Surat man gets 4.5 yrs in US jail for smuggling fentanyl precursor as 'Vitamin C'

A BUSINESSMAN from Gujarat has been sentenced to over four years in prison in the US for using his Surat-based company to smuggle chemicals used to manufacture fentanyl, a synthetic opioid illegally used in recreational drugs.

US District Judge Pamela K. Chen sentenced Bhavesh Lathia, 37, to 54 months in prison. Lathia, who founded and led Surat-based Raxuter Chemicals, pleaded guilty in April to smuggling and distributing precursor chemicals, knowing they would be used to manufacture fentanyl. He was also ordered to pay forfeiture of \$24,560 and will be deported once his prison term ends.

According to court filings filed by US Attorney Joseph Nocella, Jr.'s Office for the Eastern District of New York, Raxuter Chemicals sold and smuggled more than 50 pounds of chemicals commonly used in fentanyl manufacture, supplying buyers in the United States and Mexico.

"During a national crisis when hundreds of Americans were dying every day from fentanyl overdoses, Lathia smuggled and distributed chemical ingredients, including those that were the building blocks for this deadly drug, without any regard for the harm that his conduct would cause," stated Attorney Nocella. He said the sentence sent a message that the offence would "hold pre-

cursor traffickers like the defendant accountable for their role in the fentanyl supply chain".

The Surat-based company shipped its products through international mail and package carriers, and prosecutors said the chemicals it distributed covered all the materials needed to manufacture fentanyl through the most common synthesis routes. The evidence detected at the border, Lathia allegedly mislabelled packages and falsified customs declarations.

Drugs shipment labelled Vitamin C

One shipment delivered to an address in the Eastern District of New York on June 29, 2024, was described as manifest as "Vitamin C". Court filings state that the package contained 1-Boc-4-piperidine, a List I chemical and unlawfully imported fentanyl precursor.

Investigators from Homeland Security Investigations, New York, working under a Homeland Security Task Force, also recorded Lathia discussing chemical sales over video

calls with an undercover officer on October 2 and October 15, 2024. After the undercover officer told him that his "clients in Mexico were very happy with the quality of what you sent me" and "the yield they got of the final product", Lathia agreed to sell 20 kilograms of 1-Boc-4-piperidine—a chemical building block. He proposed labelling the chemical as an antidote to avoid scrutiny.

The undercover officer, referring to the substance, remarked that it was "a very controversial product" that was "banned," adding that shipping to Mexico could be easier because of the pressure authorities faced "because of fentanyl". On November 23, 2024, Raxuter Chemicals and Lathia shipped roughly 20 kilograms of the chemical to the Eastern District of New York, mislabelled as an antidote.

Homeland Security Investigation Acting Special Agent in Charge Isaac Glaser said Lathia's conduct had placed him "at the source of the fentanyl supply chain, where he knowingly moved the chemical building blocks of a lethal drug into the United States through deception, false labeling, and international shipments in a prosecution that breaks new ground against an India-based supplier." His investigation reflected a resolve "to attack the fentanyl supply chain before the poison is manufactured, packaged, and sold to the public."

Musician Gaurang Vyas dies at 87

VETERAN GUJARATI musician and singer Gaurang Vyas, who made a significant contribution to film and folk music, died early on Thursday following a brief illness and age-related health issues, his family members said.

Vyas was a prominent name in Gujarati film, folk and light music. His work carried forward the musical legacy of his father Avinash Vyas, one of the most influential composers associated with Gujarati music.

Gaurang Vyas had carried forward the rich musical tradition of his father and made his own mark in Gujarati music, he noted.

"His demise leaves Gujarat feeling the loss of a talented creator. His invaluable contributions to the Gujarati music scene will always be remembered," Modi said.

He also offered prayers for the departed soul and condolences to Vyas' family and his "vast legion of fans".

Union Home Minister Amit Shah also mourned Gaurang Vyas's death, calling it an "irreparable loss" for the Gujarati music world.

SC frees truck with 'liquor bottles', says seized vehicles can't languish in yard

A TRUCK seized on a Gujarat highway, allegedly with more than 8,000 bottles of prohibited liquor, cannot be left to "languish and deteriorate" in a police station for years while the criminal case moves through the courts, the Supreme Court has ruled, ordering the vehicle's release to the owner.

A bench of Justices Prashant Kumar Mishra and Shree Chandrashekar on Wednesday asked "what purpose is actually served by continued custody and placing the vehicle in a state of suspended animation" once seized under the Gujarat Prohibition Act, 1949.

