We wish to inform you that Matrix Geo Solutions Limited (“Matrix Geo” or “the Company”) has executed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with **DRIIV Foundation (Delhi Research Implementation and Innovation)**, the flagship Science & Technology cluster programme of the Office of the Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India, operating under the guidance of PM-STIAC.

This MoU represents an important step in Matrix Geo’s strategic roadmap to participate in nationally significant science, technology and innovation programmes, with a clear focus on translating advanced research into scalable, field-deployable geospatial, drone and GeoAI solutions for public sector and government stakeholders.

About DRIIV

DRIIV Foundation is the flagship programme of the Office of the Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India, established to manage the Delhi Science & Technology Cluster and enable collaborative, mission-driven research and innovation aligned with national priorities. It is an ecosystem comprising academic institutions, national laboratories, ministries, industry, startups, and global partners—focused on solving environmental and societal challenges such as water security, air pollution, solid waste management, sustainable mobility, and critical technologies.

Strategic Rationale for the MoU

The MoU aligns with Matrix Geo’s long-term focus on high-impact geospatial and data-driven solutions across water, infrastructure, environment, governance and national development missions. By combining DRIIV Foundation’s policy, institutional and programme-management capabilities with Matrix Geo’s execution strength in drones, LiDAR, GeoAI, analytics and cloud-based GIS platforms, the collaboration aims to create a structured pathway for delivering complex, multi-stakeholder projects at scale.

Under the MoU, DRIIV Foundation will act as the Project Management Partner and Implementing Agency, while Matrix Geo will serve as the Delivery Partner, responsible for on-ground execution, technology deployment and solution delivery.



Scope of the MoU

The collaboration establishes a framework to jointly pursue national- and state-level engagements across multiple domains, including:

- Drone and UAV-based surveys and monitoring
- LiDAR and high-resolution 3D digital twins
- GeoAI, spatial analytics and decision-support systems
- Satellite data integration and applications
- Cloud-native GIS platforms and data infrastructure
- Collaborative research, pilots, field deployments and capacity-building initiatives

The MoU is intended to enable pilot projects, demonstration deployments and programme-level initiatives that can be expanded into larger, multi-year implementations as project scopes are finalised.

Next Steps

The parties are currently in active discussions to identify and structure specific projects and pilot engagements under the MoU framework. While the MoU itself is non-binding and does not create any immediate commercial obligation, it is designed to facilitate the conversion of identified opportunities into scoped engagements and executable contracts in due course.

Management Commentary

Commenting on the development, Mr. Rahul Jain, Managing Director of Matrix Geo Solutions Limited, stated:

“DRIIV Foundation represents a nationally significant platform for converting research into real-world impact. This collaboration strengthens our ability to contribute meaningfully to Atmanirbhar Bharat by deploying drone, GeoAI and geospatial solutions that are execution-led, scalable and aligned with public sector priorities.”
