Southwest monsoon likely to hit Kerala on May 26: IMD

New Delhi, 15 May

The southwest monsoon is expected to set in early over Kerala on May 26, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) said in its forecast on Friday. The forecast is with a model error of plus and minus four days.

But, if the rains come on time, they could spur sowing of main kharif crops such as paddy, oilseeds and pulses.

The monsoon, the primary rain-bearing system, normally arrives in Kerala around June 1 and advances northwards to cover other parts of the country. The onset of monsoon in the state marks the beginning of the southwest monsoon season (June to September). Last year, the onset of the monsoon happened on May 24. However, timely onset of monsoon is no

summer temperatures is experienced over the areas," it added.

The four-month monsoon season brings almost 70 per cent of the country's annual rainfall. It is critical for agriculture — for the economy as a whole — and for recharging reservoirs and aquifers.

The IMD has said that India might receive below-normal rainfall this year during the monsoon season. The country is likely to get 80 centimetre (cm) of rainfall in the monsoon months, with the long-period average (1971-2020) of seasonal rainfall at 87 cm. The IMD said this could be due to the emergence of El Nino conditions, which cause less rainfall in the country.

In its monthly forecast on May 1, the department had said that El Nino-Southern Oscillation (ENSO)-neutral conditions over the equatorial Pacific were evolving toward El Nino conditions.

"This year, the southwest monsoon is likely to set in over Kerala on May 26 with a model error of ±4 days (could occur four days before or after)," the IMD said. The weather office also added that conditions were favourable for the monsoon to advance over parts of the South Bay of Bengal, Andaman Sea,

and Andaman and Nicobar Islands during the next 24 hours.

"The advance of the southwest monsoon over the Indian mainland is marked by monsoon onset over Kerala and is an important indicator characterising the transition from the hot and dry season to the rainy season," the IMD said. "As the monsoon progresses northward, relief from scorching

Neet (UG) to be computer-based from 2027: Education minister

Re-examination to be conducted on June 21, says NTA

New Delhi, 15 May

The National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (Undergraduate) 2026, or Neet (UG), India's largest medical entrance examination, will shift to a computer-based test (CBT) format from next year, Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan announced on Friday.

This year's exam, held on May 3, was cancelled after allegations that question papers had been leaked and circulated as "guess papers" ahead of the test. The National Testing Agency (NTA) also announced that the re-examination will be conducted on June 21.

"The root cause of the issue is the OMR (Optical Mark Recognition) system, so from next year, the exam will be through a computer-based test (CBT)," Pradhan said at a press conference. "The Radhakrishnan committee had recommended shifting the exam to CBT mode. We could not implement the recommendation earlier, but we will do so from next year."

chaired by former Isro chief K Radhakrishnan, was constituted in 2024 after irregularities in Neet (UG) and UGC-NET triggered widespread protests and raised concerns over the credibility of competitive examinations.

Pradhan acknowledged that lapses had occurred despite the introduction of reforms after earlier examination controversies. "Despite implementing all recommendations of the Radhakrishnan committee, there has been a breach in the chain of command, and we admit that. We

take responsibility to resolve this," he said.

He added that the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) is probing the breach to identify those responsible. Calling it a "long-term battle against the education mafia," Pradhan reiterated the government's zero-tolerance approach towards examination malpractice.

Pradhan also announced that candidates appearing for the re-examination will receive an additional 15 minutes to complete the test. "Formalities such as signing the OMR sheet at the beginning and end of the exam reduced students' effective writing time. Hence, the exam, earlier held from 2pm to 5pm, will now be conducted from 2pm to 5:15pm," he said.

He added that admit cards for the re-examination would be issued by June 14. The announcement came a day after a high-level meeting at Pradhan's residence on Thursday night, sources said.

Discussions focused on preparations for the re-examination and were attended by senior officials.

Neet paper leak 'kingpin' nabbed from Pune: CBI

The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on Friday claimed it had cracked the Neet paper leak case with the arrest of a Pune-based professor, the "source" of the leak of the paper.

"P.V. Kulkarni has been arrested at Pune after thorough interrogation," a CBI spokesperson said. Kulkarni hosted special coaching classes at his house in the last week of April and dictated to his students questions and answers which appeared in the May 3 paper. Students allegedly paid several lakh rupees to attend the sessions where they wrote the questions down in their notebooks and later "tallied exactly" with the actual Neet paper conducted on May 3, the spokesperson said.

SC to hear cases via videoconferencing on Mondays, Fridays to limit fuel consumption

New Delhi, 15 May

The Supreme Court on Friday decided to hear cases exclusively through videoconference on Mondays and Fridays, and judges "unanimously resolved" to encourage car-pooling arrangements amongst themselves in order to ensure optimum fuel utilisation.

The move came following a call by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on cutting down avoidable expenditure due to the ongoing West Asia crisis.

"Matters listed on miscellaneous days (i.e. on Mondays,

Fridays, or such other days as declared to be miscellaneous), and matters listed during the Court's partial working days, shall be heard by videoconferencing only.

"The Registry shall ensure that links for the videoconferencing are sent in a timely manner, stable videoconfer-

encing facilities are maintained and timely technical assistance facilities are extended so as to avoid any inconvenience to the Hon'ble Court," a circular issued said.

