## Sambhal on high alert on first anniversary of 2024 violence

**SAMBHAL, NOV 24:** The administration in Uttar Pradesh's Sambhal district remained on high alert on Monday with the town marking the first anniversary of the violence that occurred on the same day last year.

On November 24 2024, violence erupted in Sambhal's Kot Garvi locality during a survey of the Mughal-era Jama Masjid. The incident led to the death of four people due to gunfire, while several others sustained injuries. Authorities divided the entire district into 19 security sectors and conducted a flag march across sensitive areas, including the disputed religious site, Hindupara Kheda and Anjuman Tiraha. District magistrate Rajender Pensiya told reporters after the flag march that the objective was to instil confidence among residents. "The purpose of the flag march was to reassure the public that the police and administration stand firmly with them," he said.

Pensiya further informed that 19 magistrates — routinely deployed every Friday — have been stationed across the district on Monday as well. "A total of 163 CCTV cameras have been installed in the past year under the Safe City Sambhal project," he added. Local police forces, 19 magistrates, units of the Rapid Action Force (RAF) and two battalions of the Provincial Armed Constabulary (PAC) were deployed to maintain order. Responding to a query on preventive action, Pensiya said that over 2,000 people have been bound down in the district. Security personnel continued to maintain strict vigil throughout the day to ensure peace.

## Teenager dies after botched piles treatment by quack

**HYDERABAD, NOV 24:** A 16-year-old boy died after an alleged botched piles treatment by a quack here, police said on Monday.

The boy's mother, in a complaint, alleged that there was negligence in giving treatment to his son, a second-year intermediate student. The boy, suffering from piles, underwent treatment on November 12 and died on November 22 evening after developing bleeding and other complications, police said, citing the complaint. Based on the complaint lodged by the boy's mother, a case under Section 106 (causing death by negligence) of BNS was registered against the man operating the clinic, who was assisted by his wife during the treatment procedure, a police official said.

The man claimed to offer treatment for piles which he acquired from his forefathers, police said. The boy initially underwent piles treatment at the clinic on November 12, but as the bleeding continued following the procedure he was taken to the clinic for treatment till November 21. But when he developed fever and other complications he was referred to another private hospital by the clinic, from where he was again admitted to another medical facility, the complainant said.

## Drive begins to clear encroachments on govt land around Ahmedabad's Isanpur lake

**AHMEDABAD, NOV 24:** The Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation (AMC) along with police launched a mega demolition drive on Monday to clear illegal encroachments at Isanpur lake, officials said.

Of the 96,000 square metres of government land at the lake site, nearly 30 per cent (28,800 square metres) has been encroached, AMC deputy commissioner Riddhesh Raval said. While 167 commercial properties were demolished before Diwali, the drive launched during the day is to clear 925 illegal residential structures, he told reporters. "To avoid any friction, we had served notices to the occupants twice in the past and also took them into confidence before launching this drive. AMC has also collected documents from eligible residents so that they can be covered under a housing scheme in the

future," said Raval. Zone 6 Deputy Commissioner of Police Bhagirathsinh Gadhvi said 550 police personnel have been deployed at the site to maintain law and order, while patrolling teams are keeping a close watch with the help of drones. "It will take two to three days to clear the entire encroached area. The drive was launched early in the morning and several structures were already demolished by afternoon. A week ago, police and AMC officials held meetings with the residents and convinced them to move elsewhere," the DCP said. Nearly 80 per cent occupants shifted with their belongings during the last week while the remaining residents are moving today, he added. This is the second mega demolition drive in the city after the local administration cleared encroachments on nearly 1.25 lakh square metres of land around Chandola lake in Danilimda area in April.

## IN-BRIEF

### Gangster arrested

**THANE:** A gangster, wanted in connection with an attempt to murder case, was arrested in Maharashtra's Thane district after evading the police for 18 months, an official said on Monday. The Hill Line police in Ulhasnagar on Saturday apprehended Akshay Suresh Gaikwad alias Babu (35), who had gone underground after attacking a man in April last year, Deputy Commissioner of Police Sachin Gore said. "Acting on a tip-off about the accused's whereabouts, our team surrounded him. He was swiftly overpowered and handcuffed," the official said. Gaikwad has at least 20 cases, including assault, extortion, attempt to murder, and offences under the Maharashtra Police Act, to his name, police said.

## Andhra: 3 drown as boat capsizes

**ANAKAPALLI:** Three persons drowned after their boat capsized in Rywada reservoir in Anakapalli district, a police official said on Monday. According to police, four men were on the small boat that could accommodate only two. "Three persons drowned after the boat they were travelling in capsized in the Rywada reservoir on Sunday," the official said. Police said that the boat capsized after a distance of around 150 metres from the shore. One person, identified as Jalada Prasad, was the only survivor; they said.

## Vande Bharat train runs over 2 nursing students

**BENGALURU:** Two first-year nursing students were killed after they were allegedly run over by a Vande Bharat Express train on the outskirts of Bengaluru, police said on Monday. The deceased students, Sterlin Eliza Shaji (19) and Justin Joseph (20), both natives of Kerala, were pursuing BSc Nursing at a private institute in the city, they said. According to police, the incident occurred at around 2.35 pm on Sunday. Hit by the Belagavi bound Vande Bharat train from Bengaluru, both died on the spot. Their bodies were found in a severely dismembered state on the tracks, police said.

