Cami sought Epstein investment

Cami Clark, wife and adviser of Anthropic CEO Dario Amodei, sought investment from disgraced financier Jeffrey Epstein for an adult entertainment company, according to The Wall Street Journal and emails in the Epstein files. Clark was introduced to Epstein in March 2011 by literary agent John Brockman, three years after Epstein was convicted of soliciting prostitution and another offence. Emails show Clark later sent Epstein details about the venture and sought investment in March 2012. There is no indication he invested. Clark married Amodei in 2022 and has been dubbed a strategic adviser and sounding board for him and Anthropic.

Dubai: Iran's Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi said talks with Oman were a "completely separate" matter from reopening the Strait of Hormuz. "Our negotiations with Oman are ongoing. That is a completely separate matter. It is a technical issue concerning the designation of maritime routes in the Strait of Hormuz for the passage of ships," Araghchi told Shahrara News, as per Al Jazeera. "The routes that existed previously are no longer functional, so a new route needs to be defined. For now, we are designing a temporary route, which can then, at a later stage, be turned into a final route."

85% OF AIR DEFENCE CAPACITY SURVIVED WAR, SAYS IRGC

An official with Iran's IRGC said over 85% of the force's air defence production capacity remained undamaged during the war. In an interview featured in a documentary published by Fars news agency, the official said despite attacks on Iran's military production infrastructure, production and delivery of missiles and air defence systems had not fallen from pre-war levels. He said much of the IRGC's air defence equipment was produced by the force's self-sufficiency organisation and claimed output in some areas had since increased. The official said Iran's stock of operational air defence systems was now in a better position than at the start of the fighting.

and declining oil revenues. Pezeshkian said the bombing of industrial facilities had also hit government coffers. "The issue of livelihoods that our brother is talking about, the rise in prices he is talking about, is natural. Previously, we used to bring goods by ship, now they have to travel the entire route before reaching us. The cost of the finished product has shot up." "Our income has also decreased. We used to sell oil, but now we cannot sell it. They have destroyed a number of factories, and we cannot collect taxes from them in the same way. The wheels of the economy have to keep turning," he added.

'DEFENDERS WILL BREAK YOUR LEGS' Iranian army commander Major General Amir Hatami criticised US President Donald Trump over his remarks on the strait. "Joking about such remarks is a major mistake, because this is Iran, and it has defenders who will break your legs," Hatami said.

He said US forces had "effectively been driven out" and no longer had permission to enter the Gulf, Sea of Oman or the strait. Hatami added US bases would not be allowed to return to their previous status.

\$30K BOUNTY FOR KILLING US TROOPS Iran's Army has offered \$30,000 to anyone who kills or captures and hands over a US soldier, AFP reported. Army chief Amir Hatami announced the bounty, saying women would receive double the amount. Hatami said the plan followed requests from Iranians seeking to take part. He did not specify where such actions would take place.

'IRAN HAS WON WAR' Iranian parliamentary leader Mohammad Bagher Ghalibaf said Iran had won the war militarily and politically, as per the Fars news agency. "Iran truly won the war both militarily and politically. The conflict is a cowardly war led by the US and Israel; the Iranian people fought bravely, manfully and sincerely."

JAN PROTESTS: MAN EXECUTED

Iran's judiciary has announced the execution of a man convicted of running over several police officers with his car during anti-government protests in January. "Shahram Sadeghi, sentenced to death for having carried out an operational action in support of the Zionist regime and the US, was executed this morning," the judiciary's Mizan Online website said, adding, Sadeghi had run over several cops with his car on Jan 8 in Tehran, injuring 7.

Iranian prisoners of war from Iraq, it said the legacy of "resistance" had passed to a new generation of Iranians who stood against what it described as the world's most heavily equipped military.

Ukraine's massive drone attack on Russia kills six

Moscow says 822 Ukrainian | Russian strikes claim five drones destroyed overnight | lives in Ukraine, injure 20

Moscow: Ukraine launched hundreds of drones across Russia on Sunday, killing at least six people in one of Kyiv's largest aerial attacks of the war, while Russian strikes killed five in Ukraine.

Russia's Ministry of Defence said it destroyed 822 Ukrainian drones overnight. Moscow Mayor Sergei Sobyanin said about 600 drones were detected heading towards the capital. An 83-year-old man was killed when a drone hit a home in the Moscow region, local Governor Andrey Vorobyov said. Another attack sparked a fire at a Wildberries warehouse in Podolsk. In the southwestern Rostov region, over 150 drones targeted three towns, killing five people, Governor Yuri Slyusar said. Homes and a railway station were damaged.

In Ukraine, a Russian missile strike on Kryvyi Rih killed two people and wounded 14, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy said. One person was killed in Sumy, while two died when a strike hit a home in the southern Zaporizhzhia region. Russian attacks also sparked fires across Kyiv, wounding six people and setting ablaze one



UKRAINIAN DEFECTOR KILLED IN CRIMEA: A blast in Russian-occupied Crimea killed Ukrainian naval defector Robert Shageev, 49, reports said. Russia arrested Margarita Reut, 32, for allegedly planting an explosive device in a rubbish bin near Shageev. She has been charged with terrorism resulting in death.

BRITAIN'S DRONES USED FOR STRIKES DEEP INSIDE RUSSIA

British-made drones have been used to strike military and industrial targets inside Russia for the first time, the BBC reported, citing a military source. The drones, built by two British firms, have targeted refineries and warehouses, among other sites. Britain's ministry of defence announced in April it would supply Ukraine with tens of thousands of drones, including long-range strike devices, as part of its biggest such package.

Indonesia quake toll 53, rescuers scour rubble

Thousands displaced as landslides cut off Flores villages

Ruteng: Rescue teams in eastern Indonesia recovered six more bodies on Sunday after a magnitude-7.7 earthquake struck a day earlier, taking the toll to 53, authorities said. Thousands have been displaced. Rescuers searched debris for people feared buried under landslides triggered by the quake across six regencies on Flores, a predominantly Catholic island in Muslim-majority Indonesia. They focused on three regencies that remained inaccessible: the worst-hit Manggarai, East Manggarai and Nagekeo. "We have cleared most landslides and reopened roads to previously isolated villages, although communication disruptions and power outages continue to hamper search efforts," said Fathur Rahman, head of the Search and Rescue Office in Maumere, the capital of Sikka regency. The East Nusa Tenggara provincial government declared a 14-day emergency response.

Five dead as floods lash Indiana in US

Indiana: At least five people died after severe storms and flooding battered Indiana. Hundreds were evacuated as rivers reached record levels. Rescuers used boats to save people stranded by rising waters in Indianapolis. President Trump approved an emergency declaration, making federal disaster aid available.

NINE DEAD AS RAINS BATTER JAPAN
Torrential rain in Japan killed nine people and flooded 1,000 homes. Chiba recorded 300mm rain in 24 hours, making it the wettest August in six decades. Over 70 houses were partially destroyed and 1,200 cars abandoned on roads. The rains hit transport and caused power outages.

TWO DEAD IN GREEK ISLAND WILDFIRE
Two people were found dead on Sunday as firefighters battled a wildfire on the Greek island of Salamina. Four others were injured. Meanwhile, firemen battled a massive wildfire in Belgium on Sunday, forcing 600 residents to evacuate. —Agencies
