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# Macro-Economic Highlights

## Positives

### GDP Growth

As per RBI, **growth is estimated at 7.6% for FY26**, indicating strong economic momentum. Revised forecasts for FY27- RBI 6.9%, IMF - 6.5%, World Bank - 6.6%.

### Monetary Policy

In its April MPC meeting, RBI has maintained the Repo Rate at **5.25%**, maintaining its neutral stance.

### GST Collections

India's GST collections reached Rs. 22.27 lakh crore in FY26 with **growth of 8.3% (y-o-y)**.

### Inflation

CPI Inflation forecast for FY 2026-27 is projected at 4.6%, well within the target range of RBI.

### Strong Forex Reserves

As on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2026, India's foreign exchange reserves **stood at US\$ 700.95 billion**, sufficient to cover more than 11 months of merchandise imports.

### Export Surge

Exports **increased by 5.79% (y-o-y)** to USD 790.86 billion in FY26 (April-Feb) (y-o-y)

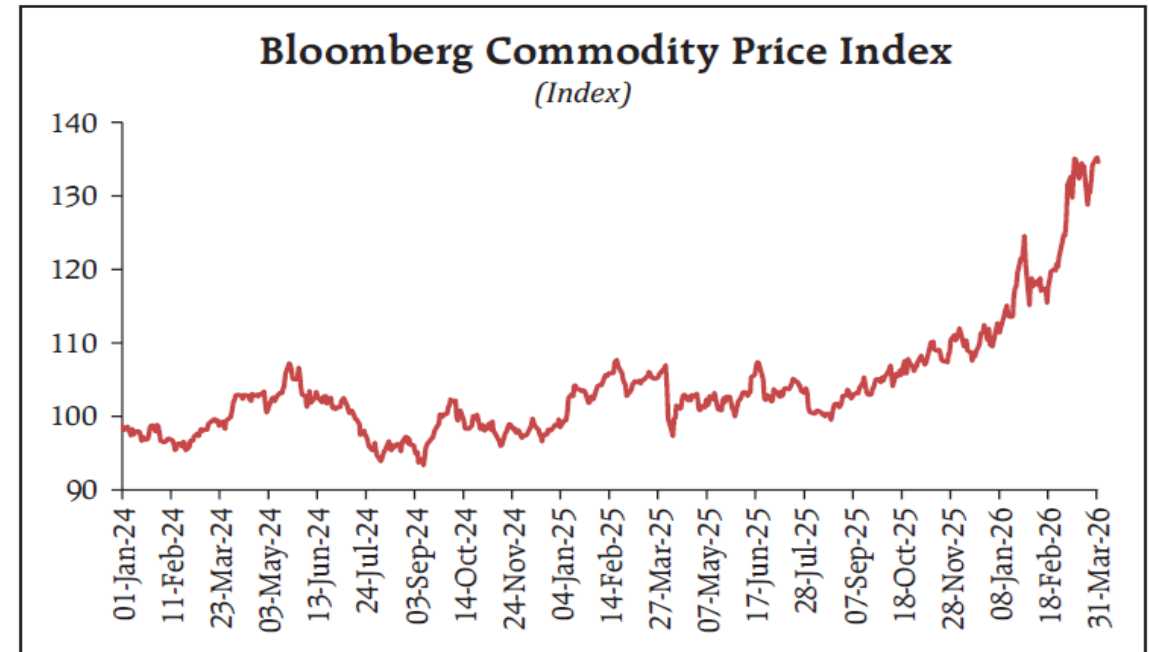

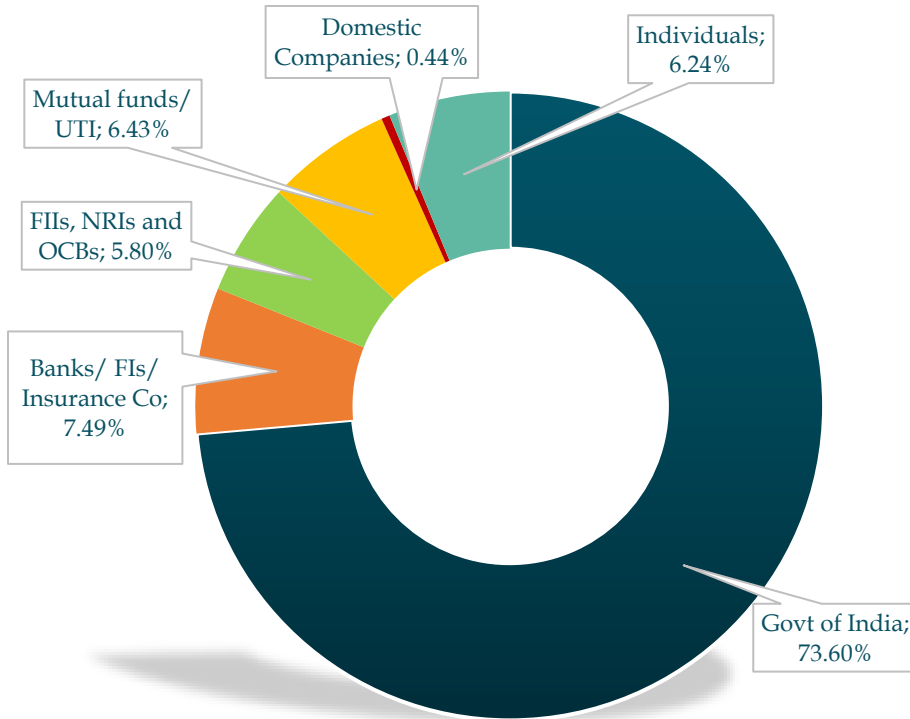

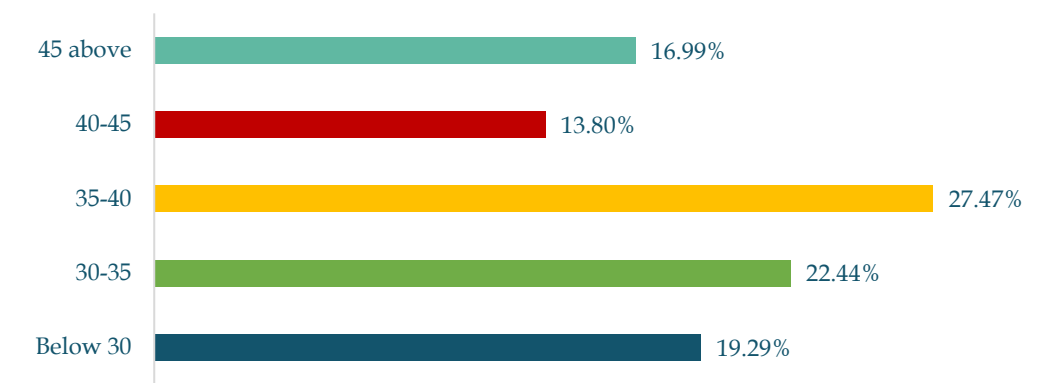
