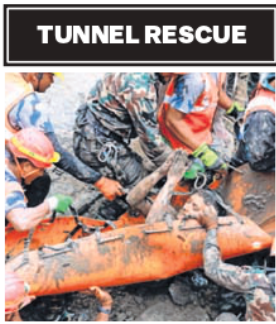
Air pocket, muddy water kept Nepal duo alive

KATHMANDU

Two hydropower workers were rescued alive after surviving nine days trapped inside a flooded tunnel following a massive glacial collapse in Nepal on August 26. The disaster unleashed mudslides that killed over 1,300 people and submerged 12 power projects.

Kabir Maharjan and mechanical foreman Sanjay Sah took shelter in an air pocket inside a sloped cable-duct tunnel at the Upper Trishuli 3A project. For nine days in pitch darkness, Sah recited prayers while Maharjan sipped muddy water to survive.

Rescuers led by engineer Shri Ram Neupane faced ex-



treme hurdles, including saturated land, heavy rain, and collapsed passages. Crews drilled boreholes and used high-pressure water jets to clear mud-filled blockages.

On the 10th day, rescue workers heard voices responding with "hunuhuncha" (we are here) through a

Kathmandu: The death toll from the flash floods in Nepal rose to 1,357 on Tuesday as more bodies were recovered. Rescue teams continued to search for 5,326 people, while 13,583 people have been rescued so far, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Authority (NDRRMA) said on Tuesday.

Maharjan was hospitalised with a leg injury, while Sah was carried out on a rescuer's back.

Canada rolls out up to 50% tariffs on US goods

Prime Minister Mark Carney has acknowledged that Canada's move to reduce economic reliance on the US "will come at a cost", as Ottawa implemented retaliatory tariffs of up to 50% on American imports on Tuesday.

The counter-measures target nearly C\$28 billion (\$20 billion) worth of US products, including steel, aluminium, dairy and clothing. Carney stated the levies are necessary to protect Canadian workers and build economic resilience following the collapse of bilateral trade negotiations in late Au-

gust.

"There's always a cost to action, but it doesn't come close to the cost of standing still," Carney said in a video address.

The escalation comes amid rising tensions with Washington. US Trade Representative Jamieson Greer signaled that retaliatory US tariffs could be announced imminently. Meanwhile, US President Donald Trump threatened to halt US business with Canadian aerospace giant Bombardier unless it moves manufacturing to the US. Bombardier contributes over C\$7 billion annually to Canada's gross domestic product.

Ahead of 9/11, EU flags new terror threats

Brussels: European Union Counter-Terrorism Coordinator Gilles de Kerchove warned that ISIS may be planning car bomb attacks in European cities.

Addressing a European Parliament committee hearing, Kerchove stated terrorists are increasingly targeting soft targets using easily available items like trucks and knives.

European Parliament members questioned Kerchove on information sharing, prevention strategies, and co-operation with Security Commissioner Julian King following recent attacks, including the March Brussels bombings that killed 32 people.

Hungary expels 10 Russia officials; Moscow warns of severe response

Hungary ordered 10 members of Russia's diplomatic mission in Budapest to leave the country over activities deemed unacceptable, Foreign Minister Anita Orbán said on Tuesday.

The move signals a foreign policy shift under Prime Minister Peter Magyar, who took office earlier this year promis-

ing to dismantle power structures left by predecessor Viktor Orbán, a long-time ally of Russian President Vladimir Putin.

Anita Orbán stated that the expulsion protects Hungary's security and sovereignty, though Budapest intends to maintain necessary diplomatic dialogue with Moscow.

The Russian Foreign Ministry promised an appropriate response.

"The response to the Russophobic lobby in Budapest will be harsh and painful," Ministry spokesperson Maria Zakharova told state-run news agency TASS.

This extremely unfriendly step is an unprecedented and unjustified escalation on the Hungarian side, and it will receive an appropriate response," Russia's ambassador to Budapest, Evgeny Stanislavov said in statement.

UK ATC glitch leads to nearly 300 flight cancellations

London: Nearly 300 flights were cancelled Tuesday because of a technical issue in the UK air traffic control system, the flight monitoring website Flightradar24 reported. Britain's National Air Traffic Services said earlier Tuesday afternoon that engineers were urgently working on the issue, which was affecting departing flights. It said recovery would take some time. Flightradar24 reported that the problem affected multiple airlines, including British Airways and Easyjet.

World's most endangered tigers born in Greek zoo

The world's most endangered tigers have started a family in Greece, offering hope for a predator that is rapidly vanishing from the wild.

Three 2-month-old Sumatran tiger cubs received identification microchips and their first vaccinations on Tuesday at a zoo near Athens, as part of a global effort to build a backup population. The Sumatran tiger, classified as critically endangered by the United Nations and conservation groups, is found only on the Indonesian island of Sumatra, which is slightly larger than Sweden. As few as 400 are believed to remain in the wild, mainly because of aggressive forest clearing.
