### **Atal Smruti Udyan - Borivali**

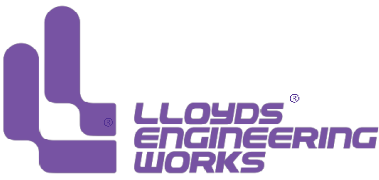

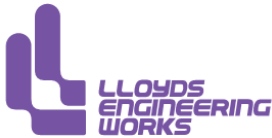
