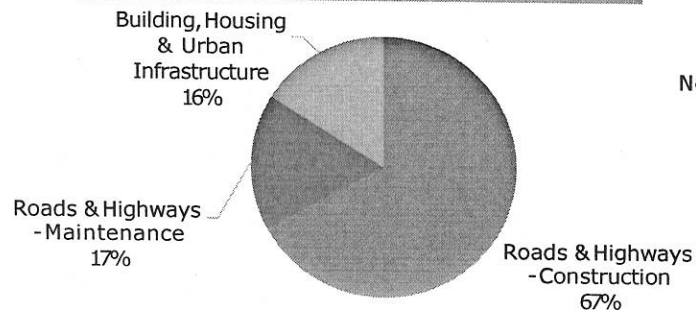
Company Overview

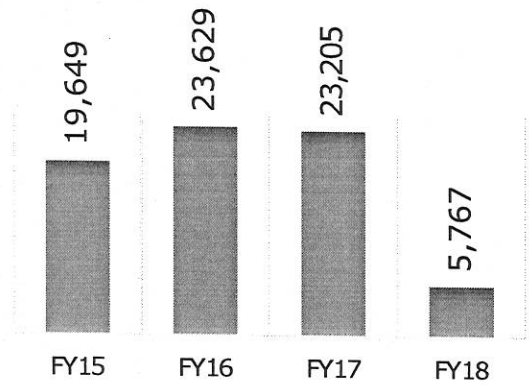

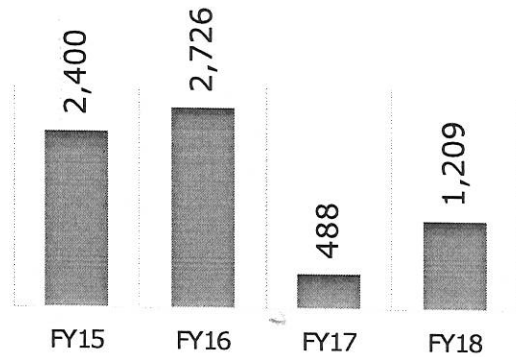

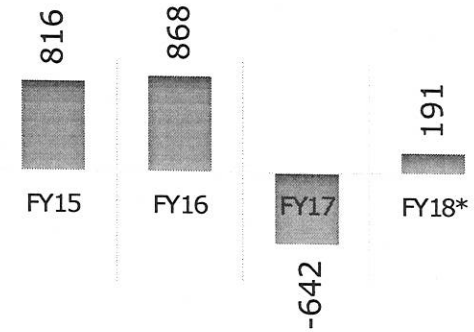
Revenue (INR Mn)



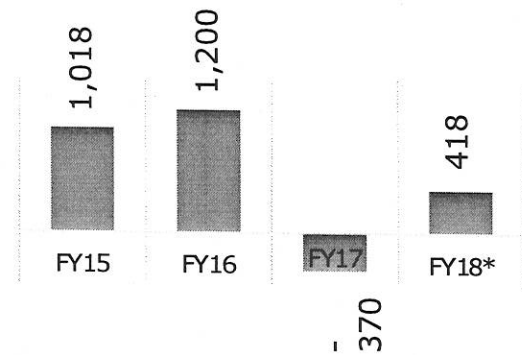
EBITDA (INR Mn)



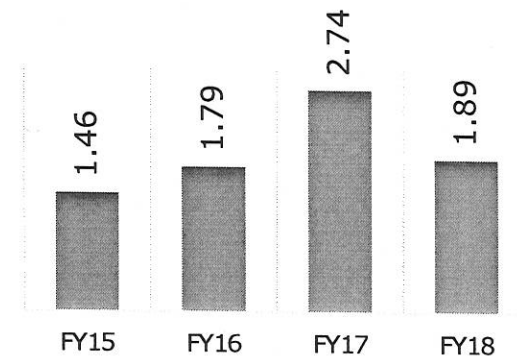
PAT (INRMn)
