Unified plan in the works to secure critical minerals, rare earth magnets

India is preparing to consolidate various incentive schemes into a single, streamlined framework to secure supplies of critical minerals and rare earth magnets — materials essential for electric vehicles, clean energy, and defence systems — as China supplies remain disrupted. The plan — now under active inter-ministerial coordination — would allow companies to stack subsidies and policy benefits from multiple ministries for different parts of the project, senior officials told *businessline*.

A nearly ₹4,000 crore outlay — across existing programmes and through new schemes under consideration — is being planned.

Generally, companies can enjoy the benefits of multiple government subsidy

schemes even if they fall under different ministries, as long as they meet the specific eligibility criteria for each scheme. However, there might be restrictions on stacking subsidies for the same activity or asset.

Senior officials in the know said that at least two line ministries — Mines and

Heavy Industries — are working on incentive schemes for critical mineral and rare earth processing, and magnet-making.

Going forward, there are plans to ensure companies draw subsidies across upcoming manufacturing projects.

This would give a push to

private participation. For instance, under the National Critical Minerals Mission guidelines for stockpiling (of critical minerals) and setting up processing facilities are being worked out keeping in mind PSUs and private players; while the Heavy Industries Ministry is looking at production linked incentives

so that magnet costs are at par with Chinese offerings, the key supplier.

“Basically, we allow the benefits of multiple schemes to a beneficiary, with guidelines being set accordingly. This helps bring in more investment and interest into the sector,” the person in the know added.

CABINET ALL-CLEAR

The ₹34,000-crore National Critical Minerals Mission (₹16,000 crore from the Mines Ministry and ₹18,000 crore from PSU investments) has got Cabinet approval already.

As part of this Mission, there is provision for a ₹500-crore outlay for stockpiling incentives, another ₹1,600 crore for processing and recycling, and a further ₹500 crore for critical mineral processing parks.

In parallel, the Heavy Industries Ministry is working on a ₹2,500-3,000 crore incentive project.

PLI scheme transforms textile sector, facilitates ₹7,343 crore investments

The production linked incentive (PLI) scheme for textiles has emerged as a transformative initiative for the industry.

It offers financial incentives for five years to promote manufacturing in manmade fibre (MMF) apparel, fabrics and technical textiles, enabling scale, competitiveness and global integration.

The Textiles Ministry has expanded the coverage of eligible products by notifying additional HS codes for technical textiles. In a significant move towards early support, the Ministry approved amendments in February, facilitating early disbursement of ₹54 crore.

BUDGETARY OUTLAY

Incentive payouts will cover five financial years (FY26 to FY30) in the FY25 to FY29 period, with a total budgetary outlay of ₹10,683 crore.

Till date, the scheme has catalysed investments of ₹7,343 crore, turnover of ₹4,648 crore and exports of ₹538 crore.

Gautam Kalra, Madura Industrial Textiles, one of the scheme's beneficiaries, said it is not just about financial incentives, the scheme also

facilitates technology transfer and innovation in India's MMF and technical textiles sector. The minimum investment threshold under the scheme is ₹100 crore (Part 1) and ₹300 crore (Part 2), with incentive disbursements linked to achieving incremental turnover of 25 per cent over the previous year.

INVESTMENT BOOST

Nikhil Dake, CFO, Global IGN, another beneficiary company, said the support under the PLI scheme has enabled the company to accelerate investments in automation, product development, capacity expansion and employment generation.

Technical textiles have emerged as a major focus area under the scheme, accounting for 57 per cent of the 74 selected applications, spanning 42 companies.

Shaleen Toshniwal, Chairman, Manmade and Technical Textiles Export Promotion Council, said the scheme has recognised the potential of technical textiles and manmade fibre by including a range of products made out of it.

By boosting production of high-tech products, the scheme is not only drives foreign investment, but also enhances India's positioning as a competitive global textiles hub, he said.

Govt to overhaul ₹1 lakh cr District Mineral Fund, plans tighter convergence with flagship schemes

India plans a strategic overhaul of its District Mineral Fund (DMF) by integrating it with flagship Central schemes. With instances coming to light of the funds being misused outside targeted districts, Coal and Mines Minister GK Reddy has called for tighter convergence and district-level accountability.

Across 106 'aspirational districts' of the country, the average DMF corpus in each of them is nearly ₹300 crore.

According to Reddy, better “convergence” could see improved utilisation of funds and push for flagship schemes of the Centre — for instance across health, housing and other segments.

The DMF corpus size in India had reached over ₹1 lakh crore; with over three lakh projects being sanctioned across 645 districts in 23 States.

Nearly ₹90,000 crore has been cleared across various sanctioned projects. Odisha leads with 29 per cent of total funds, followed by Chhattisgarh (14 per cent) and Jharkhand (13 per cent).

The funds primarily focus on addressing the needs of mining-affected areas and populations. “There needs to be a better convergence of funds that is DMF with other

Central government schemes. It is for the district collectors to prepare projects and work towards executing them so that local communities in these mining affected districts benefit.

So may be some of the Central schemes can be coordinated and executed together through the DMF,” Reddy said at the inaugural session of the National DMF workshop.

