, focusing on purchasing radio base stations to expand their 5G infra.

Senior industry executives said Jio and Airtel's depth of coverage in terms of installed 5G base stations is nowhere near 4G levels.

Latest network data collected by the Department of Telecommunications (DoT) pegs the total 5G base stations count at 4.32 lakh, or 15.3% of the nationwide installed base of 29.25 lakh base stations as on July 31, 2024, which are primarily 4G.

Jio and Airtel are expected to spend buy around \$1 billion of 5G network gear primarily radio base stations, multiple persons aware of the discussions said.

But the 5G user base in India is rising steadily. Airtel had 75 million at March end, while Jio had 190 million at June end.

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# IT Hardware Cos Seek Clarity on New Import Authorisation Rules

New Delhi: The IT hardware industry has sought clarity around the new system of import authorisation, including criteria and import quantities of products like laptops and tablets that may be allowed under the new import authorisation mechanism, that is set to come into force from October 1 this year.

The government is preparing to replace the current import management system, which will expire in September, with the import authorisation mechanism, as part of its aim to make the country a global manufacturing hub.

Officials said import authorisation will be given to firms based on three parameters—import value of previous year or average of past three years for IT products, domestic manufacturing of IT hardware devices and exports of electronics goods.

Companies having a large manufacturing base in India will get an edge in importing products as compared to those that don't have any production capacity.

Mumbai: The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TraI) issued a consultation paper to determine the reserve price for auctioning FM radio channels in 18 new cities in hilly areas under the FM Phase III policy.

The consultation paper follows the information and broadcasting ministry's reference to the TraI. The ministry has proposed creation of category E for the 18 new cities in Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Jammu and Kashmir.

Dena Bank has been held vicariously liable for the actions of its employees and ordered to repay the Mumbai Agriculture Produce Market Committee (APMC) ₹65 crore allegedly embezzled by the bank's chief manager in 2014.

The National Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission (NCDRC) has directed the bank to pay the amount with 9% interest for the past 10 years within two months.

In 2014, the APMC sought quotations from various banks for the best interest rates on fixed deposits as it intended to fund agricultural

