Not a Long-term Solution: Experts

Blocking incoming calls for customers who have not topped up after the grace period is an industry practice now, and the grace period offered by each telco has been communicated to the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India, said industry officials.
Both Bharti Airtel and Jio have reported marginal to flat ARPU growth for the fourth quarter of 2022-23. Bharti Airtel's ARPU was flat quarter-on-quarter at ₹198, while Jio's ARPU increased marginally to ₹178 from ₹172 in the previous quarter. Jio is yet to disclose its financials for the quarter ended March 31.
Bharti Airtel, which wants ARPU to increase to ₹200 in the medium term, Jio, and Vi do not respond to ET's queries on the matter till press time.
"Telcos should carefully evaluate their implementation of such strategies to increase ARPU. Balancing customer satisfaction and revenue growth is crucial to maintain a positive customer experience and retain a loyal subscriber base," said Murtuza Kachwala, managing director, Proviiv Member Firm for India.
Experts said that measures around stopping incoming calls or restricting the number of data tops could serve as stopgaps at best, and do not offer a long-term solution for significant ARPU growth.

"While these measures help increase ARPU in small amounts, as is evident from the fiscal fourth-quarter numbers, only headwinds for telcos can help bring significant growth on the metric," said an analyst with a leading brokerage, who did not wish to be identified.
However, with the general election slated for the first half of 2024, the next round of tariff hikes can be expected only after the election, said analysts.
Both Vi and Bharti Airtel have voiced their concern over pricing, with Bharti Airtel chief executive Gopal Vittal calling India's telecom pricing structure "broken" in the company's latest earnings call.
Earlier this year, Vi chief Akshaya Moondra said the tariff norms in the country need to change from a one-size-fits-all structure to "pay for what you use".
India last saw tariff hikes across the three telcos in November-December 2021. Since then, there has been no significant increase in prepaid tariffs. In November 2022, Bharti Airtel raised the tariff of its entry-level packs from ₹99 to ₹155 in Haryana and Odisha markets, and has now done so across 22 circles.

There was some concern over a postpaid tariff hike considering the difference between prepaid and postpaid pricing has narrowed down considerably. This too is now on the back burner, analysts said, since Jio has ramped up its efforts to corner a larger market share in the postpaid segment through aggressively priced plans, a strategy Reliance Industries president Kiran Thomas reiterated in the company's fourth-quarter earnings call.

GAIL entered into a 20-year deal with GEMTS in 2012 for annual supply of an average of 1 million tonnes of LNG. GEMTS was a unit of Gazprom Germania, now named Sef. However, Gazprom Germania gave up GEMTS ownership after sanctions were imposed on Moscow for invading Ukraine last year.
The Russia-Ukraine war sent LNG prices soaring and created a shortage of the fuel. GAIL tried to mitigate the shortfall of gas by cutting down supplies to fertiliser and power plants and also reducing consumption of its own Patna petrochemical plant in Uttar Pradesh to 40%.
GEMTS was to supply 40 cargoes per annum to GAIL. Of this, only 16 cargoes were supplied, said GAIL officials. According to industry estimates, the 24 cargoes could be valued at over ₹2,000-crore.

Gupta said GAIL has been receiving the contracted quantity for the past two months. It expects these volumes to continue going forward.
GAIL ended at ₹104.85, down 1.3%, on the BSE Friday. The benchmark Sensex ended 0.48% higher.

The stock ended at ₹64.54, up 1.72%, on the BSE.
For the full year ending March 31, 2023, Gurgaon-based firm's loss narrowed to ₹77 crore from ₹1,289 crore a year ago. Revenue grew 69% to ₹7,079 crore, in FY23.
Sequentially, Zomato's food delivery business reported an over threefold jump in adjusted EBITDA to ₹78 crore in the March quarter from the October-December period, as adjusted revenue for the vertical fell marginally to ₹1,530 crore from ₹1,565 crore.
Zomato's Bengaluru-based rival Swiggy had on Thursday said that its food delivery business turned profitable in March, excluding employee stock option costs.
The company also announced three key appointments. Rakesh Ranjan and Anand Chandra were named chief executive officer and chief operating officer, respectively, of the food ordering and delivery vertical. Rishi Aro, who was elevated to Blinkit cofounder last July, was appointed CEO of the company's B2B grocery vertical Hyperpure.
While Ranjan was business head of new businesses at Zomato, Chandra was vice president of product at the company. Aro had worked with Blinkit, formerly known as Grofers, for almost nine years and held the position of senior vice president of operations before being elevated to cofounder of Blinkit in July last year.

FOOD DELIVERY
The company's mainstay food delivery business reported a revenue of ₹1,530 crore for the quarter, compared with ₹1,284 crore a year ago. The B2B vertical reported revenue of ₹478 crore compared with ₹194 crore a year ago. Blinkit reported revenue of ₹363 crore against ₹301 crore in the previous quarter.
Zomato chief financial officer Akshay Goyal indicated that the company gained market share in food delivery during the March quarter as well as FY23.

