In terms of regulation 30 read with Schedule III of Listing Regulations and with reference to our disclosure dated March 5, 2025 and March 7, 2025, regarding the fire incidence that took place at our Multi-Purpose Plant (MPP3)- Facility, the warehouse and tank farms located at Dahej SEZ on March 5, 2025 at around 12.30 a.m. IST., this is to further inform you that Gujarat Pollution Control Board (“GPCB”) has issued directions through their correspondence received by the Company on April 22, 2025.

The details as per SEBI Circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated July 13, 2023 and SEBI Master Circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD2/CIR/P/2023/120 dated July 11, 2023, with respect to directions issued by GPCB are mentioned in **Annexure-A**.

Further we would like to inform that there is no change in the revenue guidance provided by the Company in its disclosure dated March 7, 2025.

2	Nature and details of the action(s) taken, initiated or order(s) passed;	A Direction is issued under Section 31A of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 (“ Direction ”) by GPCB, directing non-utilisation of MPP-3, drum storage shed, the warehouse and tank farms which were affected in fire before obtaining revocation/ written approval from Department of Industrial Safety and Health (“ DISH ”) and GPCB and has imposed an Environment Damage Compensation (EDC) cost of Rs. 34.60 lakhs on the Company and has directed to submit a Bank Guarantee of Rs. 7.5 Lakhs for compliance assurance at the time of revocation.

The Direction is issued by GPCB in respect of Fire Accident which impacted environment quality of the surrounding.
5	Impact on financial, operation or other activities of the listed entity, quantifiable in monetary terms to the extent possible	<p>Production/Operation of the Multi-Purpose Plant (MPP3)-Facility, the warehouse and tank farms which were affected in fire is suspended temporarily. It is tentatively estimated that the reconstruction of the impacted facilities may take around 9-12 months to reinstate the plant and restart operations, for which planning and construction work has already been initiated.</p> <p>In the interim, the Company has shifted production of critical select specialty products to other sites based on approval from customers. This, combined with the planned expansion in Patancheru Plant, will help minimize the impact on earnings going ahead to minimize business disruption.</p> <p>Further there is no change in the revenue guidance provided by the Company in its disclosure dated March 7, 2025.</p>