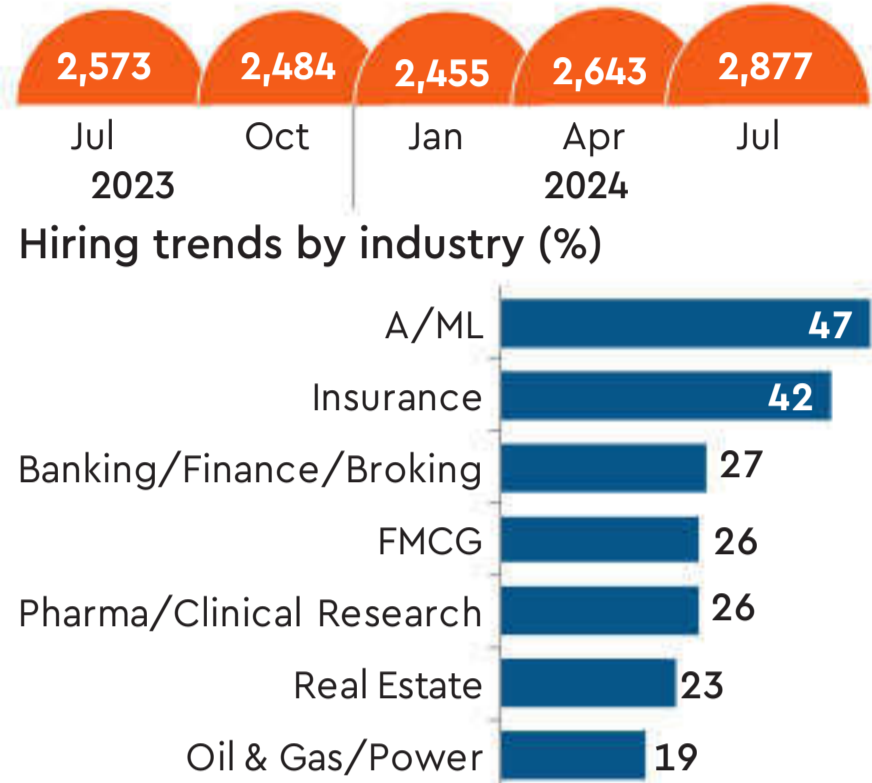

# AI, machine learning jobs grew by 47% in July: Report

**OVERALL HIRING TRENDS**

New Delhi, August 2

**WHITE-COLLAR HIRING ACTIVITY** has peaked over the past 12 months. The Naukri JobSpeak Index surged to 2,877 points in July 2024, the highest level in the past year, and 12% higher than in July 2023. The index indicates that nearly all sectors experienced double-digit growth over the last month, with artificial intelligence (AI) and machine learning (ML) leading with a 47% year-on-year increase. Other sectors that saw impressive growth include insurance (42%), banking and finance (27%), and FMCG (26%).

on account of the IT sector's woes," said the report. Meanwhile, Gujarat continued to lead, with Rajkot, Jamnagar, and Baroda recording growth rates of 39%, 38%, and 25% in hiring activity, respectively. In contrast, Hyderabad has emerged as a key hub for job creation across several major industries, including hospitality (76%), insurance (71%), BPO (52%), and oil & gas (44%).

"The robust 12% growth in hiring activity is a much-awaited, encouraging sign for this financial year. This is the first month this year that we have seen positive growth, and the fact that it's secular, cutting across sectors and geographies, makes it truly promising. This broad-based, positive shift could potentially be the onset of an upcycle in the Indian white-collar job market," said Pawan Goyal, chief business officer at Naukri.

The report shows that hiring activity grew the most among individuals with over 16 years of work experience. In contrast, job opportunities for professionals with 0-3 and 4-7 years of experience were the lowest, each at 7%, in July.

The Naukri index is based on the aggregated hiring activity of over 100,000 clients with over 7 million new job mandates yearly.

# NEET-UG paper leak: Top court questions use of e-rickshaws

**HAVING HELD THAT** there was no systemic leak of NEET-UG papers which would warrant its cancellation, the Supreme Court Friday flagged a number of concerns in the conduct of the exam this year by the National Testing Agency (NTA) — specifically pointing to the use of e-rickshaws for transporting question sheets.

The court also said that using e-rickshaws and private courier companies for transporting National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (Undergraduate) papers "raises concerns about the security and reliability of paper-handling procedures". The e-rickshaws were allegedly used to ferry question papers from the courier company's office on the outskirts of Hazaribagh to the strongroom of a local bank, from where it was then taken to exam centres.

The court listed more issues in the manner the NTA conducted the exam, telling it to implement stringent security measures. "In one of the centres (where the alleged leak occurred), the rear door of the strongroom was opened and unauthorised persons were permitted to access the question papers. This indicates that there is a serious lapse in security..." the ruling said. The NTA also did not specify a time by which the OMR sheets had to be sealed after the conclusion of the exam, which could lead to dishonest elements tampering with the sheets, it said.

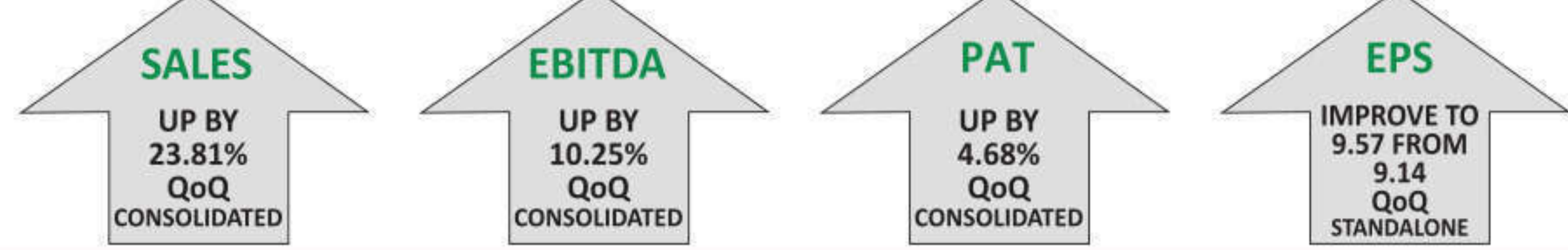
"Yet another point of concern is that NTA relies on persons over whom it does not exercise direct oversight to be the invigilators for the exam," said the court.