ET reported on May 11 that shopping across e-commerce platforms was growing slower than anticipated, according to industry executives, multiple brands and third-party platform tracking shipment and sales data.
Data from Unicommerce, an e-commerce-focused software solutions provider, showed 16% year-on-year volume growth in the March quarter. Third-quarter volumes climbed approximately 18%.
Deliveries said March-quarter shipments grew to 180 million from 170 million in the preceding one. Revenue from express parcel services, multiple brands and third-party platforms, fell 1% sequentially to ₹1,177 crore in the fourth quarter.
For the full year ending March 31, 2022, revenue from operations grew 3% year-on-year to ₹23.3 crore. Net loss, however, was little changed at ₹20.8 crore, compared to ₹1,01 crore in FY22.
The company has seen its market share in e-commerce shipments slip to an estimated 5% in FY22 from 2% in FY21. That's expected to decline to 10% by FY30, according to a report by brokerage firm Bernstein.

"The momentum built up in express and part trackload in Q3 has carried into Q4 as well," said Sahil Barua, managing director and chief executive officer of Delivery. "We were confident of continued improvement in the core transportation business and overall profitability at the end of last quarter and are happy to report we have delivered both in this quarter as planned."
The company has aggressive infrastructure and capability expansion plans and is confident of a strong start in April and the first half of May continuing through the year, he said.

With the central bank gradually pulling out these notes after having stopped their printing in 2019, the common man doesn't possess them in large numbers.
"This would have an immediate impact on cash-heavy businesses and on the grey market, and that will put a check not only on the black money circulation but also its generation," said Rahul Garg, managing partner, Astré Consulting, which specialises in tax and regulatory consultancy.
"It would be a masterstroke by the government as cash hoarders who converted their ₹1,000 denomination notes into ₹2,000 notes in anticipation of further ease in their activities would face a setback as it would be almost impossible for them to exchange the notes within the four-month window."

LEGAL MONEY
The denomination will, however, continue to be legal tender, unlike what happened during the November 2016 demonetisation, when they turned into unusable bills overnight.
"It has also been observed that this denomination is less commonly used for transactions," the RBI said in a statement Friday. "Further, the stock of banknotes in other denominations continues to be adequate to meet the currency requirement of the public. And in pursuance of the 'Clean Note Policy', it has been decided to withdraw the ₹2,000 denomination banknotes from circulation."
Prime Minister Narendra Modi in November 2016 shocked the nation by demonetising currency denominations of ₹500 and ₹1,000 in an effort to curb black economy.

A government official told ET that a system which aggregates all spending under LRS already exists. "So, there is no scope of evading it even if you have multiple cards—debit or credit—or cash," he said. Even transactions that are split to remain under the ₹5 lakh limit will be captured.
Corporate cards given to employees for official expenditure overseas will also not attract TCS, as these expenses are covered under residual current account transactions outside the LRS.
The limit is in line with remittances for education or medical treatment.
Payments of up to ₹7 lakh under the LRS for medical treatment and education overseas do not attract TCS and this beneficial status will continue, the statement said. For those who take loans for overseas education, a lower 0.5% TCS will be levied above the ₹7 lakh threshold.
Other expenditure under LRS will face 20% TCS from July 1 following a change in the provisions in the last budget that raised the levy from the current 5%.
"Existing beneficial TCS treatment for education and health payments will also continue," the ministry said. Necessary changes to the Foreign Exchange Management (Current Account Transactions) Rules, 2000, will be issued separately, it added.
The ministry's decision earlier this month to bring international credit card spending under the RBI liberalised remittance scheme (LRS) and the consequent levy of 20% TCS had evoked sharp reactions from several quarters as well as a social media backlash.

Monsoon Advances in Andaman Sea, Nicobar

New Delhi: Southwest monsoon has advanced over Southeast Bay of Bengal, Nicobar Islands and South Andaman Sea on Friday, setting the stage for the four-month rainy season crucial for the country's farm economy.
Earlier this week, the weather office said the onset of monsoon over Kerala, marking its entry into the mainland, would be slightly delayed than the usual date of June 1.
"Southwest monsoon has advanced into some parts of southeast Bay of Bengal, Nicobar Islands and South Andaman Sea today," the India Meteorological Department said. Conditions are favourable for further advance of southwest monsoon into some more



parts of south Bay of Bengal, Andaman Sea and Andaman & Nicobar Islands during next 3-4 days, it said.
On Tuesday the weather office had said that the onset of monsoon over Kerala is likely to be on June 4 with a model error of four days.
The monsoon arrived in Kerala on May 29 last year, June 3 in 2021, June 1 in 2020, June 8 in 2019 and May 29 in 2018. Agriculture contributes around 15 per cent to India's \$3 trillion dollar economy and a good monsoon helps recharge aquifers and reservoirs besides watering the farms.
The emergence of the El Niño weather pattern has raised concerns over monsoon rainfall in 2023.

As per the Scheme, 3,157,934,237 equity shares having face value of Re. 1/- each were allotted by the Company in the ratio of 1 equity share of the Company of face value Re. 1/- each for every 1 equity share of SAMIL of face value Re. 1/- each to the shareholders of SAMIL as on January 19, 2022, being the record date fixed by the Company.
c) The shareholders of the Company approved the issue of bonus shares on November 5, 2022 in proportion of 2 equity shares for every 5 equity shares held. These bonus shares have been allotted on November 18, 2022 and got trading approval from stock exchanges from November 23, 2022.
