Indian para athletes sign off with 16 medals in Finland

India signed off with a haul of 16 medals including six gold, four silver and six bronze, from the ITTF World Para Future Lahti tournament in Finland. The singles events accounted for 10 medals, while India paraathletes added six more in doubles including two gold, one silver and three bronze.

Rameshbhai Chaudhary and Sumit Sehgal spearheaded the men's doubles campaign in Classes 4-8, claiming gold with a composed 3-0 victory over South Africa's Ibrahim Abdullah and Rakan Abdulrahman in the final.

Sumit completed a memorable double, partnering with Deepikarajan Ramanathan to the mixed doubles title. The duo overcame Finland's Timo Kalavi and Aino Tapola 3-0 in the final.

Sonal Patel and Rameshbhai added a silver in mixed doubles after reaching the final, while three Indian combinations secured bronze. Shubham Wadhwa and JD Madan took the men's doubles bronze, Prachi Pandey and Savita Ajanakatti claimed bronze in women's doubles while Shivam Pal and Noorali Jaimani completed the doubles tally with a mixed doubles bronze.

Ankur wins maiden WTT title, doubles gold in Czechia

Indian paddler Ankur Bhattacharjee produced a memorable performance to win his maiden WTT men's singles title, while also securing the doubles gold with Akash Pal at the WTT Feeder Olomouc tournament in Czechia.

The World No. 78 overcame third-seed Slovenian Deni Kodz 3-1 (9-11, 11-4, 11-5, 11-6) in the singles final to cap a remarkable campaign. He had joined forces with Akash earlier to defeat Hungary's Csaba Andras Szantosi and Poland's Alan Kulczycki Zaleski 3-1 (11-8, 4-11, 13-11, 11-9) in the men's doubles final. The singles final began with a setback for Ankur as Kodz edged the opening game 11-9. The Indian, however, quickly found his rhythm, tightening his placement and controlling the rallies to win the next three games and seal the title. In the men's doubles, Ankur and Akash overcame early setback.

The duo took the opening game 11-8, but Szantosi and Zaleski levelled with an 11-4 second game.

The Indians regained the advantage in a closely fought third game, winning 13-11, before holding their nerve to close out the fourth 11-9.

Lakshya spearheads Indian challenge at China Masters, young women's singles trio in focus

Lakshya Sen will look to bounce back from the disappointment of his early exit at the World Championships but a tough opener awaits him when the spearheads the Indian challenge at the \$125,000 China Masters Super 750, beginning here on Tuesday.

Sen, who became the first Indian male shuttle to reach an Olympic semifinal in Paris two years ago before finishing fourth, will face France's newly-crowned world champion Alex Lanier in his opening match.

The Indian has enjoyed some notable results this season, including a runner-up finish at the All England Championships, and will be keen to regain consistency against strong field after a shock second-round loss to world number 92 Garrett Tan at the Worlds. Former World No. 1 Kidambi Srikanth, meanwhile, faces Chinese Taipei's Chi Yu-jen after reaching the US Open Super 300 final in June, where he finished runner-up.

His campaign on the Tour after that has been patchy. It was interrupted by an injury-forced retirement due to injury at the Canada Open before he suffered a first-round exit at the Korea Masters. In men's doubles, fourth seeds Satwiksrikant Rinkedreddy and Chirag Shetty will be among India's biggest hopes.

The former world Number 1 pair ended a two-year wait for an international title by winning the Singapore Open earlier this year.

They will open against China's Hu Ke Yuan and Lin Xiang Yi, who won the Orleans Masters title this season.

Satwik has been dealing with a recurring shoulder issue. The duo returned to action after missing a few events only to make a third-round exit from the Worlds at home. The Indian pair will hope for a deeper run as it builds up to the Asian Games title defence in Japan.

India's young women's singles contingent will also be under the spotlight, with young prospects Unnati Hooda, Tanvi Sharma and Devika Sihag carrying the national flag.

Unnati, the 18-year-old from Rohatk, faces fifth seed Han Yue of China.

She became the youngest Indian to win a BWF World Tour title when she claimed the Odisha Open Super 100 crown in 2022 as an unseeded 14-year-old. She has since added the Abu Dhabi Masters and Odisha Masters titles to her cabinet. Tanvi takes on Denmark's Amalie Schulz. The 17-year-old from Hoshiarpur climbed to the junior world No. 1 ranking last year, a run that included a silver medal in singles and a bronze in the mixed team event at the 2025 World Junior Championships - making her the first Indian to win more than one medal at a single edition of that event.

She underlined her rapid rise this year by becoming the youngest-ever winner of the Taipei Open Super 300.

The 2026 Hockey World Cup will be remembered for broken barriers, missed opportunities and shifting hierarchies, with Argentina ending the long Dutch reign in women's hockey, Germany retaining the men's title and India once again left to rue a missed opportunity.

