'Bahrain, Egypt Mediating UAE-Saudi Rift'

RIVYADH: Bahrain and Egypt are attempting to mend ties between the United Arab Emirates and Saudi Arabia, two sources said, weeks into a diplomatic rift between the Arab world's most powerful countries. Saudi Arabia and the UAE had a public falling out in December when the kingdom accused its neighbour of threatening its national security by supporting Yemeni separatists who orchestrated a brief land grab. A source close to the Saudi government insisted there was "no need for mediation" because direct channels are open between the two countries. — AFP

'China Steps Up Aid to Russian War Effort'

BEIJING: China increased its support for Russia's war in Ukraine in 2025 and is likely to deepen cooperation with Moscow further this year, Western officials said, casting doubt on efforts by European leaders to improve relations with Beijing. President Xi Jinping has become more assertive and confident in his supporting Russia's Vladimir Putin, and attempts by the Europeans to persuade their Chinese counterparts to help end the war have become more challenging over the past year, the officials said. Russia's war in Ukraine wouldn't be able to continue without ongoing Chinese support, particularly the export of dual-use components and critical minerals used in Russian drone production, the officials said. — Bloomberg

Rubio Tells Europe to Join Trump's Fight, says it Belongs with the US

Munich: US Secretary of State Marco Rubio sought to reassure a nervous Europe on Saturday, saying that Washington wanted to recharge the transatlantic alliance so that a strong Europe could help the US on its mission of global "renewal". Speaking at a security conference in Munich after months of turmoil in US-European relations sparked by US President Donald Trump's vows to seize Greenland and his often derisive remarks about US allies, Washington's top diplomat struck a markedly soothing tone. "We do not seek to separate, but to revitalise an old friendship and renew the greatest civilisation in human history," Rubio said, calling for "a reinvigorated alliance".

"We want Europe to be strong," Rubio said, adding that the continent and the US "belong together". He echoed Trump administration's off-stated assertion that immigration posed a threat, saying that "mass migration" was "a crisis which is transforming and destabilising societies all across the West." He said that Europe and the US were "heirs to the same great and noble civilisation" and

that he hoped Europe "together with us are willing and able to defend it".

CHANGE IN TONE
Aside from immigration, Rubio otherwise largely avoided the MAGA flashpoint and culture war issues that German Chancellor Friedrich Merz said on Friday, had deepened a "rift" between US and Europe. Rubio's speech marked a sharp contrast to that of US Vice President JD Vance a year ago, when he used the same stage to attack European policies on a range of issues including free trade, free speech, shocking European allies.

The Trump administration has also charged that Europe faced a "civilisational decline" and has courted far-right parties on the continent. Ties plunged last month when Trump stepped up threats to annex Greenland, an autonomous territory of NATO member Denmark, forcing European nations to stand firm in protest. Some breathed a sigh of relief following Rubio's speech, with Estonia's Defence Minister Hanno Pevkur saying "it was needed to show that we are still allies and partners." But others said they did not mark a shift in the US stance. European leaders at the Munich Security Conference have pledged to shoulder more of the burden of shared NATO defences, saying this was essential for Europe to counter a hostile Russia.

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy decried that political efforts to end the war have not worked. "Weapons evolve faster than political decisions meant to stop them," he said, calling for speedier arms deliveries for Ukraine's Western-supplied air defence systems.

Europe, UK Seek Closer Ties a Decade After Brexit

Munich: Ten years after the referendum that led to Brexit, Britain and the European Union must close ranks in an increasingly unstable world, their leaders said on Saturday. EU chief Ursula von der Leyen told the Munich Security Conference that Europe and Britain need to cooperate more closely on "security, on economy, on defending our democracies". "Europe and in particular the UK should come closer together... 10 years on from Brexit our futures are as bound as ever," she told the Munich Security Conference. British leader Keir Starmer said, "We are not at a crossroads: The road ahead is straight and it is clear: We must build our hard power, because that is the currency of the age," he said, calling for a building of "a shared industrial base across Europe which can turbocharge our defence production". — AFP

Tarique Rahman Calls for Unity After a Landslide Win

BNP alliance secured 212 seats, far ahead of Jamaat-e-Islami-led alliance, which won 77

Dhaka: Bangladesh's prime minister-in-waiting Tarique Rahman called on Saturday for all to remain united and dedicated his sweeping win to those who "sacrificed for democracy". Rahman's Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) won a landslide victory in the elections on Thursday, the first since a deadly 2024 uprising ousted the iron-fisted rule of Sheikh Hasina. The BNP alliance won 212 seats, compared with 77 for the Jamaat-e-Islami-led alliance, according to the Electoral Commission. "Our paths and opinions may differ, but in the interest of the country, we must remain united," Rahman said in his first speech since the election.

"I firmly believe that national unity is a collective strength, while division is a weakness." Jamaat chief Shafiqur Rahman, 67, had initially alleged "inconsistencies and fabrications" in the vote, but earlier on Saturday he conceded, and said he would "serve as a vigilant, principled, and peaceful opposition". Hasina's Awami League party was barred from taking part. The success of BNP chief Rahman, 60, marks a remarkable turnaround for a man who only returned to Bangladesh in December after 17 years in exile in Britain, far from Dhaka's political storms. His father, president Ziaur Rahman, was assassinated in 1981, while his mother, Khaleda Zia, served three terms as prime minister and dominated national politics for decades. "Freedom loving pro-democracy people of the country have once again brought victory to the Bangladesh Nationalist Party," he added, in an initial speech in English, before switching to Bangla.



