### 16 years ago, ISRO's probe discovered water on Moon

THE Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) on Thursday celebrated the 16th anniversary of the successful impact of the Moon Impact Probe (MIP) of Chandrayaan-1.

Chandrayaan-1 was India's first moon mission which was launched on October 22, 2008. The life of the mission was to be two years, but scientists lost contact with the spacecraft on August 28, 2009. But before that, on November 14, 2008, MIP separated from Chandrayaan-1 and hard landed on the lunar south pole as planned.

According to ISRO scientists, the MIP was a success as Indian scientists confirmed the existence of water on the Moon. But the finding was not made public till NASA's Moon Mineralogy Mapper payload onboard the Chandrayaan-1 orbiter also confirmed the finding. The announcement was then made on September 24, 2009.

## ED LAUNCHES MULTI-STATE RAIDS AGAINST CHENNAI LOTTERY KING

Accused's company bought electoral bonds worth over ₹1,300 cr

THE Enforcement Directorate on Thursday conducted fresh searches in multiple states against Chennai-based 'lottery king' Santiago Martin, the single biggest donor to political parties with over Rs 1,300 crore in electoral bonds, as part of a money laundering investigation.

The search operation comes after the Madras High Court recently allowed the ED to proceed against Martin as the Tamil Nadu police had decided to close the predicate or primary FIR against him and a few others and a lower court accepted the police plea.



Sources said at least 20 premises linked to Martin, his son-in-law Aadhav Arjun and associates in Chennai and Coimbatore in Tamil Nadu, Faridabad in Haryana, Ludhiana in Punjab and Kolkata in West Bengal were being searched as part of a "comprehensive" action against his business empire.

In Chennai, searches were conducted at offices in Triplicane, Teynampet and Poes Garden under the security cover provided by the CRPF. Searches, which started at 6.30am at three locations in Coimbatore, continued till evening.

Last year, the directorate had attached assets worth

Rs. 457 crore in a case against Martin linked to an alleged loss of over Rs. 900 crore caused to the Sikkim government due to fraudulent sale of the state lottery in Kerala. Martin's Future Gaming Solutions India Pvt. Ltd. is the master distributor of Sikkim lotteries in the country. Martin recently made news after it came to light through Election Commission data that his company (Future Gaming) was the largest purchaser of electoral bonds worth more than Rs 1,300 crore, between 2019 and 2024, meant for donation to various political parties.

The Madras High Court last month allowed the ED case against Martin and others to go on.

## No green cess if objections raised: Khandre

A day after asking the forest department to send a formal proposal on imposing a green cess on water bills, Forest Minister Eshwar B Khandre said if there are any objections, then it will not be implemented.

Reacting to questions raised by people on levying green cess, Khandre told reporters on Thursday that paying an additional Rs 2-3 a month comes up to 10 paise a day for a household. "It is not a financial burden. Water conservation and environmental protection are crucial. This is only a proposal and a final decision has not been taken. Even if one person objects to the idea, it will not be implemented," he said.

Khandre said, "A final decision be taken by the chief minister. The money collected in the cess will be used to protect the Western Ghats."

## Kappataguda a haven of medicinal plants too

CARNIVORES such as gray wolves, striped hyenas, leopards and golden jackals are in good numbers. Small carnivores such as jungle cats, rusty-spotted cats, small Indian civets, common palm civets, ruddy mongooses, and Indian gray mongooses also exist.

"Among the 18 species here, 16 are protected under Schedule I of the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972, highlighting the importance of the Kappataguda. Spread across 244.15 sq km in Gadag district with 17,872 ha of hills, the team surveyed 138 sq km in Gadag, Mundargi and Shirahatti taluks," the study said.

The forest has about 400 medicinal plant species. It experiences high velocity wind throughout the year. Because of this, several windmills here generate over 225 MW of energy. The sanctuary faces pressure from locals, who graze cattle, and collect firewood and minor forest produce from there.

## 'Curb illegal liquor sale in dhabas, hotels'

Additional counters should only be permitted on CL-9 licensed (bars) premises, and the related law should be amended to allow parcel supply of liquor and beer, he said. The other demands of the federation are: Conciliation penalties for general

prosecutions against licensees should be reduced, and penalties for unlicensed liquor sellers should be increased. Strict legal action should be taken to control illegal sale of liquor in dhabas, hotels and villages. Section 29 of the Excise Act, as amended in

2005, should be reviewed and amended. A fair decision should be taken regarding MSIL licenses. Strict action should be taken to stop selling of fake liquor under the guise of duty-free liquor, liquor from Goa, and raid centres of illicit liquor manufacturers.
