School land encroached for temple use, tiny tots in peril

A part of a government school property at Velayuthampalaya village near Avinashi in Tiruppur district has been allegedly encroached upon for the last five years by influential people for use by a priest of a private Lord Muruga temple.

After unauthorised people claiming to be 'village representatives' walled off the two school buildings on government property, over 20 children studying in the anganwadi here are compelled to use a dilapidated old building on the premises, said villagers and activists. They have requested the district administration to take appropriate steps to recover the school buildings encroached upon by vested interests.

The private Murugan temple at Velayuthampalayam village, which is on the outskirts of Avinashi taluk, is next to three school buildings: two primary blocks, one in good condition and the other unusable, and a new anganwadi structure built in 2009 and renovated in 2018.

It is alleged unauthorised 'village representatives' gave away the usable primary school block and the new anganwadi building for temple use. Furthermore, a perimeter wall has been erected connecting the two structures and preventing public access. The anganwadi children now have to use the dilapidated building. The primary school was merged with the village middle school in 2018. The latter operates out of another building located elsewhere. The anganwadi building and the building for classes 4 and 5, which are functioning near the temple, are under occupation.

When TNIE inspected the

spot on Tuesday, none of the villagers came forward to talk, apparently apprehensive to speak out against the village representatives.

A social activist, who did not want to be named, said, "Classes 1 to 3 were initially in the dilapidated building. Classes 4 and 5 and the anganwadi functioning in the two fit buildings presently attached to the temple complex."

A few years ago unauthorised village representatives shifted the anganwadi to the dilapidated building and the two usable ones were converted to form the temple complex, the activist alleged. "One of those buildings is being used as the residence of the temple priest. This has been going on for a long time," he said.

K Malarvizhi, project director of the District Rural Development Agency (DRDA), told TNIE, "Appropriate action will be taken immediately to recover those educational buildings from encroachment. Anganwadi children will be provided with a building in good condition."

M Chandrasekar, Tahsildar of Avinashi, said, "Both the anganwadi building and the old school building, adjacent to the temple, are on government land. On Wednesday, I inspected the place. We verified the documents and found the land where the educational buildings are located belongs to the government. A few have occupied them for temple usage. Rural development officials may take appropriate action to recover buildings."

Avinashi BDO Vijayakumar said, "An investigation is under way in this regard. Action will be taken after it."

A Saraswathi, Monitoring Officer (Avinashi Taluk) of Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS), said, "About five years ago, some villagers demanded the anganwadi building for just two days, saying it was for use during the temple festival. Believing that, the then-anganwadi in-charge gave nod. They didn't hand over the building after that. They insisted us to use the old school building opposite the temple for the anganwadi."

Dist admin to ensure higher edu for Class 12 pass outs

THE district administration has appointed a nodal agency in 114 government schools across the district to ensure students who have passed Class XII enrol for higher education. The aim is to ensure continuous higher education for students who struggle due to financial situations.

Sources said Collector Pavanakumar G Giriappanavar, who serves as the nodal officer for CCMA Government Girls Higher Secondary School in the city, visited the school on Wednesday. He urged students who had not yet enrolled in higher education to continue their studies. He assured that the district administration would provide financial assistance so they could join their desired courses.

Subsequently, about 30 girl students submitted petitions to the collector seeking financial assistance to enrol in courses. After nodal officers collected the details from schools, the district administration would take steps to enrol them in higher studies, sources added.

An officer from the school education department told TNIE that top officials from all district departments have been

appointed as nodal officers. "They will verify whether students have enrolled in higher education institutions after completing Class 12. If students have not enrolled for higher education, the nodal officer will contact them to ascertain why. Based on their reasons, the officers will take steps to help them. This process has now begun in the district," the department said.

TNAU counselling for undergraduate courses from June 24

Coimbatore: Tamil Nadu Agricultural University (TNAU) will begin admission counselling for undergraduate courses at TNAU and the Faculty of Agriculture, Annamalai University (AU) from June 24. A top officer from TNAU told TNIE that the TNAU received 28,536 online applications. "These applications will be considered for counselling to fill 6,921 UG seats at constituent and affiliated colleges under TNAU and 360 seats at AU during the 2025-26 academic year," he said. "The rank list will be released on June 24. On the same day, online counselling will begin for the general category and government school students who applied under the 7.5% reservation. This counselling will be held from June 24 to 27. Offline counselling for the special category will take place on June 27.

'Smuggled gold a way to hide illicit wealth'

Continued from page 1: To improve profits, carriers must then smuggle bigger quantities in a single trip, which is riskier. Sources say the expenses on smuggling have also increased, with carriers demanding higher wages per trip. Usually, carriers are paid around ₹5,000-₹10,000 for smuggling 500-800g of gold, apart from a free air ticket and stay in the foreign country. A retired Customs official said that smuggled gold is also a way to hide illicit wealth in India and a drop in airport seizures would mean that it may be happening through other channels, like the sea route which might need to be studied. HC to take up the case for further hearing on June 26

JAYARAM further alleged that the HC passed the order without "assigning any detailed reasons" relying entirely upon the purported statements of the two accused persons.

He also noted that he had not moved the HC for any relief but was directed to appear before the court on June 16 for the anticipatory bail hearing of an accused person. Jayaram further argued that the Madras HC had overlooked the fact that he is a serving po-

lice officer in the grade of an ADGP and an IPS officer with 28 years of experience.

After hearing lawyers' arguments, the SC told the government to seek instructions in the matter and fixed the case for further hearing on Thursday.
