Contractor shall submit all necessary quantity calculations and supporting records along with the RA Bill.

- The quantities stated in this agreement are estimated and indicative, and final payment shall be determined based on verified physical measurements taken on-site. No additional claims or compensation shall be entertained on any grounds should the actual executed quantities be less than the estimated amounts..
- A 10% security deposit shall be withheld from the total contract value and released upon successful erection, commissioning, site verification by the RA Bill Engineer, and submission of the Final RA Bill along with all required supporting documents; furthermore, each bill shall be subject to deductions including, recoveries for materials supplied or expenses incurred by A&T Infracon Pvt. Ltd, and applicable Statutory TDS as per government laws.
- **Other Conditions:**

1. Shifting of material from one place to another as per site requirement shall be done by the Sub Contractor and the loading & unloading of goods shall be done by the Sub Contractor with the help of manpower.
2. Time period to complete the work shall be done as per the mutually agreed time duration from the date of accepting work order.
3. The entire work shall be executed **strictly in accordance with the approved drawings, technical specifications, and instructions (TCS) issued from time to time by CPWD and/or the Engineer-in-Charge.** The Sub Contractor shall ensure full compliance with all relevant standards, codes, and guidelines. Any deviation from the approved drawings or specifications without prior written approval shall not be acceptable and may lead to rejection of work and necessary corrective action at the Sub Contractor's risk and cost.
4. All machinery, equipment, T&P, etc., including shuttering moulds, vibrators, pins, grinders, halogen lights, cables, D.G. sets, welding machines, and other required tools shall be arranged and borne by the Sub Contractor at his own cost. The Sub Contractor shall also be responsible for their operation, maintenance, repair, and safe handling during the execution of the work.
5. The excavator required for excavation of the bed for girder shall be arranged by the Sub Contractor at his own cost. All other ancillary works necessary for the proper and complete execution of the job shall also be carried out by the Sub Contractor, including deployment of required resources, manpower, and equipment, without any additional cost to the Company.
6. The prices mentioned in this Work Order are inclusive of all applicable taxes, duties, and charges, as well as transportation and delivery expenses up to the site. No additional costs shall be claimed beyond the agreed PO value.
7. The Sub Contractor or his supervisor will be responsible to strictly observe all the safety procedures and shall be solely responsible for any miss happening or accidents at site during the implementation of the work.
8. The Sub Contractor shall indemnify Company against all losses and claims in respect of: -
 - a. death or injury to any person including his own employees, and
 - b. loss or damage to any property (including the Works), which may arise out of or in consequence of the execution and completion of the works and the remedying of any defects therein, and against all claims, proceedings, damages, costs, charges and expenses whatsoever in respect thereof or in relation thereto.
9. The Sub Contractor shall ensure that the work is executed on time and promptly after receiving the instructions from the company.
10. If we are at any time dissatisfied with the performance of the Sub Contractor the said agreement shall be terminated without assigning any reason to the Sub Contractor.



11. There shall not be any arbitration clause applicable in this work as mutually agreed between us and the Sub Contractor.
12. The scope of work also includes provision of necessary manpower (skilled, unskilled and supervisory staff) along with the machinery. The supply shall be borne by the sub contractor
13. The unit rates agreed under this Work Order shall remain firm and fixed for the entire duration of the contract and shall not be subject to any escalation, variation, or adjustment on any account whatsoever, including but not limited to changes in material costs, labor, taxes, market conditions, or any other factors.
14. The defects liability period is 12 months commencing from the issue of completion certificate. Payment for the executed work shall be released strictly based on actual measurements recorded at site and duly verified as per CPWD norms and procedures. All measurements shall be jointly recorded and certified by the authorized representatives. The Sub Contractor shall submit bills along with supporting measurement sheets, and payments shall be processed only after proper verification and approval by the Engineer-in-Charge.
15. The Sub Contractor shall keep the Main Sub Contractor fully indemnified and harmless against any claims, penalties, fines, losses, damages, liabilities, costs, expenses or legal proceedings arising out of any breach, violation or non-compliance of applicable laws, rules, regulations, labour laws or directions issued by the Central/State Government or statutory authorities in connection with this contract.
18. Before commencement of the work, the Sub Contractor shall, at his own cost, obtain and maintain valid insurance policies including but not limited to Workmen Compensation Insurance, Personal Accident Insurance, Med claim Insurance, and any other statutory or project-specific insurance as required under applicable laws.
19. The Sub Contractor shall be solely responsible for making all legally payable contributions, deposits and compliances as required under applicable laws, including but not limited to PF, ESIC, labour cess, employee benefits, wages, insurance, direct and indirect taxes, and all other statutory liabilities in respect of its employees/workers engaged for this contract. The Sub Contractor shall also ensure compliance with all applicable Government rules, labour laws, regulations and statutory requirements. The Company shall not be held liable for any default, non-compliance, claim, penalty or legal obligation arising out of the same. The subcontractor shall submit the copy of PF Challan to the contractor for the reference.
20. The Sub Contractor shall be solely responsible for the actions, behaviour and conduct of its labour/workers deployed at the site. The Sub Contractor shall ensure that no act of any worker hampers national interest, site security or creates any security concern as per the guidelines/instructions of BSF or concerned authorities. Any violation in this regard shall be the sole responsibility of the Sub Contractor.
21. GST Payment Terms: The GST portion of the Sub Contractor's bill shall be released only upon submission of a proper tax invoice and after filing of GSTR-1 by the Sub Contractor. The corresponding invoice and GST amount must be duly reflected and visible in our GSTR-2B for verification and input tax credit purposes.
22. Transit Damage: If material is damaged during transportation to the site, the Sub Contractor will bear the responsibility and replace such items at their own expense.
23. Damaged Items: If any item is found damaged, the Sub Contractor must replace it at their own expense.