For 16 days, hockey took centre stage across the Netherlands and Belgium, the first time since the 1998 World Cup in Utrecht that the men's and women's tournaments were played simultaneously, though in two countries.

It was like a carnival in Amstelveen, with packed stands, mostly orange soaked passionate fans and music.

Secluded Wavre offered a more intimate and feel with fans enjoying hockey over drinks and waffles, adding a distinct Belgian flavour to the tournament.

The biggest story of the women's competition was the end of Dutch dominance. Nine-time champions and Paris Olympic gold medalist the Netherlands were denied a fourth successive World Cup title by a courageous Argentina in front of a packed home crowd.



The final was locked at 1-1 after 60 minutes before Argentina prevailed 3-1 in the shootout. Argentina had last won the title in Rosario in 2010. Rosario incidentally is the birthplace of legendary Lionel Messi.

Belgium defeated Australia for bronze, while Paris Olympic silver medalist China finished eighth.

The women's tournament showed how narrow the margins have become. Both semi-finals and the bronze-medal match were decided by a single goal, while the final went to a shootout.

Dutch drag-flicker Yibbi Jansen was the top scorer with eight goals and also reached 100 international goals.

Germany retained the title won in Bhubaneswar in 2023, defeating

Spain in the final at Belfius arena, Wavre. Spain, after stunning hosts the Netherlands, reached the final for the first time since 1998 and pushed Germany hard.

But a 44th-minute goal and Germany's disciplined defence proved decisive, giving them a fourth Women's Cup title and taking them level with Pakistan.

Belgium, the 2018 champions and co-hosts, finished seventh, while Australia failed to make an impact in either section.

Women's campaign was the most encouraging story from India's perspective.

The team lost only once, to the

Netherlands, after holding China, beating South Africa 6-1 and drawing with England.

A goalless draw with Australia ended their semi-final hopes, but India bounced back to beat higher-ranked Germany in the fifth-place match - their best World Cup finish since 1974. The achievement was particularly impressive with 11 World Cup debutants in the squad.

Young goalkeeper Bichoo Devi's spectacular save against England in the last 30 seconds was one of the tournament's memorable moments, while the experience of Savita Punia provided an important balance.

Djokovic out in US Open 1st round for first time

The US Open's Sunday start gives some players a chance to get a nice head start. For Novak Djokovic, it turned into a stunning head start back to the airport. The 24-time Grand Slam champion was knocked out in the first round of the US Open for the first time, beaten by Mariano Navone of Argentina 7-6 (5), 5-7, 4-6, 6-2, 6-1.

Djokovic was 19-0 in the US Open first round and hadn't lost his opening match in any major since the 2006 Australian Open.

"It's a good record, another one. But yeah, I'm not really thinking about it," Djokovic said. "Of course, I've been very proud of all the achievements in the past, but now is now."

And now the No. 4 seeded and four-time champion in Flushing Meadows looks every bit of his 39 years, vomiting and battling leg

problems during a match that lasted more than 4 1/2 hours. "Now I have to recover," Navone said. "It's almost 12 o'clock."

It made for a lengthy first day of play, with Venus Williams and fellow wild card Sofia Kenin not getting on the court until past midnight - after their match was set to move to another stadium but the players decided to wait and keep it in the main venue.

Kenin beat the 46-year-old Williams 6-2, 7-6 (6).

Nearly 12 hours earlier, third-seeded Jessica Pegula again experienced the benefits of the Sunday start that began last year. "It is a little bit weird, but I did kind of enjoy that I could breathe for the next couple of days and everyone else is still freaking out about whether they're going to win their first round," she said.

Djokovic later expe-

rienced the downside. "We were just talking about it, and I said, it's so nice to play on Sunday when you win. But if you lose it's not nice, because you feel like the tournament didn't even start and you're out of it," No. 11 seed Marta Kostyuk said. Pegula and Kostyuk both won easily and now the get the benefit of an extra day of rest before returning for the second round, where Pegula will play Kenin.

Pegula leads the women's tour with 46 wins this season. She has two titles and has reached three other finals. Pegula can become Rank 1 in rankings if she wins her first major title and Rank 2 Elena Rybakina loses before semifinals.

The No. 11-seeded Kostyuk beat Storm Hunter 6-4, 6-1 for a strong start to year's final major after reaching the semifinals at the French Open and Wimbledon. Some of the biggest headlines don't begin until Monday.

US Open getting longer, players left worried

The US Open was a week old by the time Aryna Sabalenka and Carlos Alcaraz opened their title defenses. What once was a two-week quest for a Grand Slam championship now extends into a third week, and US Tennis Association CEO Craig Tiley was asked how he hoped to continue that growth. "Four weeks," he said with a smile.

Some players might fear he is serious.

They were already becoming wary of an overcrowded schedule that makes it hard

to find many moves, even before the US Open moved up the beginning of the singles main draw last year to make it a Sunday start.
