Vivacity Multispeciality Hospital inaugurates advanced Cardiothoracic and Vascular Surgery unit to provide comprehensive cardiac and vascular care

- India accounts for nearly one-fifth of the estimated 17.7 million deaths caused globally due to CVDs such as ischaemic heart disease and cerebrovascular disease such as stroke. CVD death rate of 272 per 100000 populations in India much higher than global average of 235
- The CTVS unit to be equipped with state-of-art technology and a team of experts to offer advanced diagnostic, therapeutic, and surgical interventions

Kolkata, January 14, 2025: Vivacity Multispeciality Hospital, a unit of Nephro Care India Limited (NCIL), has inaugurated its advanced Cardiothoracic and Vascular Surgery (CTVS) unit to provide cutting-edge cardiac and vascular care to people in the North 24 Parganas district of West Bengal. The hospital, which was inaugurated in July last year, also conducted its first bypass surgery at the newly inaugurated CTVS unit on Monday under the supervision of Dr Neeraj Kumar and Dr Dhiraj Verma.

According to **Dr Pratim Sengupta, MD & CEO, NCIL**, the establishment of CTVS unit at Vivacity aligns with its vision of providing comprehensive and holistic care to patients. The unit, which will be equipped with the most advanced and state-of-the-art technology, will be staffed by a team of highly skilled surgeons and healthcare professionals, offering a range of advanced diagnostic, therapeutic, and surgical interventions.

Setting up an advanced CTVS unit is particularly important given that a significantly high percentage of the country's population suffers from cardio vascular issues. WHO estimates CVDs such as ischaemic heart disease and cerebrovascular such as stroke to account for 17.7 million deaths globally. India accounts for nearly one-fifth of these deaths worldwide especially in younger population. As per the Global Burden of Disease study, age-standardized CVD death rate of 272 per 100000 populations in India which is much higher than that of global average of 235. CVDs strike Indians a decade earlier than the western population.

"We are very happy to announce the inauguration of our advanced CTVS unit which will play a crucial role in providing superior and specialised cardiac and vascular care to our patients. When we set up Vivacity it was our vision to have advanced and cutting-edge services across each of our departments. We already have interventional cardiology and this Cardiothoracic unit enables us to become a complete cardiac care provider in this part of the State. We are also glad to announce the successful completion of our first bypass surgery at the unit today."

A CTVS unit is typically equipped with advanced surgical equipment for minimally invasive and open-heart procedures; boasts sophisticated diagnostic tools including echocardiography and angiography and has a dedicated intensive care unit (ICU) for post-operative care. The presence of such units in a hospital enables early detection and precise and timely intervention for complex heart and vascular diseases.

With the addition of this facility, Vivacity Multispeciality Hospital, joins an elite group of healthcare institutions in West Bengal offering specialized CTVS services and is set to address the unmet need for advanced cardiac care in the region thereby reducing the need for patients to travel long distances for specialised care, Dr Sengupta added.
