Two populist Budgets, five years apart: The likeness of Gehlot & Raje's announcements

Raje played the populist card five years ago in an attempt to hang on to power. Now, Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot has followed in her footsteps. It remains to be seen if he will succeed where she failed

WHEN RAJASTHAN Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot walked into the state Assembly on Friday to present the fifth and last Budget of his current tenure, he had several populist announcements in his briefcase, all aimed at convincing the electorate to give him another term.

The announcements he made — an increase in the insurance amount of the government's Chiranjeevi Health Insurance Scheme from Rs 10 lakh to Rs 25 lakh, the decision to provide LPG cylinders at a rate of Rs 500 to 76 lakh families and 100 units of free electricity to families — were all meant to bolster Gehlot's tagline of "good governance".

In the last several months, Gehlot has been consistently expressing confidence about the Congress getting re-elected — a herculean task given the fact that in the past 25 years every incumbent government has been voted out.

Gehlot's populist announcements echoed the measures his predecessor Vasundhara Raje of the BJP had announced in her government's last Budget in February 2018. Raje had banked on a flurry of populist announcements, with

the most potent weapon in her arsenal being the announcement of a one-time farm-loan waiver for small and marginal farmers up to Rs 50,000. The measure was expected to cost the state exchequer Rs 8,000 crore.

On Friday, Raje, who at present is facing a challenge from multiple state BJP leaders with chief ministerial ambitions, not

only sat through the entire duration of Gehlot's three-hour speech but also attacked the CM when he erroneously read out portions from his previous year's Budget speech. "This is sheer carelessness," Raje said.

Fighting anti-incumbency and embattled by a string of by-poll defeats, Raje had announced subsidies worth Rs 50 lakh for

Nandi Gushala (cow shelters) in each district and increased fodder subsidy from 90 days to 180 days. Five years later, Gehlot has announced Rs 40,000 compensation for cattle rearers who lose milk cows.

Among the other major announcements was the decision to provide government jobs to Covid-19 orphans, along with

the decision to send Annapurna food packets to the families covered under the National Food Security Act (NFSA) in the state.

In his recent speeches and interactions with the media, Gehlot appealed to the electorate to give him another chance to serve them, adding that there is no anti-incumbency against his administration.

Catering to the public sentiment against repeated question paper leaks during his government's tenure, Gehlot also announced a special task force to prevent question paper leaks.

It was expected that the Budget would have a large array of populist announcements. Last year, Gehlot surprised everyone by moving back to the Old Pension Scheme (OPS), which has since then triggered a nationwide debate over the issue, with other Congress-ruled states also following his footsteps.

In the recent elections in Gujarat and Himachal Pradesh, the Congress used OPS as one of its main poll promises. On Friday, Gehlot extended the ambit of OPS to employees of various commissions, electricity commission employees — they had recently protested demanding to be included under OPS — along with other institutions such as institutions and academies.

Ruckus after CM mistakenly reads from previous budget

IN A major embarrassment to Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot, his budget address was disrupted for 1.5 hours on Friday after he erroneously read from last year's budget for the first few minutes, leading to protests by the Opposition BJP.

A few minutes into his speech, Gehlot announced the Urban Employment Scheme along the lines of MGNREGA, while increasing the annual person days under MGNREGA from 100 days per year to 125 days as well as a bridge course for students affected by Covid — all announcements that were made last year when Gehlot presented the 2022-23 budget. However, this was noticed by bureaucrats who were sitting in the Officers' Gallery.

Soon, CM's OSD Shashi Kant Sharma ran to inform Chief Whip Mahesh Joshi, who whispered to Gehlot to stop his address. As CM asked why, Joshi pointed out that it is the old speech. CM's Principal Secretary Kuldeep Ranka and Additional Chief Secretary (Finance) Akhil Arora also spoke to Joshi who came next to the Officers' Gallery.

As the CM stopped his speech and BJP MLAs quickly realised the error, they stormed the well in protest. Leading the protest, Leader of Opposition Gulab Chand Kataria engaged in a verbal duel with Speaker CP Joshi, while state

president Satish Poonia and others stormed the well, with BJP MLAs calling it an insult to democracy. Amid the ruckus, Joshi adjourned the House for half an hour till 11:42 am.

When the House reconvened, with BJP MLAs still in the well, Joshi said that the proceedings up till now will be expunged. Kataria said that such a development has happened for the first time; Joshi responded that what has happened is unfortunate, with Kataria shooting back that the budget has sanctity.

Kataria raised an issue on two points: first, that how can an "outsider" read the budget and know that it's wrong, hence it must have leaked; second, that the Governor has set the date and time for tabling of the budget, hence the House should be suspended.