## Wanted criminal arrested after police encounter in Gwalior

**GWALIOR, NOV 25:** A history-sheeter with several criminal cases to his name was apprehended after a brief encounter with the police in Madhya Pradesh's Gwalior district in the early hours of Monday, an official said.

Kapil Yadav, a wanted criminal carrying a bounty of Rs 10,000, sustained a bullet injury to his leg in the exchange of fire that took place around 5 am in the Mohanpur area, about 25 km from the district headquarters, Gwalior Senior Superintendent of Police Dharamveer Singh said. Kapil had been on the run after attacking some people over a land dispute in the Murar area on November 21, he said. "The police had launched

a hunt for him and announced a reward of Rs 10,000," the official said. Singh said that on Sunday night, the police received information that the accused was planning to flee Gwalior, and based on the tip-off, they searched a van at Mela Ground and apprehended his associate, Aman Yadav, with an illegal firearm, while Kapil managed to escape. The accused was traced to a brick kiln in Mohanpur in the early hours of the day, where he allegedly opened fire at the police team instead of surrendering, prompting retaliatory firing, the official said.

Yadav sustained an injury to his leg and was shifted to a hospital for treatment, he added. According to the police, he faces around 12 criminal cases and was also slapped with the stringent National Security Act (NSA) in the past.

## Dharmendra's native villages in Ludhiana mourn death of their iconic son

**LUDHIANA, NOV 24:** Dango and Sahnewal, two nondescript villages in Punjab's Ludhiana district situated more than 30 kilometres apart, have one thing in common -- Bollywood's He-Man Dharmendra. And now they are united in grief over the passing of the showbiz legend.

The star with a 65-year career spanning 300 films died in Mumbai on Monday at the age of 89. As the news of the legend's death flashed across news channels, Dango and Sahnewal got into deep mourning. Born in Dango village in 1935, Dharam Singh Deol and his family settled to Sahnewal and settled there after his father, Kewal Kishen Singh Deol, a

schoolteacher, was transferred there. While Sahnewal is mostly identified with Dharmendra, people of Dango also have fond memories of the late actor. According to Dharmendra's friend Parminder Singh, the actor would meet people here like an ordinary villager, shedding the aura common for a Bollywood megastar. "He made us feel that he was like any one of us," said Dharmendra's friend, who is now in his eighties. Ganshyam Lotere recalled that despite remaining quite busy and occupied in Mumbai, Dharmendra never forgot Ludhiana, and Sahnewal in particular.

Once, some land owned by the actor's family in Ludhiana was illegally occupied. However, with the

support of the local administration, he managed to get it vacated. While Dharmendra did not visit these places much of late due to his advanced age, the villagers attest that if anyone from these villages tried to meet him in Mumbai, the actor would gladly meet them. A lot of people said Dharmendra was so fond of Ludhiana that he would at times delay his schedule to attend to people from the

## Kerala: UDF's symbolic 'charge sheet' accuses Vijayan govt of unholy alliance with BJP

**KOCHI, NOV 24:** Opposition UDF on Monday accused Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan of forming an "unholy alliance" with the BJP to thwart investigation by central agencies against him and his family members.

As a result, various cases including those against Vijayan, his son and daughter and the ruling CPI(M) are going at a slow pace now, the Congress-led front alleged. The Opposition levelled the serious charges against the CM, his family and the Marxist party in a symbolic

"charge sheet" it released against the Left government at a press conference here. The "charge sheet", with serious accusations against the Vijayan government in various matters, was released along with the election manifesto of the front ahead of the Local Self Government Department (LSGD) polls. "Vijayan entered an unholy alliance with the BJP to prevent himself and his family from going to jail in cases being investigated by Central agencies," the "charge sheet" said. It alleged that Vijayan cheated the people of Kerala and the ruling coalition partner, CPI, by signing the Centre's PM Shri

scheme under the cover of darkness to implement the RSS agenda. It further accused Chief Minister Vijayan and the Union government of pretending not to see the failures in the construction of the national highway in the state, the corruption in its contract, and the hidden dangers to the construction procedure. It also attacked state PWD minister and CM Vijayan's son-in-law P A Mohammed Riyas. "Bridges have collapsed, roads are full of potholes. Yet the Chief Minister pretends not to see the failures of his son-in-law, who is a minister, in his administration," the manifesto said. It also

accused Pinarayi Vijayan, his family and the cabinet colleagues of turning 237 official trips using tax money into pleasure trips.

Kerala's total debt will be around Rs six lakh crore when the LDF government steps down from power, it further alleged adding that every Malayali has a liability of Rs 1.66 lakh through this. People would be forced to pay this debt by paying taxes, it added. The charge sheet also alleged that 23 custodial deaths had been reported during the tenure of Vijayan government and the health and higher education sectors have been destroyed due to the misgovernance.