TIGHTENING NORMS

The criticism often is DMFs lack structured plans, often relying on *ad hoc* top down project approvals. In some cases, there are allegations, that resources are being used for implementation of development projects outside of districts that are actually intended for, a fact that was pointed out by the Union Minister too.

Key sectors such as liveli-



hoods and human capital development receive minimal funding, while spending is skewed toward infrastructure, it has been found. Roads, bridges account for about 30 per cent of the total allocations, the highest share. In high priority sectors, like drinking water, education, etc, too, infrastructure building has been a core focus.

'Nuclear power plants commissioned after Apr 2022 can adopt constant or variable RoE'

Nuclear power projects commissioned after April 1, 2022, will have the freedom to adopt either a constant return on equity (RoE) of 15.5 per cent for the operating life of the plant or a variable RoE over the period of the power purchase agreement (PPA).

However, operating nuclear power plants, commissioned before April 1, 2022, will have an RoE of 15.5 per cent. These are part of the tariff norms for the sale of electricity by the atomic power stations notified by the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE).

“Central government, in consultation with the Central Electricity Authority (CEA), determines the norms with which the tariff for sale of electricity by the atomic power stations to the State electricity boards (SEBs) and to other persons shall be determined,” the notification said.

“For new power projects commissioned after April 1, 2022, generating companies

can adopt a constant RoE of 15.5 per cent throughout the operating life,” the notification said. The company can also adopt a variable RoE profile over a PPA period, starting with lower RoE during initial years gradually increasing and later decreasing, such that the PV of the RoE over the PPA period remains same as the present value (PV) of the constant RoE of 15.5 per cent over the same period, it added.

On debt-equity, the government mandated that the debt equity structure for future pressurised heavy water reactors (PHWRs) shall be in a 70:30 ratio.

However, for the units under operation and projects under construction, the funding structure already fixed may be adopted, the norms state.

“For future projects other than PHWRs, the debt equity ratio is to be decided by the government on a case-to-case basis, depending on the maturity of technology and

the constraints of the financing arrangement,” it added.

In case the actual equity exceeds 30 per cent of the capital expenditure in a future project, the ROE should be applicable only on the notional equity i.e. 30 per cent of the capital and excess amount will be treated as notional loan at the same interest rate as of debt component of the capital.

CAPACITY UTILISATION

The norms specify that the “realistic achievable capacity” of the power station approved by the Atomic Energy Commission shall be adopted. Besides, the plant load factor, or capacity utilisation, of the 12 nuclear power stations is in the range of 68.5-80 per cent.

The government also specified that there will be no stabilisation period for atomic power stations.

The annual fuel recovery charge in case of PHWRs shall be no so fixed that the present value of charges over a period of 15 years at a discount rate of 12 per cent shall be equal to the value of initial half charge of fuel.

India to have 472 GW RE capacity by FY26-end, says Power Minister

Power Minister Manohar Lal said on Wednesday that the country is on track to achieve a renewable energy capacity of 472 gigawatt (GW) by the end of FY26.

“India has made significant strides in its energy generation efforts. Currently, we have reached almost 50 per cent of our total generation capacity of 472 GW, and by the end of this year, India is on the track to achieve the 50 per cent renewable energy milestone of 472 GW,” the minister said.

“However, to stabilise our grid, optimise power generation, and ensure 24/7 reliable clean energy, establishing an energy storage system is essential to meet our targets,” he said.

STORAGE CAPACITY

Speaking at the India Energy Storage Week 2025, organised by IESA, Lal said according to IAEA estimates, the world will need to increase its energy storage capacity six-fold by 2030 to achieve these goals.

“Our target is ambitious, and we must focus on enhancing energy storage capabilities.

“In the past three to four years, the cost of energy storage has significantly decreased. What was once ₹10 lakh per megawatt has now

fallen to ₹2.5 lakh per megawatt per month, indicating a reduction to one-fourth of the original cost,” the minister said.

“As industries like steel and cement shift towards green hydrogen, India is pushing for energy independence to reduce oil dependency.

“With a green hydrogen mission backed by ₹19,744 crore, the country seeks to produce 10 million tonnes of green hydrogen and establish an electrolyser capacity

of 60 to 100 gigawatts. This initiative highlights India's determination to lead in next-generation fuel production,” he added.

Central Electricity Authority (CEA) Chairperson Ghanahyam Prasad said India currently has around 3,300 megawatt (MW) of capacity in the pipeline, which is expected to culminate in 8,500 megawatt-hours (MWh) over the next two years.

“Moreover, we have around 12,500 MW equating to roughly 42,000 MWh under tender. However, the country's current battery energy storage system (BESS) capacity looks very meagre standing at around 205 MW or about 506 MWh. Why I am sharing these numbers, because starting from 2026-2027, we will need to increase our capacities steadily to reach around 74 gigawatts (GW) by 2031-32,” he added.

“More capacity target

This year, the government aims to target around 3,000 MW of hydro PSP capacity and is working towards increasing the total pumped storage project capacity to 50 GW in the coming years, Prasad said.

“The challenge is to raise the current hydro pumped storage capacity from 5 GW to 50 GW within the next five to six years. We recognise this is a significant challenge, and we are actively working towards achieving it,” he added.