Deputy Leader of Opposition Rajendra Rathore said that as per Article 202 of the Constitution and Rule 138 of Rajasthan Assembly Rules of Procedure, the day and time are set by the Governor, hence House should be postponed, Business Advisory Meeting (BAC) be called, and another date be set for tabling the budget.

However, Cabinet minister B D Kalla pointed out neither of the two specified the time. He said that the Rule 138 states that, "The Annual Financial Statement... shall be presented to the House on such day as the Governor may direct," Joshi said that it was a human error, and has not happened for the first time.

Gehlot then said he was reading "one page mistakenly" and that there is no question of leak. As BJP continued to protest, Joshi, an hour into the day's proceedings, asked Gehlot to start his budget speech.

However, before beginning his speech, Gehlot requested the opposition to go back to their chairs. Amidst this, Kataria insisted that the CM should apologise, as the BJP MLAs returned to the chairs. Joshi then asked Gehlot to stop and engaged with the Opposition MLAs. As Parliamentary Affairs minister Shanti Dhariwal stood up to respond, BJP MLAs again got agitated and stormed the well once again. Amid the ruckus, Gehlot requested the Opposition to stop their protest. However, as they persisted, Gehlot walked out of the House at 12:11 pm, leading Joshi to adjourn the House again for 15 minutes.

When the House reconvened at 12:26 pm, Gehlot said that, "I was myself confused... I felt sorry at that time too. Maybe you didn't hear it. Now I feel sorry again that a mistake was made."

He said that a correction was made by former CM Vasundhara Raje too, prompting Raje to stand up and react sharply at Gehlot: "What you have done, that is sheer carelessness. No CM comes with his papers in this manner without reading the budget. If it happens like this, then I feel sorry for what will happen to Rajasthan. Hence, don't raise this here."

Post that Gehlot finally restarted his budget address.

PM flags off Vande Bharat, says Budget boost to middle class

PRIME MINISTER Narendra Modi on Friday said this year's Union Budget has strengthened the middle class. "Be it the salaried class or the middle class earning from trade and commerce, this Budget has made them happy," the PM said after flagging off two Vande Bharat trains from the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus in south Mumbai.

you start an infrastructure project, it boosts cement, sand and iron sectors. When the project is complete, it improves connectivity and generates new avenues of employment." After reaching Platform 18 of CSMT, the PM inspected the Mumbai-Sainagar Shirdi Vande Bharat train and interacted with the train crew and the children inside the coach.

He said it is a huge day for the Railways, especially for advanced connectivity in Maharashtra, as this is the first time that two Vande Bharat trains have been flagged off on the same day. He said these trains will connect economic centres such as Mumbai and Pune to centres of faith, thereby benefiting those traveling for college, office, business, pilgrimage and agricultural purposes.

Travelling to sacred places like Shirdi, Nasik, Trimbakeshwar and Panchvati will be made easier with the new Vande Bharat trains, which will give a boost to tourism as well as pilgrimage, he

said. "The pilgrimages of Pandharpur, Solapur, Akkalkot and Tuljapur will also be made more accessible with the Mumbai-Solapur Vande Bharat Express... The Mumbai to Sainagar Shirdi Vande Bharat Express will help people to go to Shirdi, Trimbakeshwar and Panchwati at Nashik."

"Vande Bharat trains are a reflection of India's speed and scale," he added. The PM noted that the budgetary allocation for railway projects was higher for Mumbai and Maharashtra this year and this has been appreciated by both Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and Deputy CM Devendra Fadnis.

The PM, who inaugurated multiple projects, said, "The improved connectivity between eastern and western suburbs will help in ease of travel and save time." The purpose of these infrastructure projects is to provide better living conditions and quality to Mumbaiers, he added.

'Sextortion calls' to Maharashtra MLA: Police arrest man from Bharatpur

PUNE CITY police have arrested a youth from a Rajasthan village for allegedly trying to extort money from MLA Yashwant Mane by making obscene video calls to him on WhatsApp and threatening to circulate it on social media.

Police have identified the accused as Rizwan Aslam Khan (24), of Sihawali village in Rajasthan's Bharatpur district. Mane, is a Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) MLA from Mohol in

Maharashtra's Solapur district, and also has a house in Pune.

At a press conference held by Pune's cyber police station, Mane said that since January 23, 2023, he had been receiving sleazy messages from a number used by the accused. "I ignored the messages for a few days. Then around 9.15 pm on January 31, I got a video call. I did not respond initially, but the video calls continued. The same day when I decided to take the call, I saw an obscene video of a woman. I cut the call within seconds, but the accused made a screen recording of this short

call and threatened to circulate it to my contacts if I did not give him Rs 1 lakh," said Mane. "I asked the caller whether he knew me, and as to how he got my number. He said he got my number from social media and made demanding money saying, "Aap bade ijatdar ho, paise se jada apko ijat pyari hai. I suspected this to be a major racket," he said.