The ruling came in a case arising from the seizure of an Ashok Leyland truck travelling towards Vadodra through Lavanwadi in January 2025. The police allegedly found 8,064 bottles of Indian Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL), concealed among other goods, in the vehicle.

The Supreme Court said that allowing seized commercial vehicles to remain in police or court compounds until the conclusion of a trial served little purpose and inflicted substantial losses on their owners.

"Vehicles, prevented from being released back to their owners under Section 98(2), languish and deteriorate sitting in police station or court compound until final disposal of the criminal case. This benefits no one and causes major losses to the owner," the bench observed.

The court overturned orders

of the Gujarat High Court, a sessions court, and a magistrate, which had refused to hand over interim custody of the truck to its owner, Ms ABC Express.

When the police intercepted the truck

The case relates to an incident that occurred on the intervening night of January 4 and 5 last year when the police intercepted a truck travelling from Modasa towards Vadodra via Lavanwadi in Gujarat.

The truck driver allegedly told the police that the vehicle was carrying miscellaneous goods belonging to ABC Express. When the police opened the rear compartment, however, they found plastic bags, boxes, and cardboard cartons containing liquor. The driver could not produce a pass or permit authorising its transportation, according to the prosecution.

The police allegedly recovered 8,064 bottles of IMFL, amounting to about 22,532 litres and valued at Rs 1702 lakh. The truck was also carrying edible transport goods worth nearly Rs 98.67 lakh. A chargesheet was later filed after four accused, including the driver.

The owner sought interim custody of the truck, arguing that it was a commercial vehicle and that its continued detention would cause financial loss while it deteriorated. The company also maintained that the owner was not involved in the alleged offence and offered to furnish adequate security.

Vadnagar to Varanasi & back: BJP lines up bike rallies to mark Modi's 25 years in public office

TO MARK the completion of 25 years of Prime Minister Narendra Modi in public office, the Gujarat Chief Minister and then as Prime Minister—the Gujarat BJP has organised a range of programmes under the banner 'Vadnagar to Varanasi'. These will include motorcycle rallies from Vadnagar to Varanasi in Uttar Pradesh and back, a party statement said.

Participants in the bike rally will carry water from several rivers of Gujarat to perform 'jalabhishek' at Kashi Vishwanath in Varanasi and Ganga water to perform 'jalabhishek' at Hatkeshwar Mahadev temple in Vadnagar.

Vadnagar in Mahesana district of north Gujarat is PM Modi's hometown and Varanasi is the Lok Sabha constituency from which he is elected.

Modi became Chief Minister of



Gujarat on October 7, 2001. He has been holding a public office since then. In May 2014, he went on to become the Prime Minister. Next month, October 7, marks 25 years of Modi in public office as 'head of state'. To mark the occasion, the Gujarat BJP has organised several programmes between September 17 and October 17. PM Modi's birthday is on September 17.

"The state BJP convened a workshop in Gandhinagar to discuss the programmes to be organised in the presence of the party's Gujarat in-charge Tarun Chugh, state unit chief Jagdish Vishwakarma, Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel, Deputy Chief Minister Harish Sanghani and organising secretary of the party in

Gujarat Ratnakar, among others. Chugh is visiting Gujarat for the first time after being appointed as the state party in-charge recently, replacing Union Minister Bhupendra Patel in Vadnagar.

An official party release, quoting state organisation secretary Ratnakar, provided details of the campaign. A motorcycle rally will be organised from Vadnagar to Varanasi carrying water collected from Gujarat's sacred rivers to perform a 'jalabhishek' (water ritual) for Kashi Vishwanath. On the return journey, Holy Ganga water will be brought to Vadnagar to perform a 'jalabhishek' for Lord Hatkeshwar Mahadev in Vadnagar," the statement said.

The Gujarat BJP's media convener, Prashant Vaid, said that around 500 members of the party's youth wing in the state would embark on a rally from Vadnagar to 250 bikes, carrying water from the state's rivers. "They will follow

three different routes to reach Varanasi. On the way, they will spread the message of various developmental works done under PM Modi. Similarly, another set of 500 youth wing workers from the party in Uttar Pradesh will undertake a journey from Varanasi to Vadnagar on bikes with water from the Ganga," Vaid said.

About other programmes, the statement said, "under the 'Ashwamedh No Deevdo' (Lamp of Blessings) programme, beneficiary families of various government schemes of every polling booth will light a lamp to express gratitude for PM Modi's 25 years of public service. This lamp will symbolise the collective resolve of 'Vishat Bharat 2047'."

The programmes will also include formation of 'Human Rangoli' at main public places and innovation challenge among students, startups, professionals and grassroots innovators.