Cabinet Oath in Next Four Days: Official

DHAKA Bangladesh President Mohammed Shahabuddin is expected to administer the oath of office to the new cabinet of Tarique Rahman within next four days, officials said on Saturday. The BNP leader is set to become the prime minister, replacing the interim government chief Muhammad Yunus. — PTI

As electric scooters move beyond novelty and into everyday commuting, buyers are placing greater emphasis on reliability, service access and long-term ownership costs, areas where traditional original equipment manufacturers (OEMs) enjoy a structural advantage. "Being first mattered in the early phase. Now consistency matters more," said an industry executive. "Legacy players waited, built their supply chains and dealer readiness, and are now scaling at the right time." By early 2026, the electric two-wheeler market has clearly transitioned from a startup-led disruption phase to one dominated by incumbents, particularly TVS Motor and Bajaj Auto. Competition has intensified, but the nature of that competition has changed, from aggressive price-led expansion to a focus on portfolio depth, manufacturing stability and customer experience. TVS Motor has emerged as a beneficiary of this shift. Its electric strategy combines steady capacity expansion with a widening product portfolio, allowing it to address multiple customer segments. Speaking after the company's Q3 FY26 results, KN Radhakrishnan, CEO and director of TVS Motor, said demand remained strong across both the flagship

iQube and the recently launched Orbiter, which targets a different set of buyers. In the December 2025 quarter, the company sold more than 100,000 electric scooters for the first time, despite supply-side disruptions earlier in the year. Analysts say this highlights the advantage of TVS's distribution reach as volumes scale up. Bajaj Auto has also staged a strong recovery after resolving battery pack supply constraints that had weighed on production earlier. With output ramped up, volumes rebounded sharply in the December quarter, helping Bajaj regain the number-two position in the electric scooter market. The company has expanded the Chetak range with a new entry-level variant aimed at younger buyers and women, broadening its appeal while reinforcing its positioning around reliability and value. For startups though, growth trajectories are becoming more differentiated. Ather Energy reported a particularly strong December quarter, driven by rising demand for its Rizta scooter and improving operating leverage. Cofounder and CEO Tarun Mehta told analysts that expanding volumes over recent quarters had begun to unlock efficiencies, supporting margins as demand broadens. Ola Electric's sharper loss of

market share, however, highlights the growing execution challenges in a more competitive market. Service scalability, operational consistency and rising customer expectations are increasingly shaping buyer preferences, narrowing the advantage that early movers once had. Other players such as Hero MotoCorp's Vida and Ampere continue to scale, but at a more measured pace than during the category's early expansion. Ravi Bhatia, president at Jato Dynamics, said the next phase of growth will increasingly favour scale players. The upcoming ABS mandate is likely to raise vehicle costs, disproportionately impacting mid-range electric scooters. "Large OEMs can absorb these increases through scale and sourcing efficiencies, while smaller startups may face margin pressure. Although price-sensitive rural demand could soften in the short term, higher safety standards are expected to strengthen long-term consumer confidence," said Bhatia. Electric two-wheelers still account for a relatively small share of India's overall two-wheeler market, but adoption continues to rise steadily. Growth is being supported by improvements in battery safety and durability, expanding service and dealer networks, and greater confidence in resale value and total cost of ownership.

districts across Delhi, Haryana, Maharashtra and Karnataka were approved at an estimated cost of ₹18,509 crore. The projects will add about 389 km to the existing network of Indian Railways. Urban transport also received a boost with the approval of an 11.6-km extension of the Noida Metro Rail Project from Noida Sector 142 to Botanical Garden. The elevated corridor will include eight stations and, once operational, will take the total active metro rail network in Noida and Greater Noida to 61.62 km. The extension is expected to improve last-mile connectivity and reduce road congestion in the fast-growing NCR region.

Nobel Prize Winner Transferred to Prison in Northern Iran

Paris: Iranian authorities have, without prior warning, transferred Nobel Peace Prize winner Narges Mohammadi to a prison in the north of the country as concern grows over her health, her husband said on Saturday. Mohammadi, who won the peace prize in 2023 in recognition for more than two decades of campaigning, was arrested on December 12 in the eastern city of Mashhad after speak-

ing out against the clerical authorities at a funeral ceremony. She spent time on hunger strike earlier this month and had been hospitalised before being returned to prison. "The Norwegian Nobel Committee said this week it was "deeply appalled" by reports detailing "physical abuse and ongoing life-threatening mistreatment" of Mohammadi both during her arrest and in detention.

The fund will be operational from FY26 to FY31, with an extendable implementation period up to FY34. It will be used to roll out budget proposals related to positioning cities as growth hubs, undertaking creative redevelopment projects, and strengthening water and sanitation systems. Information and broadcasting minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said Friday that the launch followed "extensive consultations" with states, explaining the gap between the initial announcement and formal approval. In another key decision, the cabinet cleared construction of a 15.79-kilometre road-cum-rail tunnel under the Brahmaputra in Assam at a cost of ₹18,662 crore under the engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) model. The project is expected to

cut travel time between key points in the region from about six hours to 20 minutes, reducing the travel distance from 240 km to roughly 34 km. The government also approved three national highway projects with a combined outlay of over ₹11,000 crore. These include a 107.67-km, four-lane highway in Gujarat to be developed under HAM at a capital cost of ₹4,583.64 crore. Additionally, the cabinet cleared the upgradation of a 154.635-km highway stretch in Maharashtra under the EPC mode at a cost of ₹3,320.38 crore. It also approved the widening of NH 167 in Telangana, covering 80.01 km, at a cost of ₹3,175.08 crore under HAM as part of the NH (O) scheme. The National Highway Original programme pertains to roads not covered under various umbrella projects. In the rail sector, three multi-tracking projects covering 12