Mane then contacted additional commissioner of police (crime) Ramnath Pokle of Pune City Police about the call, and an FIR was lodged under Section 384, 500 of IPC on February 2. A

police team headed by DCP Shrinivas Ghadge, ACP Vijaykumar Palsule, senior inspector Meenal Supe Patil, assistant inspector Balbhim Nanaware and SI Sachin Jadhav initiated the probe. Upon technical analysis of the accused's phone number, it was found that he was based in Bharatpur, Rajasthan.

A police team was sent to Bharatpur, where after a rigorous search operation for a week, with the help of Rajasthan police, Rizwan Khan was arrested from Sihawali village on Thursday. Police found that sev-

eral persons from the village were involved in committing similar online crimes. Police seized four cell phones and four sim cards from the accused Khan. Police suspect he spoke to the complainant MLA in a female voice.

"We found 90 obscene videos in his phone. A court in Pune has remanded him to police custody for five days. We suspect he got the MLA's number randomly. We are investigating his possible involvement in more sextortion cases, and to find his accomplices," said Pokle.

No pay for 6 months, literacy worker dies by suicide in Kerala

A RECIPIENT of the President's award for the best literacy worker allegedly ended life in Kerala on Thursday over "non-payment of monthly honorarium for the past six months".

Literacy praker E S Bijumon, 49, a block-level nodal officer of the state literacy mission, was among the 1,714 literacy prakers in Kerala who have been denied the honorarium for the last six months due to the state government's financial crisis.

A native of Kollam district, Bijumon's death comes at a time when the prakers have been on an indefinite sit-in in front of the state secretariat for the last 82 days, demanding payment of their

dues. Apart from the government's financial crisis, salary payment to literacy prakers has been in limbo due to the delay in redeploying the prakers with the local self-government department, sources in the state literacy mission said.

Earlier, the prakers were under the education department but last year, the government decided to bring the foot soldiers of the literacy mission under civic bodies. However, this process has not been completed, leaving the prakers in the lurch, sources added.

Vijayamma, mother of the deceased, told media: "After the death of his father, he was looking after me and my daughter. We were surviving on his meagre income. On many days in the last six months, we did not have money to even buy provisions."

Kerala State Literacy Praker Association spokesperson C Sheeja said Bijumon had been with the state literacy mission for last 25 years. "Bijumon is a martyr of the government's apathy towards the literacy workers. In the state budget, we expected allotment for prakers. Bijumon was despondent after realising that nothing has been allotted for paying the arrears," she said.

M B Rajesh, minister for local self-government department, said a decision on the salary of prakers would be taken after discussions with the finance and education ministers. BJP Kollam district president B B Gopakumar said: "These prakers had expected the government would set aside money for their salary in the budget. But the government's inhumane approach has disappointed them."

BENGAL SCHOOL JOBS SCAM

Cancel jobs of 1,911 illegally appointed Group D staff: HC

THE CALCUTTA High Court on Friday directed the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education (WBBSSE) to cancel the jobs of 1,911 Group D employees, who were given appointments in state-run schools illegally after manipulation their recruitment examination results. The court directed the School Service Commission (SSC) to immediately initiate steps to fill up the posts.

The single bench of Justice Abhijit Gangopadhyay gave the order after it found that the 1,911 candidates had got the recommendation owing to manipulation of their OMR sheets for the recruitment examination in 2016 for Group D employees. Names of such candidates were recommended to the WBBSSE by the West Bengal School Service Commission.

The court also directed Subiresh Bhattacharya, who was the chairman of the WBSSC at the time of the publication of results for the 2016 examinations, to disclose the names of persons who asked to manipulate the results.

तुर्किये-सीरिया भूकंप में मृतकों की संख्या 24 हजार पार

तुर्किये और सीरिया में विनाशकारी भूकंप के बाद से शुरुआत देर रात तक 24 हजार से ज्यादा लोग अपनी जान गंवा चुके हैं और व्यापक तबाही के बीच मरने वालों की संख्या में वृद्धि जारी है। तुर्किये के सरकारी मीडिया अनादोलु के अनुसार, तुर्किये के स्वास्थ्य मंत्री फर्हार्तिन कोका ने कहा कि इस सप्ताह आए भूकंप में कम से कम 20,213 लोग मारे गए हैं और 80,052 घायल हुए हैं। उन्होंने कहा कि मलबे से बचाए गए नागरिकों को भूकंप प्रभावित क्षेत्रों के बाहर प्रांतों में स्थानांतरित कर दिया गया है। कोका ने कहा कि जिन लोगों की पहचान नहीं हुई है, उनकी डिजिटल तस्वीरें मिलान के लिए विशेष सॉफ्टवेयर पर अपलोड की जा रही हैं।