भारताच्या पुरुष हॉकी संघाने क्वालीफायिंग टूर्नामेंटमध्ये खेळ करत पॅरिस ऑलिम्पिक क्रोडा स्पर्धेतील अखेरच्या साखळी सामन्यात सोमवारी ऑस्ट्रेलियाला ३-२ असा पराभवचा धक्का दिला. ऑलिम्पिक स्पर्धेत भारताने तब्बल ५२ वर्षांनी ऑस्ट्रेलियावर विजय मिळवला आहे. यापूर्वी १९७२ म्युनिक ऑलिम्पिक स्पर्धेत भारताने ऑस्ट्रेलियाचा ३-१ असा पराभव केला होता.

भारताकडून पीआर श्रीजेशचे गोलरक्षण आणि कर्णधार हरमनप्रीत सिंगचे गोल पुन्हा एकदा निर्णायक ठरले. त्याहोपेक्षा भारतीय हॉकीपटूंनी ऑस्ट्रेलियासमोर दाखवलेली जिद आणि आक्रमकता सर्वात महत्त्वाची होती. एरवी ऑस्ट्रेलियाच्या आक्रमकतेसमोर भारतीय संघ निष्प्रभ झालेला पाहायला मिळायचे. मात्र, या



वेळी भारताने ऑस्ट्रेलियाला तोडीसतोड उत्तर दिले. ऑस्ट्रेलिया खेळाडूंना दडपणाखाली ठेवण्यात भारताच्या आक्रमकपटूला यश आले. तसेच मध्यरक्षक आणि बचावपटूंनीही आपले काम चोख बजावले.

भारताने सनसनाटी सुरुवात करताना पूर्वाधातूतच एका मिनिटाच्या अंतराने दोन गोल केले. प्रथम १२व्या मिनिटाला अभिषेकने भारताला आघाडी मिळवून दिली. त्यानंतर पुढच्याच १३व्या मिनिटाला हरमनप्रीतने भारताची आघाडी

वाढवणारा गोल केला. उत्तरार्धात हरमनप्रीतने (३२व्या मिनिटाला) ही आघाडी आणखी एका गोलने वाढवली. ऑस्ट्रेलियाने उत्तरार्धात प्रयत्नांची शिकस्त केली. मात्र, भारताच्या बचावपटू आणि गोलरक्षक श्रीजेशने त्यांना यश मिळू दिले नाही. विश्रांतीपूर्वी टॉम क्रेगने २५व्या मिनिटाला एक गोल करून पिछाडी भरून काढली. त्यानंतर उत्तरार्धात ब्लेक गोव्हर्सने (५५व्या मि.) गोल नोंदवला. मात्र, ऑस्ट्रेलियाला बरोबरीचा गोल करता आला नाही.

अखेरची ऑलिम्पिक स्पर्धा खेळणारा श्रीजेश वेगळ्याच ऊर्जेने खेळत आहे. गोल वाचवण्याबरोबर तो सामन्याचा अभ्यास करून खेळाडूंना सूचना देताना दिसून आला. मध्यरक्षकांची भूमिकाही महत्त्वाची होती. भारतीय मध्यरक्षकांनी ऑस्ट्रेलियाच्या आक्रमकांना रोखताना क्वालीफायिंग सामन्यात खेळले.
