To consider and if thought fit to pass, with or without modifications, the following resolution(s) as a Special Resolution:-

"RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the provisions of Sections 152, 161 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 (the 'Act') and the Rules made thereunder and the applicable provisions of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (the 'SEBI Listing Regulations') (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force), Mr. Prabodh Kumar Nahar (DIN: 11457800), who was

appointed by the Board of Directors, based on the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee as an Additional Director designated as an Executive Director, with effect from 07th January, 2026 and in respect of whom the Company has received a notice in writing under Section 160 of the Act proposing his candidature for the office of a Director, be and is hereby appointed as an Director of the Company, whose office shall be liable to retire by rotation.”

“RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the provisions of Section 196, 197, 198 and 203 read with Schedule V and all other applicable provisions, if any, of the Act, read with the Companies (Appointment and Remuneration of Managerial Personnel) Rules, 2014 (including any statutory modification (s) or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force), and all other applicable regulations of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, the Articles of Association of the Company and subject to such other approvals, permissions and sanctions as may be necessary and subject to such conditions as may be prescribed by any of the concerned authorities (if any) while granting such approvals, consent of the members of the Company be and is hereby accorded for appointment to Mr. Prabodh Kumar Nahar (DIN: 11457800) as a Whole-time Director designated as an Executive Director of the Company for a period of three years with effect from 07th January, 2026.”

The Company is providing e-voting facility of National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) to its members to exercise their right to vote on the proposed resolutions by electronic means.

The remote e-voting period begins at 9: 00 a.m. (IST) Thursday, 26th February, 2026 and ends at 5:00 p.m. (IST) on Friday, 27th March, 2026. The remote e-voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter. 5. Upon confirmation, the message "Vote cast successfully" will be displayed.

7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

General Guidelines for shareholders

Item No. 1

Pursuant to provisions of Section 161 of the Companies Act, 2013 and as recommended by the Nomination and Remuneration Committee, the Board of Directors, at its meeting held on 07th January, 2026, appointed Mr. Prabodh Kumar Nahar, as an Additional Director designated as an Executive Director of the Company, w.e.f. 07th January, 2026. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 160 of the Act, the Company has received a notice in writing to appoint Mr. Prabodh Kumar Nahar, signifying his candidature for the office of the Director of the Company.

Mr. Prabodh Kumar Nahar is Post Graduate in Commerce from the University of Rajasthan. He is also fellow member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). He has about 37 years vast and rich experience in the field of Finance, Commercial, Accounts, Taxation, Legal, Administration and Management etc.

The Board of Directors considered the matter of his appointment and felt that his association would be of immense benefit to the Company and proposed his appointment as Director, whose office shall be liable to retirement by rotation, to hold office for a term of three years commencing with effect from 07th January, 2026.