The communication from the apex court also said that till further orders, up to 50 per cent of staff in each branch or section of the registry are permitted to work from home (WFH) for up to two days every week, provided that the remaining staff remain available in the office to ensure uninterrupted functioning.

"The Registrar concerned shall ensure that a weekly roster

is prepared before the commencement of the week. Staff who are permitted to work from home are directed to remain available on the telephone and be ready to attend office, in case of requirement, at any time.

"The concerned officers shall also ensure the timely completion of various tasks assigned to them. If, after considering the essential nature of the work in a branch or section, the concerned Registrar is of the opinion that a work-from-home arrangement is not effective, the Registrar may restrict or modify such arrangements for that branch or section," the circular said.

Navi Mumbai battles water shortage after 24-hr clamp

Supply remains erratic, low pressure leaves residents struggling

Several residents across Navi Mumbai continued to face acute water shortage on Friday, despite the Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC) claiming restoration of normal supply after completing major maintenance work on the Morbe water pipeline. NMMC had announced a 24-hour water shutdown from 10am on May 13 to 10am on May 14 for critical infrastructure work, including repairs to a 2,000mm balancing tank at Belapur, connection of major pipelines and other technical upgrades. Though

the work was completed on Thursday and pumping resumed in phases from the Bhokarpada treatment plant, many residents alleged that supply remained erratic due to low pressure. NMMC additional city engineer (civil) Arvind Shinde had said that direct-line water supply across all wards would resume between 10pm and 11pm on Thursday, while supply through Jalkumbhi Pump Houses would restart from Friday morning. However, residents from several nodes said they received either extremely low-pressure supply or no water even by Friday evening. A resident of Nerul Sector

A severe water crisis has gripped 29 villages alongside the core Panvel municipal area, triggering a peaceful protest scheduled for May 17. The protest will be held at 11am near the water supply centre in Kamothe to draw administrative attention to the situation. Rapid urbanisation, new residential projects, and industrial expansion have caused a 30-million litres per day deficit. Residents face erratic supplies, forcing a heavy reliance on private water tankers.

4, Manasi Udeshi said supply resumed briefly on Thursday night but remained inadequate. "At 10pm on Thursday, water supply resumed in Nerul Sector 4 with very low pressure for only an hour. We managed to fill only three-fourths of the tank, and by Friday evening there was no water again," she said. Residents said the disruption forced many families to depend on stored water and private tankers. NMMC officials have maintained that pumping has resumed in phases and that water supply is expected to normalise gradually as pressure stabilises in the distribution network.

CR seeks 100% handover of Navi Mum stns

Member of Parliament Naresh Mhaske on Friday claimed that the handover process for the maintenance and control of railway stations in Navi Mumbai could be completed within six months. However, railway officials clarified that no final agreement has yet been reached between CIDCO and Central Railway (CR). The long-standing dispute between CIDCO and CR over

maintenance and control of railway stations in Navi Mumbai remains unresolved, with CR insisting on complete transfer of station premises and revenue rights before taking over maintenance responsibilities. The continued deadlock has raised concerns over poor passenger amenities and delayed infrastructure upgrades across several Harbour and Trans-Harbour line stations. The issue was discussed during a special meeting on Friday at the CR headquarters

at Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus, chaired by Mhaske. During the meeting, participants stressed the need for a single authority to manage stations, especially in view of increasing commuter pressure expected from the upcoming Navi Mumbai International Airport and other infrastructure projects. Demands were also raised for station modernisation, reopening of closed ticket counters and speedy completion of subway and foot over-bridge works in Rabale, Digha

and Airoli. Several stations in Navi Mumbai have been facing complaints over poor upkeep, inadequate amenities and delayed repair works. CIDCO currently earns nearly 5 crore every month through an additional surcharge levied on Harbour and Trans-Harbour railway tickets. The authorities said they are prepared to take over station management only if commercially used spaces, rental income and adjoining properties are also handed over.

Marathi must for revenue hearings, says minister

MUMBAI: The state government on Friday made the use of Marathi mandatory in hearings as well as in all orders passed by authorities in quasi-judicial proceedings in the revenue department. Revenue minister Chandrashekhar Bawankule announced a new standard operating procedure (SOP) for these proceedings. The government considered earlier directives, recommendations from divisional commissioners, field-

level instructions and observations of the Bombay High Court and the Supreme Court while framing the revised procedures for quasi-judicial functioning, the minister said. The new SOP also makes it mandatory for all revenue officers to conduct hearings at least twice a week, preferably on Tuesdays and Fridays. All interim and final orders will have to be uploaded on the 'e-QJ Court' system and issued only with digital signatures. —PTI

State plans to launch 'soulful' office facility

MUMBAI: Union minister Piyush Goyal on Friday announced that the government is mulling to start a "soulful" office facility to help entrepreneurs with any aspect under the commerce ministry. Addressing media persons in SEEPZ, Goyal said at present, one has to seek information from a "mechanical" platform like ChatGPT. Exuding confidence that the move will bring welcome change, he said, "Now there will be a soulful office run by

our ministry with which he (entrepreneur) can engage either physically or through video conferencing and get all the answers he requires." The answers can be related to commerce, industry, flagship initiatives like Startup India or Make in India, delegations going to scout newer markets and also exhibitions held across the world, he said. The office will also give information on how to start a business, and how to get land for a project —PTI
